The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

LEGISLATORS' TERMS IN OFFICE. CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND

JUNKETS. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. Changes the California

Constitution to allow legislators to serve more time in office. Allows a person to serve an additional four-year term in the Senate for a maximum of 12 years. Allows a person to serve an additional two-year term in the Assembly for a maximum of eight years. Provides that a legislator "may serve a further term beyond the current term in office" if he or she does not receive campaign contributions or accept any "privately-funded junkets." Summary of estimate by Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance of fiscal impact on state and local government:

This measure would have no direct fiscal effect on state or local governments.
