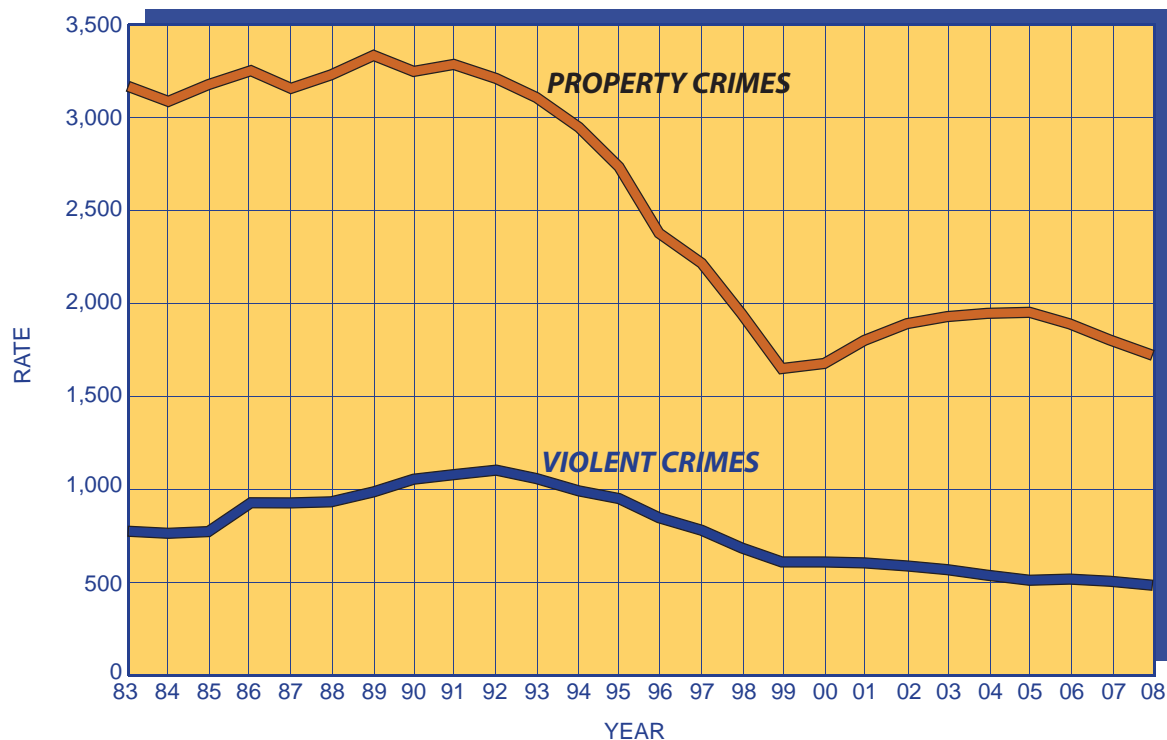

Crime in California, 1983–2008

By Category

Rate per 100,000 Population



The violent crime rate:

- Decreased 4.2 percent from 2007 to 2008 and has decreased 56.0 percent since it peaked in 1992.

The property crime rate:

- Decreased 4.6 percent from 2007 to 2008 and has decreased 48.3 percent since it peaked in 1989.

Crime in California, 2008, Advance Release provides 2008 criminal justice data on crimes, arrests, adult felony arrest dispositions, citizens' complaints against peace officers, and juvenile dispositions and placements. The full reports, *Crime in California, 2008* and *Juvenile Justice in California, 2008*, will be completed later in 2009.
