Bargain Buy-in

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Kings Card Club may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-004234) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Kings Card Club at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- The required amount a player must buy-in for and the corresponding amount of bonus chips he/she will earn.
- The time required to play in order to retain the earned bonus chips.
- The number of participants that the promotion is limited to.
- The number of times per day a player may participate.
- Procedures to redeem the additional chips.
- Time requirements in order to keep the additional chips.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Games

Object and Summary

This promotion will award players who play during the pre-determined and designated posted hours with instant cash in the form of card room chips. For example, players will receive a fixed amount of \$60.00 in chips for the purchase price of \$30.00 in cash during live play. Players will receive the chips at the time they buy-in. Players are required to play between one and four hours to retain the additional bonus chips. Players must play for the required one to four hours or go bust. Players shall be required to fulfill the pre-determined and designated time in order to keep the bonus chips. If the player has lost all of their chips before they have fulfilled the required amount of time, including the bonus chips, then they have fulfilled the time requirement. In the event that a customer has to leave before the required amount of playing time has been fulfilled, then that customer shall return the entire bonus chip amount or any remaining amount of chips up to the bonus chip amount, as long as they have enough left in play. If the amount of chips left in play does not equal the amount of bonus chips given, the Kings Card Club shall not require a player to pay the difference.

In order to keep track of the bonus chip distribution and time of play, a floor person shall maintain a daily log during the promotional period, which shall be used to track the time of play for each player that participates. The log will contain the player's first and last name, the current date, time in, time out, and the starting and ending date of the promotional period in which players may participate in the promotion. Each daily log sheet will be manually recorded, tracked, maintained, and stored by the Kings Card Club in an Excel file. It is the player's

responsibility to sign in at the start of their game with the floor manager, as well as to sign out with the floor manager when they leave.

Eligibility

- The required buy-in shall range from \$10 to \$100 in order to qualify for the bonus casino chips.

- A player is eligible to participate in this promotion once per one to four hour promotional period.

Prize

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion features a fixed prize element ranging in value from \$5 to \$200 in the form of casino chips, as pre-determined and designated by the Kings Card Club.

Funding

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion shall be fully funded by the Kings Card Club. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate. All collection fees and table limits are for the designated controlled game and are Bureau approved, pre-determined, and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

The Kings Card Club shall not retain an administrative fee as the gaming activity is funded by the Kings Card Club.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Hold'em Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot

Advertisement Requirements

The Kings Card Club may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-004232) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this jackpot, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Kings Card Club at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Qualifying winning and losing hands and corresponding prize amount.
- Prize payout structure.
- The amount by which the jackpots increase daily.
- Jackpot prize amount.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply to these jackpots.

Eligible Controlled Game

The Hold'em Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at the Kings Card Club, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Texas Hold'em (GEGA-004248)

Object and Summary

The Hold'em Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot features a progressive jackpot prize pool. A prize is awarded to players participating in a jackpot game when a designated second hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand at the showdown. When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with the qualifying jackpot hands shall receive the posted percentage of the progressive jackpot prize. Additionally, a posted percentage of the jackpot prize, referred to as the table share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying tables who have participated in the designated game, as shown below.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make the following advertised hands shall be eligible to win their share of each of the Hold'em Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot prize amounts, as shown below. Only winning and losing hands that have been Bureau approved and pre-determined and designated by the Kings Card Club are eligible. In order to qualify for the jackpots, in games utilizing hole cards, both the winning and losing hands must use two hole cards and three board cards. All qualifying hands listed below shall be offered together at all times.

Hold'em Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at an above listed game during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of 4 players for No Limit games or 5 players for Limit games are required to be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a floor person will verify that both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- The players with the qualifying winning and losing hands must complete the applicable bets on each round and play through the final betting round (the showdown) in order to qualify for the jackpot.
- The player or players will only receive the highest jackpot that occurred, not all the possible jackpot combinations that occurred on the particular hand.
- In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying losing or winning hands, all players with qualifying losing and winning poker hands shall split the posted percentage of the jackpot prize for the losing and/or winning hand equally. The remaining players, which do not include players that received a qualifying losing or winning hand, shall receive the posted prize percentage of the table share, if applicable.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the jackpot.
- Only off duty Third Party Players are eligible to participate in this gaming activity.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in the jackpot as long as they are playing while they are off-duty.

Prize

The Big Super Bad Beat Jackpot prize amount is a progressive amount ranging between \$1,000 and \$300,000. The Small Super Bad Beat Jackpot prize amount is a progressive amount ranging between \$500 and \$100,000. The Big Super Bad Beat Jackpot and the Small Super Bad Beat Jackpot prize pools shall both increase daily in amounts ranging between \$5 and \$1,000. All jackpots shall be paid in the form of cash or chips. The actual prize amounts shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at and how much time has accumulated in order for the jackpot to increase progressively each day.

Prize Pavout Structure

Players that make the designated qualifying hands will be eligible to win their share of the Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot prize amount, based on the payout table being used, as shown below. Only one of these prize payout structure options shall be offered at any one time that the Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpots are being offered for play. They shall not be offered together at any time nor may any combination of the prize payout structure options be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered. Patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of which prize payout structure option is being offered for play. Once a prize payout structure option is designated by the Casino, the payout structure shall not be adjusted or changed until the jackpot has been hit and awarded.

^{*}The table share shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the table who are participating in a designated game that is eligible for the jackpot when the jackpot is awarded.

<u>Funding</u>

The Hold'em Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot utilizes two progressive jackpot prize pools which will be funded by a \$1 jackpot collection fee that will be taken from the pot. All fee collections and table limits are for the designated controlled game and is Bureau approved, predetermined, and posted at each table. The Big Super Bad Beat Jackpot shall be initially seeded by the Kings Card Club in an amount ranging between \$1,000 and \$100,000. The Small Super Bad Beat Jackpot shall be initially seeded by the Kings Card Club in an amount ranging between \$500 and \$50,000. The House will be reimbursed the seed money once the funds have been collected. The jackpot will not increase past the initial seeding amount until the house is reimbursed. After the house has been paid back the initial seed amount, the jackpot funds will go directly to the jackpot prize pools. The Big Super Bad Beat Jackpot and the Small Super Bad Beat Jackpot prize pools shall both increase daily in amounts ranging between \$5 and \$1,000. Furthermore, the Big Super Bad Beat Jackpot shall have a cap amount ranging between \$5,000 and \$300,000. The Small Super Bad Beat Jackpot shall have a cap amount ranging between \$3,000 and \$100,000. Under no circumstances shall the jackpot cap amount be decreased once determined and posted. Once the jackpot has reached the cap, the future collected funds shall go into a reserve account. When either jackpot is hit, the reserve fund from the player jackpot funds will be used to reseed the jackpot in the amount ranging between \$1,000 and \$100,000 for the Big Super Bad Beat Jackpot and between \$500 and \$50,000 for the Small Super Bad Beat Jackpot.

Administrative Fees

The Kings Card Club shall retain an \$8.00 per table per hour administrative fee for the Hold'em Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot. The administrative fee will be used to cover the cost of marketing and operating the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

All persons wishing to participate on a No Purchase Necessary (NPN) basis will be accommodated by asking a Casino Floor Manager for a NPN table to be set up. This will be accomplished within a reasonable period of time and the participant will be dealt hands as if it is in a live game. All opportunities to win the promotion will be provided to a person participating at an NPN table in the same procedure and manner as that of a live game. No cash, collection, or Casino gaming chips will be used at the NPN table. The casino dealer or floor manager will play the hands of the unoccupied seats to simulate a full game.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Kings Card Club at all times the gaming activity is being offered:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Qualifying losing hands.
- The prize amount that shall be awarded.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply.

Controlled Game

The Kings Cracked Promotion shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at the Kings Card Club, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Texas Hold'em (GEGA-004248)

Object and Summary

The Kings Cracked Promotion gaming activity features a fixed prize element attached to the game listed above. A prize is awarded to the player(s) participating in a game when he/she has a hand containing a pocket pair and is beaten by a better hand at the showdown. The promotion shall vary per month and/or promotion cycle.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make a hand that contains the specific pair of "Pocket Kings" and loses to a better hand will be eligible to win the Kings Cracked prize amount, as shown below. The following qualifying hand chart options shall not be offered together at any time nor may any combination of the different qualifying hand chart options be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered. Only the following hands that have been Bureau approved, predetermined, and designated by the Casino are eligible.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at an above listed controlled game during the pre-determined and specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- There is no minimum or maximum number of players required to be dealt in during a
 qualifying game in order for players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the
 Kings Cracked prize amount.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a floor person will verify that the hand qualifies. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player dealt the qualifying losing hand must use both hole cards.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player must complete all betting rounds of the hand, which includes the pre-flop, the turn, the river, and not fold their hand. If the player goes all-in, this is considered to have completed all bets.
- In order to qualify for the jackpot, the player must lose the hand at the showdown, after the final round of betting.
- In the event that during a round of play, another player has a qualifying hand, the prize will be split equally between qualified players.
- Players are eligible to win this gaming activity more than once.
- Tournament Games are not eligible to participate in the gaming activity.
- Casino employees off duty and out of uniform are eligible to participate and win the promotion at any time.

Prize

A player that receives the qualifying losing hand will receive a fixed amount ranging from \$25 to \$1,000 in the form of cash or chips. The amounts will be pre-determined and prominently posted in the casino.

Funding

The Kings Cracked Promotion gaming activity shall be fully funded by Kings Card Club. There will be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity for players to participate. All fee collections and table limits are for the designated base games and are Bureau approved, pre-determined and posted at the table.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any additional administrative fees

No Purchase Necessary

The Kings Cracked Promotion gaming activity shall be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary (NPN) game. Kings Card Club shall provide NPN tables for all patrons who request to participate in this promotion without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. The casino dealer will deal a hand to the NPN player and to all other seated positions. The casino dealer will play/monitor all of the hands dealt except for the NPN player's. If one of the qualifying hand(s) is dealt in the community cards, as listed above, the player will be awarded that associated prize or their portion thereof. There shall be no time restriction placed on the NPN player regarding the number of hands dealt. There shall be no live wagering or cash/casino chips used at this table. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Kings Cracked gaming activity. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Match Play Coupon Promotion

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Kings Card Club may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-004236) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Kings Card Club at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Match Play Coupon and/or free play chip value(s).
- Procedures to redeem coupons or free play chips.
- Any other applicable restrictions.

Eligible Controlled Game

The Match Play Coupon Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California controlled games offered at the Kings Card Club at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Patrons are awarded match play or free play coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, etc. Players who receive a match play will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the coupon if he/she places a wager on an eligible game equal to the amount listed on the match play coupon.

Match Play Coupon

The Casino will offer match play coupons having a face value from \$5 to \$500 per coupon. The amount will be clearly stated on the coupon. Each coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) that the voucher may be used on. The wager must be equal to the amount of the match play coupon. When the player uses a match play coupon and the hand loses, the player will only lose his/her original wager and the match play coupon is collected and voided. A player's winning hand will be paid his/her wager as well as the listed amount on the match play coupon. The player-dealer will then have a casino gaming staff member sign the voucher, verifying that it has been won. All winning vouchers are verified and signed by a casino gaming staff member. Winning vouchers are taken to the cage by the casino gaming staff member, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the coupon(s). If a player loses, the money part of the wager is collected by the player-dealer, and the voucher is voided and collected as well. If the player pushes (receives no action), the voucher may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a match play voucher with a value of \$5.00 that specifically states it may be used to place a wager on the Pai Gow Poker table. The person would place the voucher on the gaming table; place a bet that matches the amount on the voucher, and pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play. The collection fee is based only on the wager and not the coupon. If the player wins the hand, he/she will receive \$10.00 just as if they had placed a \$10.00 bet and the player-dealer will collect the voucher.

Match Play Coupon Promotion

Free Play Chip

The Casino will offer free play chips having a face value from \$5.00 to \$500.00 per chip. The free play chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash.

The free play chips shall initially be in the form of a coupon which shall be offered to all patrons that wish to come into the Casino and use them to play. Patrons may be awarded free play coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, etc. When a patron receives a free play coupon he/she shall take the coupon to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the free play chip(s) to be used in a live game. Each coupon shall state the specific qualifying game(s) that the free play chip(s) may be used on.

Free play chips shall be used as the player's bet and placed on the betting circle. Free play chips shall not be paid from the dealer's tray. If the player wins the hand, he/she would be paid \$10.00 by the person in the player-dealer position just as if he/she had placed a \$10 bet. The free play chip will be collected by the person in the player-dealer position. The player-dealer will then have a casino gaming staff member verify that the chip has been played. All played free play chips are verified by a casino gaming staff member. The free play chip is taken to the cage by a casino gaming staff member, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the chip. If the player loses the hand, the free play chip is forfeited and will be collected by the casino dealer and dropped in the drop box for accounting purposes. If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a free play chip coupon for \$10.00 that specifically states it can be used to place a wager on the No Bust Blackjack table. The player would take the coupon to the cage. Cage personnel would log the redemption code of the coupon and exchange the coupon for a promotional free play chip. The player would then place the free play chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection (if applicable), and the game would play.

Eligibility

The promotion will be open to all players who are seated and playing at the above listed games during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the promotion.

- A minimum of one (1) player and a player-dealer are required to be playing in any of the games, as listed above, in order for the game to qualify.
- Each coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) that a player may use the coupon at.
- Players shall not exchange the coupons for live chips or give them to another player.
- Players who receive a Match Play Coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the coupon when they place a wager equal to what is listed on the Match Play Coupon.
- A player using a Match Play Coupon must place a base game wager.
- A player may place a Match Play Coupon on any spot on which the player has placed a wager except bonus spots, Match Play Coupons are not eligible for bonus bets.
- The collection fee is taken on the base game wager only. The coupon does not count as a part of the collection fee.
- A Match Play Coupon must be placed with the base game wager, before any card in the round of play is dealt.

Match Play Coupon Promotion

- Only one Match Play Coupon may be used on the table at any one time. The
 player who presents the first coupon is the player who is permitted to use the
 coupon for that hand. Additional players at the table must wait until subsequent
 rounds are played to use their Match Play Coupon.
- The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a casino gaming staff member.
- Off duty Casino Employees are eligible for the promotion
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible for the promotion.
- Tournament games are not eligible for the promotion.

Prize

The match play coupons and/or free play chips shall have a value ranging from \$5 to \$500 for each coupon or free play chip. Players shall not exchange match play coupons or free play chips for live chips. Additionally, players shall not give match play coupons or free play chips to another player. The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a casino gaming staff member.

Funding

The Match Play Coupon Promotion shall be fully funded by the Kings Card Club. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

No Purchase Necessary

The Match Play Coupon Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Non-Negotiable Chips Promotion

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Kings Card Club may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID, (GEGA-004241), shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Kings Card Club at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games.
- Eligible dates and time period(s).
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Information regarding chips awarded for purchasing non-negotiable chips.
- The amount of times a player may rollover, purchasable increments, the extra bonus amounts and purchase time periods will be up to the casino's discretion.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Game

The Non-Negotiable Chip Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California controlled games offered at the Kings Card Club at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play. All base game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Patrons are awarded non-negotiable chips via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament. Players are also able to purchase bonus non-negotiable chips. Players who receive a non-negotiable chip coupon shall be eligible to receive the specific amount printed on the coupon in individual non-negotiable chips. The player will go to the cage for verification, logging and redemption of the non-negotiable chips to be used in the specified live game. The non-negotiable chips shall be used as the player's wager and placed on the betting circle. The non-negotiable chips shall not be taken into the dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray.

Eligibility

The promotion shall be open to all players who are playing the Bureau approved games of the casino during the pre-determined and specified time period designated for the promotion.

- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required to be playing in any of the games in order for the game to qualify.
- The players can take home the non-negotiable chips and use them at a later date. The non-negotiable chips have no cash value and can not be redeemed for cash at anytime.
- The non-negotiable chips do not expire.
- After the chips make their way back to the cage, after the drop count, the chips are placed back into the inventory rotation for the promotion for use again.
- Casino employees, off duty and out of uniform, are eligible for the promotion.
- The Third-Party Provider is not eligible to participate in this promotion.
- The chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a key employee.

Non-Negotiable Chips Promotion

- Tournament games are not eligible for the promotion.
- Non-negotiable chips shall not be used in tournament games. However, players that sign up for certain tournaments may receive non-negotiable chips.
- Players shall not exchange the coupons or non-negotiable chips for live chips or give them to another player.

Prize

Each non-negotiable chip or coupon has a value ranging from \$5 to \$5,000. Players shall not exchange non-negotiable chips for live chips. Additionally, players shall not give non-negotiable chips to another player.

Non-Negotiable Chips:

A player will receive the advertised amount of non-negotiable chips as specified in the advertised promotion. The non-negotiable chips are of a different style and design from the standard casino chip. The non-negotiable chips can not be exchanged for cash and must be played on the gaming table. Once the non-negotiable chip has been placed as a wager the following applies:

- If the wager wins, the non-negotiable chips are paid with real Casino chips by the player-dealer and the player retains the non-negotiable chips.
- If the player pushes, the chip will remain with the player.

- Non-negotiable chips shall not be used to pay collections.

Purchasing Non-Negotiable Chips:

• The players may purchase non-negotiable chips in increments ranging between \$5 and \$10,000 at the cage. Each increment will be rewarded a certain amount in extra non-negotiable chips ranging between \$5 and \$15,000. The purchasable increments, extra bonus amounts and purchase time periods will be determined by the casino. All patrons will be given ample notice of the rules.

Rollover:

• After a patron has played through their initial allotment of non-negotiable chips, they may purchase more non-negotiable chips with real casino chips. The player will receive another extra bonus amount with the additional purchase. Or the number of additional rollovers will be counted and logged in order for the player to receive another bonus at a later date. The amount of times a player may rollover, purchasable increments, the extra bonus amounts and purchase time periods will be up to the casino's discretion. Patrons will be given ample notice of the rules.

Funding

The promotion shall be fully funded by the casino. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

Non-Negotiable Chips Promotion

<u>Administrative Fees</u>
The Kings Card Club shall not retain an administrative fee as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Non-Negotiable Chips Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with the qualifying jackpot hands shall receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize. Additionally, a posted percentage of the jackpot prize, known as the table share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as shown below.

<u>Funding</u>

The Pai Gow Poker Bad Beat Jackpot utilizes a progressive prize pool which will be player funded via a \$1.00 jackpot collection fee. A collection fee shall be taken from the player-dealer position per hand. Three or more players are required to be dealt in during a Pai Gow Tiles game in order for players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the Pai Gow Tiles Bad Beat Jackpot, as well as for the \$1 jackpot collection fee to be dropped. If there are two or less players dealt in during a Pai Gow Tiles game, the table shall be in-eligible for the Pai Gow Tiles Bad Beat Jackpot and the \$1 jackpot collection fee shall not be dropped. The Jackpot shall be initially seeded by the Kings Card Club in the amount of \$5,000. The House will be reimbursed the seed money from the reserve account once the funds have been collected. The jackpot will not increase past the initial seeding amount until the house is reimbursed. The jackpot collection fees shall then be used to fund the jackpot. Additionally, when the casino is required to seed the jackpot or cover the shortfall due to in-adequate funds in the reserve account, the casino shall be repaid from the jackpot reserve account once the reserve is sufficient and the funds become available. Object and Summary

This gaming activity is a loyalty reward program open to all Kings Card Club patrons. This promotion will reward players with points based on either time of play at designated table games during pre-determined and eligible periods or based on pre-determined and designated qualifying hands. The casino will create a player tracking sheet where player's points, time played, and qualifying hands shall be tracked manually by a floor person on an excel spreadsheet that only Casino management have access to. The tracking sheet shall include the date, the player's first and last name, the start and end time of the game they are playing, and/or the player's total playing time or the qualifying hand. A sample of the excel spreadsheet is attached.

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points shall be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player that plays a certain table game during live play will, at certain times, receive points, which will gain them eligibility to win pre-determined and designated prizes. The range of points will be 1 to 100 points for each hour of play. At the beginning of each hour, players have to check in with a floor person, for their hours to be tracked. The player will have to show their ID to a floor person once he/she takes a seat at the table. He/she will be signed out by the floor supervisor on duty once they

leave the table. If the player forgets to sign in with a floor supervisor or doesn't let the supervisor know when he/she is going to leave the table the player will not receive credit for the time he/she was playing. The hours and points are tracked manually on the excel spreadsheet, as stated above. Prior to the promotional period a sign(s) will state how many points will be earned per hour and any other details and/or restrictions. The Kings Card Club may offer bonus rates (for example, double points) on play during off-peak hours or in specific games, within the range as shown above. Patrons will be given ample notice of how many points will be awarded, as well as, the amount of time required to earn points for each eligible game.

How Points are Redeemed

Players may redeem their points at any time during the promotion or at the end of the promotional period. The redemption period will be displayed in Kings Card Club to give players ample notice. All prizes shall have a pre-determined and designated value. After a player has accumulated a pre-determined and specific amount of points, based on time of play or a qualifying hand, a player may redeem the accrued points for a pre-determined and designated prize.



- Eligible games, dates and time periods.
- Qualifying hands and any restrictions.
- Specific prize amounts.
- No purchase necessary information.
- Any other applicable restrictions.

Eligible Controlled Game

The Poker High Hand Promotion will be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at Kings Card Club as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Poker High Hand Promotion features a promotional element, which shall be attached to the game of Texas Hold'em. Players who achieve the approved highest ranking poker hand of a full house or better, as listed below, during a pre-determined and specified time frame win a prize with a value ranging from \$25 - \$1,000. The Poker High Hand Promotion prize will be awarded on a daily basis. The winning player shall receive the pre-determined posted prize amount for the corresponding qualifying hand. The current qualifying high hands will be prominently displayed in an area of the casino that will be easy to view.

Qualifying Hands

A player is eligible to win this promotion by making the highest ranking hand that meets or exceeds the minimum designated hand, during the posted time period. In the event two or more players tie for the same prize, the prize will be evenly distributed between each tying player.

During the designated time periods, qualifying hands will be recorded in a log by an authorized casino employee. Just after the end of every period, the cashier records the winning high hand for the last designated high hand period. The hand, the time, the date, and the customer's name, are recorded on the log.

 deviation from a standard deck will nullify the promotion.
- Qualifying hands shall be tracked and verified by the floor person and the cage to ensure that proper payout is done.
- There is no minimum or maximum number of players in order to be eligible for the promotion other than what is required in the eligible controlled games rules.
- To qualify for the promotion, the player must complete all the applicable bets on each round. If the player goes "all in" this is considered to have completed all bets.
- Players are eligible to win this gaming activity once per eligible time period. All players will be eligible for this promotion as often as it is offered.

Furthermore, the amount of the prize shall be displayed prominently within Kings Card Club at all times the Poker High Hand Promotion is being offered for play.

Funding

The Poker High Hand Promotion will be fully funded by Kings Card Club. There will be no additional promotional fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity for players to participate. - The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament.
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid.
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid.
- Any other restrictions that apply to the Poker Tournament.
- The amount that shall be withheld from the buy-ins to fund free roll tournaments.

Tournament Log

For each tournament conducted a Tournament Log must be completed. The log must be retained by the cardroom for seven years and available upon request from the Bureau during all hours of operation. The log should contain the following information:

- Day, date, time and name advertised for the tournament
- Total number of tables used
- Method of entry and amount of any entry fees
- Number and amount of any re-buys and/or add-ons offered
- Name of controlled games offered
- Source of all funds for tournament prize pool
- Name of each fee charged, amount of each fee charged, total number of each fee collected, and cumulative amount of each fee charged
- Number of entries
- Amount of the prize pool
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool
- Name of gaming activities offered (when applicable)
 - o Funding source
 - o Prize amount
 - Total number of prizes awarded
 - o Total amount deducted from prize pool (when applicable)
- Results of the tournament, including the amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament
- Signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament

Poker Tournaments

Gaming Activities Offered During Tournament Play

Bounties

Bounty targets are tournament players who are selected prior to the start of the tournament. During the play of a tournament, either a single player or multiple players in a tournament may be designated as bounty targets. If a bounty target player loses all of their tournament chips during a hand of play and is eliminated from the tournament, the winner of that hand shall win a pre-determined and designated amount of money ranging in value between \$1 and \$10,000. The bounty money may be deducted from the tournament prize pool or may be guaranteed and paid for by Kings Card Club. Patrons shall be given notice of how the activity shall be funded prior to the tournament being offered.

Points System

Object and Summary

During specified tournaments, Kings Card Club may offer a predetermined amount of points that will entitle a player to a prize and/or entry into a grand finale tournament. The range of points will be from 5-25. Points are non-transferrable and will only be valid for specific time purposes.

Eligibility Requirements

 Casino employees are eligible when off duty. Poker proposition players are not eligible to participate in Poker Tournaments.

Prize

Players may qualify for prizes ranging in value from \$5-\$100,000. Prizes shall be in the form of fixed cash amounts, merchandise, jewelry, trips, tournament chips, and vehicles. Players may also gain entry into a future tournament by utilizing the Points System.

Fundina

The Points System will be house funded.

Freeroll Tournament

- A freeroll tournament shall be offered at Kings Card Club.
- Entry is gained via Bureau approved promotions earned during specified tournament play. This shall be displayed prior to the start of any qualifying tournament.
- The freeroll tournament prize pool is funded by an amount ranging from \$1-\$1,000, which is taken from the buy-in for each tournament
- The house may add extra funds, ranging between \$0 and \$25,000, to the existing freeroll tournament prize pool to increase the amount.

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure shall be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament shall not change once sign-ups begin.
- Promotional materials shall not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided shall be equal and posted for all players.

- Partial entry can also be used to offset full entry fees for specified tournaments.

^{*\$1-\$1,000} from every buy-in shall be placed into a prize pool to fund free roll tournaments.

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

The prizes will be the cumulative amount of buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. The prizes may also be guaranteed. The cardroom may provide prizes or add funds to the prize pool for special events.

- When the prize amount is guaranteed, the payouts will be a cash value ranging from \$5 -\$100,000. The cash will be paid to players from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. If there is not enough cash to cover the guaranteed prize amount, Kings Card Club will fund the difference.

Object and Summary

The Pot Splash Bonus gaming activity features a promotional element which shall be attached to Texas Hold'em. During pre-determined times and intervals of the promotional period, a floor person shall begin the "Pot Splash Bonus" by adding a pre-determined and posted prize to the pot at the start of the next hand.

The method for determining which table will receive the posted "Pot Splash Bonus" prize involves a drawing where a non-electronic randomizer shall be used. The cards or lamers, which are pre-printed, equally sized and colored, shall be mixed within the randomizer. During pre-determined times and intervals of the promotional period, a casino employee shall announce the commencement of the drawing. The casino employee shall then select one (1) eligible table by randomly choosing a card or other lamer from the randomizer. Each card or lamer shall depict a number that corresponds to each eligible poker table. Once the table number is determined, the employee shall place the pre-determined and posted prize ranging in value from \$25 to \$1,000 into the pot on the table, at the start of the next hand. Betting procedures and play shall proceed as a normal round of play would. The player with the winning hand shall win the pot, including the added prize amount. In the event of a tie, the winning players shall split the pot evenly. In the event that the prize is merchandise or an item, players with tie hands will be awarded identical prizes. The regular pot shall be split according to standard poker rules.

Pot Splash Bonus

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled game during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A player is eligible to win this promotion by winning the round of poker at the table number that is designated by the drawing.
- The round of play will continue until a winner is determined.

No Purchase Necessary

The Pot Splash Bonus promotion will be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. Kings Card Club shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. Within a reasonable amount of time of a No Purchase Necessary player requesting to play one of the specific games within the gaming activity, a No Purchase Necessary table will be made available. The casino dealer will deal a hand to the No Purchase

Necessary player and to all other seated positions. The casino dealer will play/monitor all of the hands dealt except for the No Purchase Necessary player's. If one of the qualifying hand(s) is dealt in the community cards, as listed above, the player will be awarded that associated prize or their portion thereof. There shall be no time restriction placed on the No Purchase Necessary player regarding the number of hands dealt. There shall be no live wagering or cash/casino chips used at this table. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Pot Splash Bonus promotion. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Object and Summary

The Kings Card Club will reward players with tickets based on pre-determined and designated qualifying hands at designated table games during pre-determined and eligible periods. A player that obtains a qualifying hand, as listed below, during a pre-determined and posted time period, shall be awarded a raffle ticket. The raffle ticket enters the player into a drawing to win a predetermined, posted prize in the form of cash, chips, or prizes. Once a qualifying hand is achieved, a floor person will verify the qualifying hand. After the qualifying hand has been verified, the ticket will be divided into two halves; one half will be placed in the drum, while the other half will be given to the player. The player's name and contact information will be written on the Casino's portion of the ticket and placed in a secured raffle bin that is under twenty-four hour surveillance. Once it is time to draw the tickets, all qualifying tickets will be spun and mixed in the drum, then the ticket will be chosen at random. Players will have two minutes to claim their prize. If after two minutes the player does not come forth to claim their prize, another ticket will be drawn, and the ticket that was not claimed will be placed back in the drum. All non-winning tickets will be saved and held for a larger drawing at the end of the month; dates and times will be posted before the start of any monthly drawing.

Three Card Poker 6 Card Bonus (GEGA-004246)

Object and Summary

The Three Card Poker Progressive considers the best possible hand among each individual player's first three cards dealt. The player-dealer's hand is not used in any way to make or aid in the qualifying hand.

- To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may optionally place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1.
- A "Hockey Puck" disc will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
- Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Coin In" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees are dropped in a separate and locked jackpot collection box affixed to the left side of the gaming table.
- The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game.

Qualifying Hands

When a player is dealt an ace, king and queen, of spades, they are paid 100% of the jackpot prize shown on the progressive meter. When a player is dealt an ace, king and queen with a suit of either hearts, diamonds or clovers, they will win 10% of the posted jackpot shown on the progressive meter. Any Straight Flush, a hand consisting of three cards of the same suit in consecutive ranking, other than ace, king and queen, receives a fixed prize amount. A player paying the \$1 jackpot fee also qualifies to win an Envy payout. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an Envy pay, all other players who paid the \$1 jackpot fee win the Envy pay. The player hitting the hand receives the normal prize pay only, but does NOT receive the envy pay for their own hand. All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required to play for the progressive jackpot.
- Only active players, who have placed an Ante wager and are dealt a designated hand, are eligible for the jackpot.
- There is no restriction on the number of times a player can win a fixed or progressive prize during any promotional period.
- The player-dealer's hand is not used in any way to make or aid in the qualifying hand.
- Backline bettors are not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee or receive a prize.
- In the event two or more players have qualifying hands during a round of play, each player will receive the posted prize amount for their designated hand.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Three Card Poker Progressive prize only when off duty and out of uniform.
- Player's may play up to 3 spots adjacent as long as they place an ante bet on each hand.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible for this promotion.
- A Third-Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) is not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the Three Card Poker Progressive gaming activity when either in the player-dealer or player capacity.

Prize

The progressive prize will increase every time a jackpot fee is collected and placed on the progressive prize meter. The progressive and fixed prizes will be paid out in live casino chips. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, a casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from Kings Card Club dealer's tray.

Progressive Winners:

- When a player achieves the qualifying hand of ace, king, and queen, the house dealer shall then contact a casino representative.
- Once a casino representative verifies the progressive win, the casino representative shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager.
- The prize is paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter based on the payout table above. All other hands are paid from the reserve fund; they do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter.
- In the event of more than one progressive meter pay or any other qualifying hand hits during the same round, all winning players will be paid the posted progressive prize or the posted fixed amount.
- When more than one progressive meter pay hits, one progressive payout will be paid from the meter and the others will be paid from the reserve fund. If there are not enough funds in the reserve account, Kings Card Club shall cover the payout and will not be reimbursed.

Fixed Prize:

- When a player is dealt a Straight Flush, they are paid a fixed prize amount according to the payout table above.
- All fixed payouts will be paid by a casino representative.
- All fixed payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund. If there are not enough funds in the reserve account, Kings Card Club shall cover the payout and will not be reimbursed.

Envy Bonus:

- If a player's hand triggers an envy payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the house dealer will lock up the cards. The house dealer will then move on to the next player.
- The house dealer pays any envy bonuses at the end of the round. In the event more than one player is involved in a qualifying envy pay, then all players win multiple envy payouts excluding their own hand.

Funding

All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that will be maintained for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

The Three Card Poker Progressive is a player funded jackpot featuring both fixed and progressive prize elements. Kings Card Club will initially seed the jackpot at \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Three Card Poker Progressive fund, the initial \$1,000 will be reimbursed to Kings Card Club.

Each \$1 jackpot fee paid by a player will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.20 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- \$0.80 will be tracked in a reserve fund. The reserve fund will be utilized to immediately re-seed the metered progressive jackpot prize. In addition, this reserve fund will payout all fixed amounts.

There is no cap on the progressive prize pool. The prize pool will be re-seeded when the progressive jackpot is awarded to a player(s). The re-seed amount will be between \$100 and \$25,000 and come from the reserve account. Object and Summary

The prize wheel will have 4-64 spots with prizes ranging from \$10 to \$10,000 including one or more "double" spot(s). Players may earn the opportunity to spin the prize wheel in one of two ways.

<u>Funding</u>

Players that make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown above, will be eligible to win their share of the posted EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot V2 prize amounts, according to the payout option as shown below. Patrons will be provided with ample advance notice of the prize payout being offered for play. Furthermore, it will be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot V2 is being offered for play.

<u>Funding</u>

The EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot V2 is a player-funded jackpot with both fixed and progressive elements, which is funded by an optional \$5 jackpot fee. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at a minimum of \$1,000 to a maximum of \$50,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot V2 reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and will be documented in the accounting records.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded from the reserve fund at an amount between \$1,000 and \$50,000. In addition, this reserve fund will payout all fixed prize amounts. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the re-seed amount and any shortfalls made up by the Casino, will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and will be documented in the accounting records. All increases and decreases to the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot V2 reserve fund will be documented in the accounting records.

Each \$5 jackpot fee will be broken down as follows:

- a. \$0.20 shall be immediately posted on the meter.
- b. \$0.80 shall be tracked in a reserve fund.

All monies collected and paid out will be tracked both electronically and on an excel spreadsheet that will be maintained by the gambling establishment, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel. There is no cap to the jackpot.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will retain an administrative fee ranging in an amount between \$10 and \$50, taken per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee will cover the cost associated with the complicated computer system and program in addition to technicians having to service the systems.

No Purchase Necessary

The EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot V2 will be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino will provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material will state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot V2. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this gaming activity has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI). If there is a malfunction or the digital reader breaks, the jackpot will not be offered.

- When a player has a progressive qualifying hand, the house dealer will press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer will then contact a supervisor.
- Once a supervisor verifies the progressive win, the supervisor will press the confirm button. To complete the action, a supervisor or executive card (depending on jackpot level) swipe is required. This records the win onto the Game Manager computer and adjusts the meter appropriately for the prize won. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize. (Reviewing the monitor connected to the Game Manager will show the prize amount to be paid, and pressing the "money bag" icon will print a win page, which can be used to help record the payout for accounting).
- When the house dealer reconciles all action, he/she presses "END GAME." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- Once the supervisor or executive card (depending on jackpot level) is swiped the prize is logged into Game Manager.
 - If the progressive pay needs to be backed out (voided) at this point, the prize will need to be manually backed out using the Game Manager manual adjustment feature.
