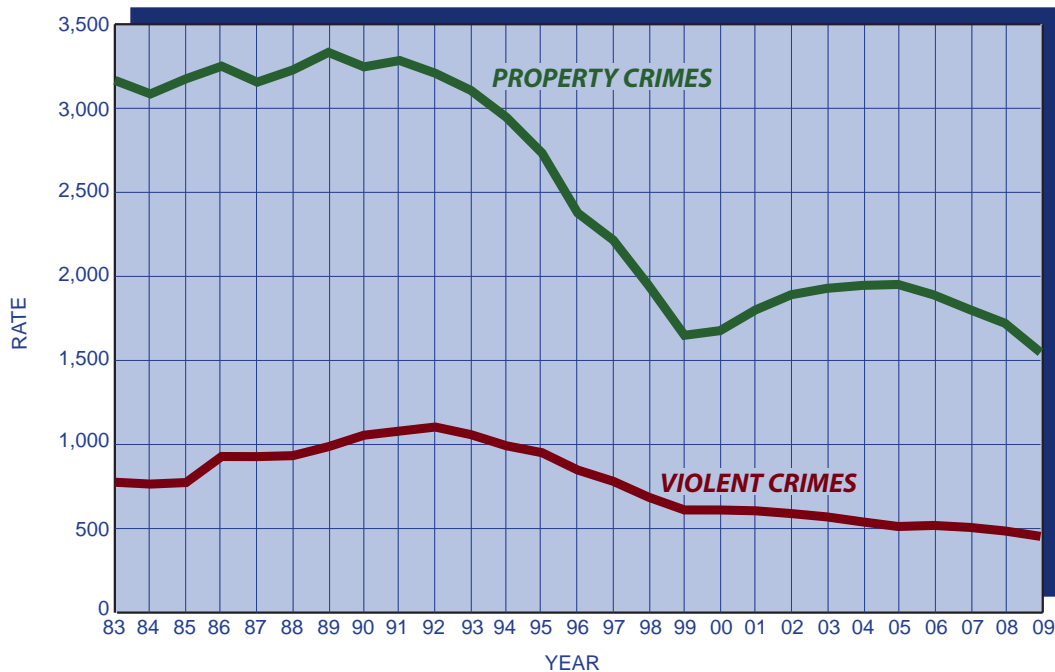

Crime in California, 1983–2009

By Category
Rate per 100,000 Population



The violent crime rate:

- Decreased 6.6 percent from 2008 to 2009 and has decreased 58.9 percent since it peaked in 1992.

The property crime rate:

- Decreased 10.1 percent from 2008 to 2009 and has decreased 53.5 percent since it peaked in 1989.

Crime in California 2009, Advance Release, provides 2009 criminal justice data on crimes, arrests, dispositions of adult felony arrests, citizens' complaints against peace officers, and juvenile justice. The full reports, *Crime in California 2009* and *Juvenile Justice in California 2009*, will be published in late 2010.
