# CRIME IN 2008

## JANUARY THROUGH DECEMBER

This report compares preliminary crime counts for January through December 2008 with final counts for the same period in 2007 for California law enforcement jurisdictions serving populations of 100,000 or more. The 85 jurisdictions that met this criterion in 2007 and 2008 account for approximately 65 percent of the crimes reported in the state annually.

Law enforcement jurisdictions are grouped into three categories:

- Police departments** – provide law enforcement services to cities.
- Sheriff's departments** – provide law enforcement services to unincorporated areas<sup>1</sup> within counties.
- Contract cities** – cities that contract for law enforcement services, usually with a sheriff's department, rather than maintain their own police force.

The 2008 crime data used in this report are preliminary and are subject to change. Crime rates are not used in this report, but are included in the annual *Crime in California* publication. In addition, the California Department of Justice submits this preliminary data to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Uniform Crime Reporting Program for inclusion into their preliminary semiannual and/or annual uniform crime reports.

**Violent Crimes**  
**DOWN 3.3%**

The **VIOLENT CRIME** category includes the offenses of *homicide, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault*.

- When January through December 2007 data were compared to the same period in 2008, the number of reported violent crimes decreased 3.3 percent (from 133,916 to 129,461). The decrease in this category can be attributed to declines in homicide, robbery and aggravated assault (down 3.7, 1.8, and 4.8 percent, respectively).

**Property Crimes**  
**DOWN 3.5%**

The **PROPERTY CRIME** category includes the offenses of *burglary, motor vehicle theft, and larceny-theft over \$400*.

- When January through December 2007 data were compared to the same period in 2008, the number of reported property crimes decreased 3.5 percent (from 428,570 to 413,709). The decrease in this category can be attributed to the decline in motor vehicle theft (down 12.1 percent). Burglary increased slightly (up 0.5 percent) and larceny-theft over \$400 increased 1.4 percent during this period.

**HOMICIDE** – The willful (nonnegligent) killing of one human being by another. Homicide includes murder and nonnegligent manslaughter.

- The number of homicides reported in 2008 decreased 3.7 percent when compared to 2007 (from 1,702 to 1,639). Homicide counts remained the same or decreased for 55 of the agencies (down 195). Counts for the remaining 32 agencies increased (up 132). This resulted in a net decrease of 63 homicides.*

**FORCIBLE RAPE** – The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will. Assaults or attempts to commit rape by force or threat of force are included.

- The number of forcible rapes reported in 2008 increased 2.4 percent when compared to 2007 (from 5,580 to 5,714). Forcible rape counts increased for 38 of the agencies (up 478). Counts for the remaining 47 agencies remained the same or decreased in number (down 344). This resulted in a net increase of 134 forcible rapes.*

**ROBBERY** – The taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear.

- The number of robberies reported in 2008 decreased 1.8 percent when compared to 2007 (from 52,574 to 51,615). Robbery counts remained the same or decreased for 55 of the agencies (down 2,202). Counts for the remaining 30 agencies increased (up 1,243). This resulted in a net decrease of 959 robberies.*

**AGGRAVATED ASSAULT** – The unlawful attack or attempted attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury. This type of assault is usually accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm.

- The number of aggravated assaults reported in 2008 decreased 4.8 percent when compared to 2007 (from 74,060 to 70,493). Aggravated assault counts remained the same or decreased for 57 of the agencies (down 5,045). Counts for the remaining 28 agencies increased (up 1,478). This resulted in a net decrease of 3,567 aggravated assaults.*

**BURGLARY** – The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or theft. Attempted burglary is included.

- The number of burglaries reported in 2008 increased 0.5 percent when compared to 2007 (from 145,953 to 146,683). Burglary counts increased for 43 of the agencies (up 5,534). Counts for the remaining 42 agencies remained the same or decreased in number (down 4,804). This resulted in a net increase of 730 burglaries.*

**MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT** – The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle.

- The number of motor vehicle thefts reported in 2008 decreased 12.1 percent when compared to 2007 (from 144,029 to 126,557). Motor vehicle theft counts remained the same or decreased for 78 of the agencies (down 17,888). Counts for the remaining 7 agencies increased (up 416). This resulted in a net decrease of 17,472 motor vehicle thefts.*

**LARCENY-THEFT OVER \$400** – The unlawful taking, carrying, leading, or riding away of property from the possession or constructive possession of another.

- The number of larceny-thefts over \$400 reported in 2008 increased 1.4 percent when compared to 2007 (from 138,588 to 140,469). Larceny-theft over \$400 counts increased for 43 of the agencies (up 5,703). Counts for the remaining 42 agencies remained the same or decreased in number (down 3,822). This resulted in a net increase of 1,881 larceny-thefts over \$400.*
