The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

REDISTRICTING. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AND STATUTE. Creates 14member redistricting commission responsible for drawing new district lines for State Senate,
Assembly, and Board of Equalization districts. Requires State Auditor to select the commission
members randomly from voter applicant pool to create a commission with five members from
each of the two largest political parties, and four members unaffiliated with either political party.
Requires ten votes to approve final district maps. Establishes standards for drawing new lines,
including respect for the geographic integrity of counties and cities. Permits State Legislature to
draw lines for congressional districts subject to these standards. Summary of estimate by
Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local government:
Probably no significant increase in state redistricting costs. (Initiative 07-0078.)
