



Office of the Attorney General Privacy Notice

Collection and Use of Personal Information. The Attorney General collects the information requested on this form to verify information as authorized by Education Code section 94874.1, subdivision (a), which provides that the Bureau for Private and Postsecondary Education shall not verify the exemption from Chapter 8 of the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009, or contract for the complaint handling under Education Code section 94874.9 for a nonprofit institution that operated as a for-profit institution during any period on or after January 1, 2010, unless the Attorney General provides a verification to the nonprofit institution.

The Attorney General uses the information in the administration and enforcement of Education Code section 94874.1. The Attorney General may also use the information for additional purposes, including in support of investigations and law enforcement actions, providing public access to information as required by the Act (Gov. Code §§ 12587, 12587.1, 12590), and making referrals to other law enforcement agencies. Any personal information collected by state agencies is subject to the limitations in the Information Practices Act and state policy. The Department of Justice's general privacy policy is available at www.oag.ca.gov/privacy-policy.

Providing Personal Information. All the personal information requested in the form must be provided. An incomplete submission may result in the Attorney General not be able to provide a verification.

Possible Disclosure of Personal Information. In order to determine the verification process the Attorney General may need to share the information on this form with other government agencies. We may also share the information to further an investigation, including an investigation by other government or law enforcement agencies.

The information provided may also be disclosed in the following circumstances:

- With other persons or agencies where necessary to perform their legal duties, and their use of
 your information is compatible and complies with state law, such as for investigations or for
 licensing, certification, or regulatory purposes;
- To another government agency consistent with state or federal law.

INSTRUCTION FOR APPLICATION FOR VERIFICATION ATTORNEY GENERAL OF CALIFORNIA

Section 94874.1, California Education Code Cal. Code Regs., tit. 11, section 940

(FORM CT-SCHOOL-1)



The purpose of the Application for Verification (Form CT-School-1) is to assist the Attorney General with verifying information as required by Education Code section 94874.1, subdivision (a).

WHO MUST FILE THE APPLICATION FOR VERIFICATION FORM CT-SCHOOL-1?

Every nonprofit institution that seeks a verification of exempt status with the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education is required to have information verified by the Attorney General pursuant to Education Code section 94871.1, subdivision (a).

PART A

Name of the nonprofit institution and other information - Insert the legal name as stated in the nonprofit institution's organizing instrument such as its articles of incorporation, any and all doing business as (DBAs) operating names, telephone number, and its website address.

<u>Mailing Address</u> - Insert the official mailing address of the nonprofit institution.

Physical address of the nonprofit institution's primary administrative location in California – Insert the physical address of the nonprofit institution's primary administrative location in California, if different from the mailing address.

Name and contact information of the nonprofit institution's contact person – Insert the name, address, email address, and telephone number of an individual who will function as the nonprofit institution's contact person for the purposes of the Application for Verification.

<u>Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN)</u> – Insert the FEIN the Internal Revenue Service assigned when the nonprofit institution was applying for an exemption.

<u>Corporation or Organization Number</u> - All California and foreign businesses that have qualified to do business in California are assigned an entity number by the California Secretary of State. Insert that number here.

Provide the effective date and a full description of the transaction converting the institution from for-profit to nonprofit status, including all agreements entered into between the nonprofit institution and the for-profit institution, all related financial information, and a statement from the nonprofit institution's board of directors as to why they believe the transaction is or was necessary or desirable.

PART B, QUESTIONS 2 AND 3

"Fair value" shall be demonstrated through one of the following: (1) A third-party appraisal based on comparable assets acquired by, or goods or services procured by, nonprofit corporations in similar market conditions.

(2) Independent financing of the acquisition or procurement based upon the asset acquired or goods or services procured. (3) Full and open competition in the acquisition of the assets or procurement of the goods or services. (Ed. Code, § 94874.1, subd. (c).)

The completed Application for Verification must be uploaded on the Attorney General's website at https://oag.ca.gov/charities, and shall be submitted in one (1) hard copy or one (1) electronic copy on a compact disc or flash drive.

Signature, Title, and Date – I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that I have reviewed this application, including accompanying documents, and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the content is true, correct and complete, and I am authorized to sign.
