The Department does not estimate firearms dealers to incur any additional cost to comply with the revised regulation. Firearms dealers are already required by regulation to submit a hard-copy form to renew their placement on the Centralized List of Firearms Dealers. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 11, § 4018.) This regulatory proposal codifies the existing renewal process by replacing BOF 4080 with a separate renewal form that will include the certification required by Penal Code section 26806.
