## Application for License to Manufacture Firearms and Centralized List of Firearms Manufacturers INSTRUCTIONS



Penal Code section 29010 states that a "person, firm, or corporation shall not manufacture more than three firearms within this state in a calendar year unless that person, firm or corporation is licensed pursuant to Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 29030)" by the Department of Justice (DOJ) and placed on DOJ's Centralized List of Firearms Manufacturers.

All applications must be typed or printed in ink. The application must be completed and signed.

- Part A Provide the information requested in the spaces provided.
- Part B All individuals who are sole owners and all individuals who hold authority over, direct, control, or have any influence over the administration or operation of the business entity engaged in the manufacture of firearms must possess a current, valid DOJ Certificate of Eligibility (COE) and must be listed in this section as licensees. Such individuals include, but are not limited to: trustees, officers, conservators, and directors. Use additional copies of the application form as necessary for all licensees.
- Part C Each licensee must sign and date the application. Use additional copies of the application form as necessary for all licensees.

All initial applications must be accompanied by the by copies of the following:

- The appropriate Federal Firearms License (FFL) for manufacturing as described by Penal Code section 29050.
- 2) Any regulatory or business license, or licenses, required by local government.
- 3) A valid seller's permit or resale certificate issued by the State Board of Equalization, if applicable.

DOJ must have current copies of the above listed licenses in order to process renewal applications. If any of of the above listed licenses on file with DOJ have expired, submit a copy of the current license with your renewal application to ensure expeditious processing.

All applications must be accompanied by the appropriate fee in the form of a check or money order payable to the "Department of Justice". The fee listing is as follows:

- \$250 Manufacturers who produce between 4 and 499 firearms in a calendar year.
- \$600 Manufacturers who produce 500 or more firearms in a calendar year.

Incomplete applications, unsigned applications, and/or applications with missing or incorrect fee remittances will be rejected by DOJ and returned unprocessed.

## **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

A firearms manufacturer licensed pursuant to Penal Code section 29050 who uses a subcontractor(s) who is exempt from licensing as a firearms manufacturer must maintain on file with DOJ a current Use of Exempted Subcontractor Self-Certification form (BOF 957). A copy of this form is provided for your convenience with this application.

Any subcontractor engaged by a licensed firearms manufacturer must maintain with DOJ a current Exempt Subcontractor Self-Certification form (BOF 958) identifying the licensed firearms manufacturer as its contractor, or the manufacturer's California Firearms Manufacturer License is subject to revocation. The licensed firearms manufacturer must ensure the subcontractor(s) maintains a current certification with DOJ declaring its contract(s) with the licensee. It is recommended you coordinate the filing of this form with your subcontractors, where applicable.
