The Bureau reserves the right to: (1) review the lawfulness of Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot; (2) notify all law enforcement agencies and gambling establishments if further review determines Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot to be unlawful; (3) require gambling establishments to cease and desist offering for play Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot if found to be unlawful; and (4) take action against those gambling establishments that decline to abide by the Bureau's cease and desist notification.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Limelight Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001192) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands
- Prize payout structure
- The prize amount to be awarded
- Availability of Alternative Prize Option & corresponding value
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at Limelight Card Room, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Pure 21.5 Blackjack (GEGA-003252)

Object and Summary

A player that receives one of the qualifying hands listed below for the Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot is eligible to win either a fixed amount prize or the progressive prize.

- 1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. Players may optionally place any bonus bets and optional \$1 jackpot fee. Players who do not make a base game wager are not eligible to place a jackpot fee.
- 2. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a live casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
 - a. Should the sensor malfunction, the chips will be returned to the players and no jackpot will be offered during that time, until the malfunction is fixed.

Qualifying Hands

Players who make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown below, shall be eligible to win their share of the posted prize amount, according to the posted payout options. The qualifying hands are based on the player's initial two cards and the player-dealer's face-up card. All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two seated players, the player and the player-dealer, are required to be dealt in the base game to be eligible for the jackpot.
- A player may qualify for the jackpot regardless of the outcome of the controlled game.
- There is no limit on the number of times a player may win a prize during any given promotional period.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in the gaming activity when they are off duty and out of uniform.
- A minimum of two decks must be used in the base game in order for the table to qualify for this promotion.
- Backline bettors are not eligible for this promotion.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible for this promotion.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible for this promotion.

Prize

All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log and will be maintained by the gambling enterprise, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

- 1. Three 7s of the same color is paid 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.
- 2. All other hands are paid a fixed amount from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the

casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve account.

- 3. In the event more than one progressive meter pay or any other qualifying hand hits during the same round, all winning players will share, in equal amounts, the posted progressive prize or the posted fixed amount. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve account.
- 4. When a player has a progressive winning hand, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- 5. The house dealer shall then contact a supervisor.

All prizes will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray; the live casino chips will come from the cage. All fixed payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund. Any prize payouts over \$10,000 will be paid to the winner the following day via a check.

Alternative Prize Option

When predetermined and offered, winners of the jackpot will have the option to claim a prize in the form of merchandise, vehicle, trips, gift certificates, clothing, jewelry, or tournament entries (GEGA-001950) in lieu of the entire posted jackpot prize. The merchandise will be assigned a monetary value that will be less than the actual retail value. The cost assigned will be reimbursed to Limelight Card Room and any difference will be borne solely by the gambling establishment. Only one item will be offered and it will be up to the winners to decide who will get it. If the players cannot come to an agreement, the prize will be awarded as normal.

- Once a winner is determined, the chosen player must decide how they will claim their jackpot prize.
 - Either the original prize or a combination of the original prize and the posted merchandise.
- One Alternative Prize Option (when offered) will be available per jackpot.
- All eligibility and prizes will be predetermined and posted.

Funding

The Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot is a player-funded progressive jackpot which features both progressive and fixed prizes.

The \$1 jackpot fee paid by each player will be broken down as follows:

- a. \$0.20 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- b. \$0.80 will be tracked in the reserve fund.

Limelight Card Room will initially seed the jackpot at a minimum of \$1,000 to a maximum of \$50,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the initial seed amount will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. There is no cap to the Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot fund.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded by the reserve fund at an amount ranging between a minimum of \$1,000 and a maximum of \$50,000. In addition, the reserve fund will be used to pay out all fixed prize amounts. In the event that the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall. Once there are sufficient monies in the Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the re-seed amount will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. All increases and decreases to the Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot fund shall be documented in the accounting records.

Administrative Fees

Limelight Card Room will take an administrative fee ranging from \$10-\$16 per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee will cover the costs associated with the complicated computer system and program in addition to technicians having to service the systems.

No Purchase Necessary

The Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Blazing Sevens Progressive Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this gaming activity has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the supervisor will press the confirm button. To complete the action, a casino representative's card swipe is required. This records the win onto the Game Manager computer and adjusts the meter appropriately for the prize won. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize. (Reviewing the monitor connected to the Game Manager will show the prize amount to be paid, and pressing the "money bag" icon will print a win page, which can be used to help record the payout for accounting.)
- 2. Once the house dealer reconciles all action, the house dealer presses "End Game." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- 3. Once the casino representative's card is swiped the prize is logged into Game Manager. If the progressive pay needs to be backed out at this point, the prize will need to be manually backed out using the Game Manager manual adjustment feature.

- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at Limelight Card Room, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• EZ Baccarat Panda 8 (GEGA-004006)

Object and Summary

The EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot adds optional \$1.00 player-funded progressive and fixed jackpot elements to the game of EZ Baccarat Panda 8 (GEGA-004006). The EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot considers both the player and banker hands. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. Players may place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1.00. Once the house dealer removes all jackpot fees from the table, the jackpot fees will be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection box. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. A player is NOT required to place a wager on the Dragon 7 Bonus Bet or the Panda 8 Bonus Bet in order to be eligible to place an optional \$1.00 jackpot fee on the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot. When a winning hand is confirmed, the player with the qualifying jackpot hand will receive either a posted percentage of the progressive jackpot prize or a fixed prize, depending on the winning qualifying hand.

- 1. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
- 2. Once all players have placed their base wagers and optional jackpot fees, the house dealer will press "Start Game" on the keypad. Dragon 7 - Player 0	The bankers hand wins with a three-card total of 7 points and the player hand totals 0.
Banker Two-Card 7 - Player 0	The banker hand wins with a two-card total of 7 points and the player hand totals 0.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- There is no time requirement for how long a game must be played in order to be eligible for an EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot payout.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player may win a fixed or progressive prize during any given promotional period for the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot.
- A player must make a base game wager in order to be eligible for this jackpot.
- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required in order for the table to be eligible to participate in the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot.
- A player can qualify for the jackpot regardless of the outcome of the base game.
- Casino employees are eligible for the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot when they are off duty and out of uniform.

Funding

The EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot is a player-funded jackpot with both fixed and progressive elements, which is funded by an optional \$1.00 jackpot fee. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at a minimum of \$1,000 to a maximum of \$50,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and will be documented in the accounting records. After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded from the reserve fund at an amount between \$1,000 and \$50,000. In addition, this reserve fund will payout all fixed prize amounts. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the re-seed amount and any shortfalls made up by the Casino, will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and will be documented in the accounting records. All increases and decreases to the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot reserve fund will be documented in the accounting records.

Each \$1.00 jackpot fee will be broken down as follows:

- a. \$0.15 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- b. \$0.85 will be tracked in a reserve fund.

All monies collected and paid out will be tracked both electronically and on an excel spreadsheet that will be maintained by the gambling establishment, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel. There is no cap to the jackpot.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will retain an administrative fee ranging in an amount between \$5 and \$20, taken per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee will cover the cost associated with the complicated computer system and program in addition to technicians having to service the systems.

No Purchase Necessary

The EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot will be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino will provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material will state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the EZ Baccarat Progressive Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this gaming activity has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI). If there is a malfunction or the digital reader breaks, the jackpot will not be offered.

- When a player has a progressive qualifying hand, the house dealer will press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer will then contact a supervisor.
- Once a supervisor verifies the progressive win, the supervisor will press the confirm button. To complete the action, a supervisor or executive card (depending on jackpot level) swipe is required. This records the win onto the Game Manager computer and adjusts the meter appropriately for the prize won. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize. (Reviewing the monitor connected to the Game Manager will show the prize amount to be paid, and pressing the "money bag" icon will print a win page, which can be used to help record the payout for accounting).
- When the house dealer reconciles all action, he/she presses "END GAME." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- Once the supervisor or executive card (depending on jackpot level) is swiped the prize is logged into Game Manager.
 - If the progressive pay needs to be backed out (voided) at this point, the prize will need to be manually backed out using the Game Manager manual adjustment feature.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and the restrictions for those hands
- Prize payout structure
- Jackpot prize amount
- Alternative Prize Option and amount
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Fixed Jackpot shall be attached to all Bureau approved poker games offered at Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Fixed Jackpot features a house funded fixed prize element ranging in value from \$100 to \$100,000. A prize is awarded to players participating in a jackpot game when a designated second hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand at the showdown. When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with the qualifying jackpot hands shall receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize. Additionally, a posted percentage of the jackpot prize, known as the table share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as shown below. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the rules and restrictions when completing a qualifying jackpot hand. Furthermore, the jackpot prize shall be displayed prominently within Limelight Card Room at all times the jackpot is being offered for play.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make the following qualifying hands shall be eligible to win their share of the Fixed Jackpot prize amount, as shown below. Only a winning and losing hand that has been Bureau approved and predetermined and designated by Limelight Card Room is eligible. Patrons shall be given ample notice of the specific hands that are being offered. Furthermore, the qualifying jackpot hands shall be displayed prominently within Limelight Card Room at all times.

Fixed Jackpot Qualifying Hands

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of five (5) players are required to be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- In order to qualify for the jackpot in games utilize hole cards, the winning and losing hands must use two (2) hole cards.
- Any communication that a player has a winning jackpot hand prior to the opening of the hands to determine the winner of the game will be declared a violation and disqualify the hand.
- Players with qualifying winning and losing hands must play through the final betting round, in order to qualify for the jackpot. If a player with one of the qualifying hands folds prior to the final betting round, the table will be in-eligible for the jackpot.
- In the event that during a round of play, two (2) or more players have qualifying losing or winning hands, only the player with the highest ranked losing and winning poker hands will receive the posted prize percentage of the jackpot for the losing and winning hand. The remaining player(s), including those who had lower ranked qualifying hands, will receive the posted prize percentage of the table share.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative will verify that both hands qualify and that no collusion, cheating, or other rules were violated. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- If, for any reason the prize payout is not awarded due to possible cheating or other rule violations, the camera recording of the event will be saved for the Department of Justice and/or law enforcement review. The event will be documented by a casino representative and witnessed by the house dealer.
- Once the verification process is completed, a casino representative will inform the eligible players that they have won the posted prizes amounts and the payout process will proceed.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Fixed Jackpot when off duty and out of uniform.

<u>Prize</u>

The jackpot prize for the Fixed Jackpot is a fixed amount ranging from \$100 to \$100,000. The actual jackpot prize amount shall be posted at all times. All jackpots shall be paid in the form of cash or check and will be paid after hand verification by a casino representative. The Limelight Card Room reserves the right to pay any winning amount over \$5,000 by check only, for security reasons and may require a 48-hour wait to issue payment due to holidays, or availability of someone with check signing privileges. All proper Internal Revenue Service and additional required paperwork will be completed with payment.

Alternative Prize Option

When predetermined and offered, winners of the jackpot will have the option to claim a prize in the form of merchandise, vehicle, trips, gift certificates, clothing, jewelry, or tournament entries (GEGA-001950) in lieu of the entire posted jackpot prize. The merchandise will be assigned a monetary value that will be less than the actual retail value. The cost assigned will be reimbursed to Limelight Card Room and any difference will be borne solely by the gambling establishment. Only one item will be offered and it will be up to the winners to decide who will get it. If the players cannot come to an agreement, the prize will be awarded as normal.

Fixed Jackpot

Example: The Fixed Jackpot using "Option A" of the prize payout structure, shown below is hit at \$8,000. A Vespa scooter that cost \$2,381 will be displayed in the gambling establishment with an assigned value of \$2,000. In this example, a player that is awarded the "Losing Share" of the Fixed Jackpot would receive \$4,800 of the total \$8,000. The player will have the option of taking all of the posted prize or taking \$2,800 and the scooter which will total \$4,800. The Casino will be reimbursed (from the jackpot prize pool) only \$2,000 and they will expense the remainder (\$381) within their bookkeeping records. The rest of the jackpot prize will be awarded as normal.

- Once a winner is determined, the chosen player must decide how they will claim their jackpot prize.
 - Either the original prize or a combination of the original prize and the posted merchandise.
- One Alternative Prize Option (when offered) will be available per jackpot; or one Alternative Prize option per multiple jackpots.
 - **Example:** A Vespa scooter would be available for the Fixed Jackpot and the Progressive Jackpot prize. If a player wins and selects the prize, the same prize will also be available for the other jackpot if/when hit.
- All eligibility and prizes will be predetermined and posted.

Prize Payout Structure

Players that make the qualifying jackpot hands, as shown in the chart above, shall be eligible to win their share of the Fixed Jackpot prize amount, based on the payout table being used, as shown below. A posted percentage of the jackpot prize, known as the table share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as shown below. Patrons shall be given ample notice of the specific payout structure that is being utilized for the jackpot. Only one distribution chart shall be offered at any one time. Furthermore, the prize payout structure shall be displayed prominently within Limelight Card Room at all times.

Funding

The Fixed Jackpot utilizes a fixed prize which shall be house funded. Therefore, there shall be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken for this jackpot. All fee collections and table limits are for the designated controlled game and are Bureau approved, predetermined, and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

Limelight Card Room shall not retain an administrative fee as the Fixed Jackpot is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Fixed Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Fixed Jackpot</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive

Although the Bureau has approved this jackpot, jackpots with an electronic component are currently under Bureau review. The Bureau reserves the right to: (1) review the lawfulness of the Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive; (2) notify all law enforcement agencies and gambling establishments if further review determines the Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive to be unlawful; (3) require gambling establishments to cease and desist offering for play the modified Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive if found to be unlawful; and (4) take action against those gambling establishments that decline to abide by the Bureau's cease and desist notification.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Limelight Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001183) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts
- Administrative fees
- No Purchase Necessary Information
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Limelight Card Room, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Fortune Pai Gow Poker (GEGR-002082)

Object and Summary

- 1. The Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive considers the best hand possible among each individual player's cards.
- 2. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may optionally place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1. A minimum of two players are required to play for the progressive jackpot.
- 3. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players who wish to participate must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
- 4. Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Game Start" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees shall be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection box and accounted for separately.

- 5. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. All seven cards will be considered when determining if a qualifying hand is made. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.
- 6. When a player has achieved a winning hand, the house dealer shall press the appropriate button on the keypad. A casino representative will then be responsible for verifying the winning hand.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown below, shall be eligible to win their share of the posted prize amount, according to the payout options, as shown below.

Qualifying Hands

*If the base game includes a joker, the joker shall be played per the base game rules.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Backline bettors are not eligible to participate in this gaming activity.
- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required for this gaming activity.
- A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game, regardless of the outcome of the base game.
- Winning players will be paid in live casino chips by a casino representative at their seat once their hand has been verified by a casino representative.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player can qualify for and win either the fixed or the progressive prize.
- A player may place a base game wager as well as the optional jackpot fee on any unoccupied seat, as well as their own, and become eligible for multiple payouts. For example, if a seated player places a base game wager and the optional jackpot fee on their own seat as well as an unoccupied seat, and achieve a straight flush in both hands, they are eligible for two fixed prize payouts, each equal to 100% of the posted prize.
- Casino employees are eligible to play when off duty.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible for this promotion.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Players Services (TPPPS) are not eligible for this promotion.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

The complete payout table for both the progressive prize and the fixed amount prize is listed below.

Progressive Prize

- A 7 Card Natural Straight Flush is paid 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.
- A 7 Card Wild Straight Flush is paid 25% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.
- When a player has a progressive winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- Once the proper paperwork has been filled out and the hand has been verified, the casino representative will pay the winner in live casino chips taken from the cage.
- In the event that more than one progressive meter pay is hit, the progressive prize will be equally split among the winners.
 - In the event there is an odd number of chips, the player closest to the player-dealer position will get the odd amount.
- All hands will be paid the posted prize as shown in the pay table below.

Fixed Prize

- All fixed prize qualifying hands are paid from the reserve fund. Fixed prize amounts do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.
- All fixed payouts will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips taken from the cage.
- Payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.
- In the event that more than one qualifying hand hits during the same round, all fixed prize winning players will be paid 100% of the posted fixed prize amount.
- All hands will be paid the posted prize as shown in the pay table below.

Fixed Prize Pay Table

Funding

The Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive is player funded with both fixed and progressive elements. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. After the progressive jackpot is hit, the progressive meter will be re-seeded at \$1,000 from the reserve fund. If there are insufficient funds in the reserve fund, the Casino shall re-seed at their own expense. There is no cap on the progressive jackpot. Furthermore, the Casino will cover any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.

Each \$1 jackpot fee paid by a player will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.34 will be immediately posted on the progressive meter.
- \$0.66 will be tracked in the reserve fund. The reserve fund will be utilized to immediately reseed the metered progressive jackpot at \$1,000 following a progressive prize win. In addition, this reserve fund will be used to pay all fixed amount prizes and administrative fees.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will take an administrative fee ranging from \$6-\$12 per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee will cover the costs associated with the complicated computer system and program in addition to technicians having to service the systems.

No Purchase Necessary

The Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- When a player has a progressive winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer shall then contact the representative.
- Once the Casino verifies the progressive win, the representative shall press "Confirm", then swipe the authorization card. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), he/she presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- Once the "Confirm" button is pressed and the authorization card swiped, the prize is logged into Game Manager.
- If the electronic software or digital reader malfunctions or breaks down, the jackpot will not be offered.

Bureau Requirements

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in the Limelight Cardroom at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games
- The date(s) and time(s) the gaming activity will be offered
- How points are earned
- Corresponding time played and point(s) amount(s)
- How the number of points earned corresponds to what amount in prize value
- The possible prize(s) offered for meeting the requirements of the gaming activity
- The possible bonus rates offered on play during off-peak hours or in specific games
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Object and Summary

The Limelight Social Club features a promotional element that is house funded and attached to the games listed above. This gaming activity is a loyalty reward program open to all Limelight Cardroom patrons. This promotion will reward players with points based on time of play at the designated games listed above during pre-determined and eligible periods. The tracking of the player's and the points they earn will be tracked via the Poker Atlas/Table Captain (PATC) system through a player rewards program.

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points will be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player who plays a Bureau approved game listed above will have their Player Rewards Card scanned/swiped using the Poker Atlas/Table Captain system and their hours played will be tracked.

- The player will receive points, which will gain them the eligibility to win a pre-determined and designated prize(s)
- Each hour will account for 100 to 1,000 points
- The Casino may offer bonus points

- Examples include double points on play during off-peak hours or in specific games as long as it is within the specified range, by playing an hour on the first day they sign up for the Limelight Social Club or by referring another player and both players completing an hour of play on that day
- Patrons will be given ample notice of how many Lucky Bucks will be awarded as well as the amount of time or number of hands required to earn points for each eligible controlled game.

How Points are Redeemed

Players may redeem their points at any time during the promotion. All prizes will have a predetermined and designated value. After a player has accumulated a pre-determined and specific amount of points, based on time of play, a player may redeem the accrued points for a pre-determined and designated prize.

- Each 100 points will be equal to \$1
- After a player has been awarded a prize, they may also be eligible for multiple and subsequent prize(s) until the end of the promotion
- Players may redeem their points for multiple prizes as long as the total amount of points required for the prizes are within the player's point balance
 - Some prizes may be limited to one per person or one per day
- Upon request, a player may view the amount of points they have earned during the predetermined and designated promotional period
 - This will be verified by a casino floor-person base on what has been recorded and tracked
- Points are non-transferrable and can only be used by the player who earned them
- All reward points are subject to review and verification
- Limelight Cardroom reserves the right to adjust the balances or void any points due to error or fraud

Player Reward Card

- The player's rewards card will be used to track players' hours and points earned
- Players can request to become a member of the Limelight Social Club by presenting their valid identification to a casino employee. The casino employee will enter the player's information into a secured system and a card will be printed
 There is no fee to replace a lost or stolen card
- The Poker Atlas/Table Captain software will be stored on a computer, on a secured server, locked in the cage
- Players may request their point count at the cage from a casino employee
- Players may request to participate in a specific promotion or offer. A casino employee will verify the amount of points the player has available. If the player has enough points for the specific promotion, the casino employee will print out a voucher and the point will be deducted and recorded in the player's account. The voucher will be signed by the player confirming the use and deduction of points and which promotion the player is using the voucher for. The voucher is then used for the specific promotion and a casino employee collects the voucher
 - Points may expire. Rules and regulations for each promotion and promotional period will be posted at least seven days prior to the start of any promotion and/or promotional period
- Player's time played is tracked by having their card scanned when they sit down to start playing

- Players will remain in the system accruing time until one of the following occurs:
 - The player leaves the game and is checked out by the casino employee; or
 - The player temporarily leaves the game and the casino employee puts them in lobby mode and then back in when he/she resumes play

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of two players, a player and player-dealer, required to be playing for California games
- There is a minimum of two players required to be playing for all poker games
- Some prizes may be limited to one per person or one per day
- Players may participate and win other promotions running concurrently
- Employees will be eligible to participate in this gaming activity when they are off duty and out of uniform
- Backline bettors are not eligible to participate in this gaming activity
- Patrons satisfying the player-dealer position are eligible to participate in this gaming activity
- Tournament games do not qualify for this promotion
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) will not be eligible to participate in this promotion at any time

<u>Prize</u>

The prize amount will be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000 in the form of cash, cardroom chips, food, food gift cards, merchandise, trips, entries into Poker Tournaments (GEGA-001950), Match Play Vouchers or Free Play Chips (GEAR-000959), Spin the Wheel (GEGA-002395) or Limelight Add-On Promotion (GEGA-002551). In all instances, prizes for this promotion will be pre-determined and posted on all advertisements relating to the promotion. Cash prizes are a fixed amount and are not progressive. Once a player's points have been verified, they will receive the prize.

Funding

The Limelight Social Club will be fully funded by the Limelight Cardroom. There will be no additional gaming activity fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will not retain an administration fee, as this gaming activity is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Limelight Social Club does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Limelight Lucky Draw Promotion

Section III

- 1. Promotional name: Limelight Lucky Draw Promotion.
- 2. The Limelight Lucky Draw promotion will apply to Pure 21.5 Blackjack and all Texas Hold'em approved house games. All house rules would apply.
- 3. The Limelight Lucky Draw promotion would be awarded in either cash or chips.
- 4. The prize will be a fixed amount ranging from \$100 to \$5000.
- 5. The Limelight Lucky Draw will be house funded.
- 6. There will be no special fees or collections.
- 7. The Limelight Lucky Draw promotion will be a drawing for a cash or chip prize ranging from \$100 to \$5000. To be entered into this drawing the player will have to have made a certain qualifying hand, a suited Blackjack in Pure 21.5, or in Texas Hold-em, either a full house (or better) or four of a kind (or better). The duration of this promotion will be either 1 week, 1 month, or 3 months. The player will be required to be present in order to win the drawing if their name is chosen. After the winner(s) have been chosen, all tickets will be discarded and not held over for future drawings.
- 8. The winner will receive the winning amount in either cash or chips.
- 9. N/A.
- 10. There will be no minimum or maximum number of players required for this promotion
- 11. The Limelight Lucky Draw promotion is completely house funded and therefore no administrative fee will be taken.
- 12. No Purchase Necessary (NPN). Any person who wishes to participate in the promotion may do so with NPN or at no cost to that person/customer. Upon request a player may receive one entry into the Limelight Lucky Draw promotion. The NPN player must adhere to all house rules.
- 13. At this time there are no flyers or available literature.
- 14. There are no other persons involved other than approved Limelight employees.
- 15. A standard Texas Hold-em table with a house dealer.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Match Play Voucher and/or Free Play Chip values
- Procedures to redeem Match Play Voucher or Free Play Chip
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Match Play Vouchers shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Limelight Card Room, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- EZ Baccarat Panda 8 (GEGA-004006)
- Three Card Poker 6 Card Bonus (GEGA-003699)
- Pure 21.5 Blackjack (GEGA-003252)
- Pure Spanish 21.5 (GEGA-004367)

Object and Summary

Patrons may receive Match Play Vouchers via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, e-mail, text messages, social media, etc., during pre-determined and posted times. Players who receive a Match Play Voucher will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the voucher if he/she places a wager on an eligible game equal to the amount listed on the voucher. In certain instances, the Match Play Vouchers may be redeemed for a Free Play Chip(s).

The Match Play Voucher will have marketing logos, a description of the voucher's worth, explanations of Bureau approved games the voucher can be used to place a bet with and references to problem gambling advice avenues. It will not be necessary for players to write on the vouchers.

Vouchers will have expiration dates ranging from one month to two years. Some vouchers may dictate time periods or days of a week when they can be used. The specifics will also be clearly defined on the voucher(s).

Match Play Voucher

The Casino will offer Match Play Vouchers having a face value from \$5 to \$500 per voucher; the amount will be clearly stated on the voucher. Each voucher will state the specific qualifying game(s) for which the voucher can be used to place a wager on.

- When playing the Match Play Voucher, the player must place the Match Play Voucher on the table in the betting circle along with a wager equal to the amount of the Match Play Voucher.
- If a player achieves a winning hand, the winning hand will be paid his/her wager as well as the listed amount on the Match Play Voucher by the player-dealer.
 - The house dealer will signal a Casino floor person that a Match Play Voucher has been used to bet with and the player won the hand.
 - The player-dealer will have a floor person sign the voucher verifying it was collected from a winning hand.
 - Winning vouchers are taken to the cage by the floor person, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the voucher(s).
 - The voucher amount is then returned to the player-dealer.
- If a player loses, the money part of the wager is collected by the player-dealer, and the voucher is voided and collected by the house dealer.
- If the player pushes (receives no action), the voucher may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a Match Play Voucher with a value of \$5 with the voucher specifically stating it may be used to place a wager on the Pure 21.5 Blackjack table. The person would place the voucher on the gaming table; place a bet equal to the amount on the voucher, and pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play. If the player wins the hand, he/she will receive \$10 just as if they had placed a \$10 bet and the player-dealer will collect the voucher.

Free Play Chip

In specified cases, the Casino will offer Free Play Chips having a face value from \$5 to \$500. The amount will be clearly printed on the chip. The Free Play Chips will not have a cash value, therefore cannot be exchanged at the cashiers cage for money.

- The Free Play Chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being they cannot be exchanged for cash.
 - Players who receive Free Play Chips will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the chip on an eligible game without being required to place a live bet.
 - Free Play Chips shall be used as the player's bet and placed on the betting circle.
- Players can wager the Free Play Chips against the player-dealer:
- If a player achieves a winning hand, the winning hand will be paid his/her wager by the player-dealer.
 - The player-dealer will pay the amount of the wager and collect the Free Play Chip.
 - The house dealer will signal a Casino floor person that a Free Play Chip has been used to bet with and the player won the hand.
 - The floor person will then take the Free Play Chip and take the chip to the cage, and exchange it for the value listed on the chip(s).
 - The Free Play Chip amount is then returned to the player-dealer.
- If a player loses, the house dealer will collect the Free Play Chip and insert the chip in the table drop box. This temporarily voids the chip.
- If the player pushes (receives no action), the Free Play Chip may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: Marketing material, such as a post card, will have a physical Match Play Voucher attached. The marketing material may have an additional or alternative offering of Free Play Chips. "Use this \$10 Match Play Voucher any time in November or exchange the voucher for a \$10 Free Play Chip with a Cardroom floor supervisor".

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Match Play Vouchers cannot be used in conjunction with Free Play Chips.
- Free Play Chips cannot be used in conjunction with live chips.
- Match Play Vouchers and Free Play Chips cannot be used to pay collection fees, place bonus bets or jackpot fees.
- The Match Play Vouchers and Free Play Chips cannot be used for tournament games.
- Players shall not exchange the Match Play and/or Free Play Chips for live chips or give them to another player.
- The Match Play and/or Free Play Chips shall only be redeemed after having been played by a customer, and then verified by a floor person.
- Backline bettors are eligible to use the Match Play Vouchers and Free Play Chips.
- Casino employees, on or off duty, and in and out of uniform, are not eligible for the promotion.
- Third Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPPS), are not eligible for this promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

The Match Play Voucher and Free Play Chips shall have a value ranging from \$5 to \$500 for each voucher or chip. The vouchers and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played by a customer and then verified by a floor person.

Funding

The Match Play Voucher and Free Play Chips promotion shall be fully funded by the Limelight Card Room. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

Administrative Fees

Limelight Card Room will not take any administrative fees for this promotion.

No Purchase Necessary

The Match Play Voucher does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Limelight Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-001950) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- How a player may enter the tournament
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by the Casino, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid
- Any other restrictions that apply to the Poker Tournaments

Gaming Activities Played with Tournaments

- The rules and procedures for any and all gaming activities that are being offered in conjunctions with the Poker Tournaments
- All information related to prize ranges and amount for all gaming activities associated with the Poker Tournaments

Tournament Log

Limelight Card Room shall maintain all completed tournament logs for at least seven years. These logs shall be maintained in either paper or electronic format. The cardroom shall also retain and make available the most recent three months of the tournament logs for inspection by a representative of the Bureau during all hours of operation. Upon request of the Bureau, a licensee shall provide the Bureau with copies of such tournament logs. Tournament logs shall contain the following information:

- Name of Gambling Establishment
- Day, date, time and name advertised for the tournament
- Total number of tables used
- Name of controlled games offered
- Method of entry
- Number and amount of rebuys and/or add-ons offered
- Number of participants
- Name of each fee charged, amount of each fee charged, total number of each fee collected, and cumulative amount of collected
- Source of all funds for tournament prize pool
- Amount of the prize pool
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool

- Name of gaming activities offered (when applicable)
 - Funding source
 - Prize amount
 - Total number of prizes awarded
 - Total amount deducted from prize pool (when applicable)
- Results of the tournament, including the total amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament
- Printed name and signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament

Eligible Controlled Games

The Poker Tournaments shall be attached to all Bureau approved poker controlled games offered at Limelight Card Room at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

• All approved poker games

Gaming Activities Offered During Tournament Play

Bounties

- If there is a bounty offered for the tournament; when "player x" knocks out the "advertised bounty" player(s) by ending their play in the tournament, then "player x" will be awarded their bounty.
- The bounty(s) will be paid to "player x" during the tournament or as soon as their tournament play ends; to be determined by the casino.
- The bounty amount will range from \$0 to \$10,000.
- If a bounty or bounties are advertised, the prize amount will be deducted from the total number of buy-ins, rebuy(s) and add-on(s) or the Casino will pay this prize amount and will not be reimbursed.
- If a group at the final table decides to split the prize pool among them evenly, the bounty(s) will become part of the total split.

Points System (Tournament Play Only)

Objective and Summary

During a large tournament (i.e. month long), several tournaments may offer a predetermined amount of points that will entitle a player to a prize and/or entry into a grand finale tournament. All points will be tracked using a spreadsheet.

Example: There are twenty-four (24) tournament events held during the Legends of Poker Tournaments at the Casino. Ten (10) of the tournaments will be pre-designated as points tournaments where the players who finish in the top 25 will be awarded a predetermined number of points (depending on which place they finish in) that will accumulate during the month. At the end of the point qualification, the winner of the top points winner could win a car or the top nine (9) winners will be granted a free entry into the \$10,000 main event.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours designated and posted for the Poker Tournament.

Prize

Player's shall receive a predetermined and posted prize and/or entry into a grand finale tournament. Prizes include cash, merchandise, jewelry, trips, tournament entries, extra tournament chips, and vehicles.

Funding

Funding for this gaming activity associated with tournament play shall be from the tournament prize pool.

Freeroll Tournament

Objective and Summary

Entry is gained via points awarded during tournament play and any predetermined and posted live play. The number of points needed to gain entry shall be displayed prior to the start of any qualifying tournament.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all tournament players playing at any of the above listed controlled games during predetermined specified hours and posted for the gaming activity. Listed below are specific eligibility requirements:

- During live play, players must accumulate points by using their Limelight Social Club (GEAR-001120) rewards card.
- All procedures, times and point amounts will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

Prize

The prize pool will range from \$100 - \$50,000.

Funding

The Freeroll Tournament prize pool is funded by \$1 to \$1,000 taken from the buy-in for previous tournaments. The Casino may add extra funds to the existing prize pool to increase the amount and will not be reimbursed.

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure will be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament will not change once sign-ups begin.
- Promotional materials will not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided will be equal for the initial buy-in and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament or a Bureau approved gaming activity. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- More than one method of entry for a specific tournament may be utilized.

*The Casino will retain the designated entry fee that will be income for the casino and/or to pay expenses and tips for the dealers and staff.

**Service Charge will be taken from the Entry fee and be used to cover any staffing costs or tipping shortfalls.

***Dealer Appreciation Fee is a fee that will not become part of the prize pool. This fee is obtained for dealer cost and tips. This shall be an optional fee that tournament entrants may pay in exchange for additional tournament chips.

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

The prizes will be the cumulative amount of buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. The prizes may also be guaranteed. The Casino may provide prizes or add funds to the prize pool for special events.

- When the prize amount is guaranteed the payouts will be a cash value ranging from \$1 -\$100,000. The cash will be paid to players from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. If there is not enough cash to cover the guaranteed prize amount, Limelight Card Room will fund the difference.
- When the prize pool is not based solely on buy-ins, re-buys and add-ons (free roll), Limelight Card Room will determine and set the payout structure.

Tournament Prize Structure

When the prize is not guaranteed, the prize structure will be broken down by the number of paid entries and percentage paid. The percentage paid out will always equal 100%. In the event the players decide to forgo the payout structure and "split" the total prize pool among them, it shall be permitted and shall be noted in detail on the casino's tournament log.

Promotional prizes will be paid in the form of cash, live casino chips, extra poker tournament chips, jewelry, electronics, clothing, vehicles, watercrafts, gift certificates, sporting events, concert tickets, gift certificates, entertainment, food comps, entry into future Poker Tournaments, and travel. Patrons shall be given ample notice of what prize is being offered and it shall be displayed prominently.

Entities Involved Other Than the House

Limelight Card Room shall not allow other entities to become involved in the play of Poker Tournaments at their gambling establishment.

No Purchase Necessary

The gaming activities attached to the Poker Tournaments shall be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary (NPN) game. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for patrons who request to participate in the gaming activities attached to the Poker Tournaments without paying any entry into the tournament. The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the tournament player. All advertisements shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the gaming activities offered during the Poker Tournaments.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Limelight Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-002306) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and the restrictions for those hands
- Prize payout structure
- Jackpot prize amount
- Alternative Prize Option and amount
- Limelight Card Room's discretionary increases to the Progressive Jackpot prize and specific time periods the Jackpot prize will be increased
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to all Bureau approved poker games offered at Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Progressive Jackpot features a house funded progressive jackpot prize element. A prize is awarded to players participating in a jackpot game when a designated second hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand at the showdown. When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with the qualifying jackpot hands shall receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize. Additionally, a posted percentage of the jackpot prize, known as the table share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as shown below. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the rules and restrictions when completing a qualifying jackpot hand. Furthermore, the jackpot prize shall be displayed prominently within the Limelight Card Room at all times the jackpot is being offered for play.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make the following qualifying hands shall be eligible to win their share of the Progressive Jackpot prize amount, as shown below. Only a winning and losing hand that has been Bureau approved and predetermined and designated by Limelight Card Room is eligible. Patrons shall be given ample notice of the specific hands that are being offered. Furthermore, the qualifying jackpot hands shall be displayed prominently within Limelight Card Room at all times.

Progressive Jackpot Qualifying Hands

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of five (5) players are required to be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- In order to qualify for the jackpot in games that utilize hole cards, the winning and losing hands must use two (2) hole cards.
- Any communication that a player has a winning jackpot hand prior to the opening of the hands to determine the winner of the game will be declared a violation and disqualify the hand.
- Players with qualifying winning and losing hands must play through the final betting round, in order to qualify for the jackpot. If a player with one of the qualifying hands folds prior to the final betting round, the table will be in-eligible for the jackpot.
- In the event that during a round of play, two (2) or more players have qualifying losing or winning hands, only the player with the highest ranked losing and winning poker hands will receive the posted prize percentage of the jackpot for the losing and winning hand. The remaining player(s), including those who had lower ranked qualifying hands, will receive the posted prize percentage of the table share.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative will verify that both hands qualify and that no collusion, cheating, or other rules were violated. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- If, for any reason the prize payout is not awarded due to possible cheating or other rule violations, the camera recording of the event will be saved for the Department of Justice and/or law enforcement review. The event will be documented by a casino representative and witnessed by the house dealer.
- Once the verification process is completed, a casino representative will inform the eligible players that they have won the posted prizes amounts and the payout process will proceed.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Progressive jackpot when off duty and out of uniform.

<u>Prize</u>

The jackpot prize for the Progressive Jackpot is a progressive amount in the value at \$1,000 as a minimum. The Limelight Card Room will increase the Progressive Jackpot prize amount at predetermined and posted times with a minimum amount of \$50 per day. The actual jackpot prize amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at, as well as how many days have transpired in order for the progressive jackpot prize pool to increase by based on the fixed amount designated by Limelight Card Room, as shown below. The actual jackpot prize amount shall be posted at all times.

All jackpots shall be paid in the form of cash or check and will be paid after hand verification by a casino representative. The Limelight Card Room reserves the right to pay any winning amount over \$5,000 by check only, for security reasons and may require a 48-hour wait to issue payment due to holidays, or availability of someone with check signing privileges. All proper Internal Revenue Service and additional required paperwork will be completed with payment.

Alternative Prize Option

When predetermined and offered, winners of the jackpot will have the option to claim a prize in the form of merchandise, vehicle, trips, gift certificates, clothing, jewelry, or tournament entries (GEGA-001950) in lieu of the entire posted jackpot prize. The merchandise will be assigned a monetary value that will be less than the actual retail value. The cost assigned will be reimbursed to Limelight Card Room and any difference will be borne solely by the gambling establishment. Only one item will be offered and it will be up to the winners to decide who will get it. If the players cannot come to an agreement, the prize will be awarded as normal.

Example: The Progressive Jackpot using "Option A" of the prize payout structure, shown below is hit at \$8,000. A Vespa scooter that cost \$2,381 will be displayed in the gambling establishment with an assigned value of \$2,000. In this example, a player that is awarded the "Losing Share" of the Progressive Jackpot would receive \$4,800 of the total \$8,000. The player will have the option of taking all of the posted prize or taking \$2,800 and the scooter which will total \$4,800. The Casino will be reimbursed (from the jackpot prize pool) only \$2,000 and they will expense the remainder (\$381) within their bookkeeping records. The rest of the jackpot prize will be awarded as normal.

- Once a winner is determined, the chosen player must decide how they will claim their jackpot prize.
 - Either the original prize or a combination of the original prize and the posted merchandise.
- One Alternative Prize Option (when offered) will be available per jackpot; or one Alternative Prize option per multiple jackpots.
 - **Example:** A Vespa scooter would be available for the Progressive Jackpot and the Fixed Jackpot prize. If a player wins and selects the prize, the same prize will also be available for the other jackpot if/when hit.
- All eligibility and prizes will be predetermined and posted.

Prize Payout Structure

Players that make the qualifying jackpot hands, as shown in the chart above, shall be eligible to win their share of the Progressive Jackpot prize amount, based on the payout table being used, as shown below. A posted percentage of the jackpot prize, known as the table share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as shown below. Patrons shall be given ample notice of the specific payout structure that is being utilized for the jackpot. Only one distribution chart shall be offered at any one time. Furthermore, the prize payout structure shall be displayed prominently within Limelight Card Room at all times.

Funding

The Progressive Jackpot utilizes a progressive prize pool which shall be house funded. Therefore, there shall be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken for this jackpot. All fee collections and table limits are for the designated controlled game and are Bureau approved, predetermined, and posted at each table.

The jackpot shall initially be seeded by Limelight Card Room in the amount of \$1,000 and progress each day by at least \$50. When the jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded in an amount of \$1,000, and will increase in the values previously listed.

Administrative Fees

Limelight Card Room shall not retain an administrative fee as the Progressive Jackpot is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Progressive Jackpot</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Limelight Quads Promotion

Section III

- Name of Proposed Gaming Activity "Promotional Name" Quads Prize. The Limelight Card Room proposes to offer a Quad Prize promotional activity for current approved games. "Promotional Name" would be e.g. "Hot Quads," or "The Limelight Quad 4 Winners," or "Progressive Quad Prize."
- 2. The above "Quad Prize" would apply to the following current approved games. Texas Hold'em Limit, Texas Hold'em No Limit. All house game rules apply.
- 3. The Quad Prize will be a cash prize awarded to eligible players when a qualifying quads poker hand is shown at the show down. See attached Quads Prize Rules.
- 4. The cash prize will be a prize. The prize amount will range from \$10 to \$1,000. The promotion will be house-funded .
- 5. No special fee or collection.
- 6. The prize will be a minimum of \$10 and a maximum of \$1,000. The Quads promotion will re-seed whenever it is hit.
- 8. The Quad prize distribution will be as follows:

The player with a quad hand, a Royal Flush or Straight Flush at the show down will receive s spin at the prize wheel. The cash prizes will range in value from \$10 to \$1,000. Every spot on the prize wheel contains a cash prize. Players who had a Straight Flush will receive double the amount showing on the prize wheel. Players who had a Royal Flush will receive triple the amount showing on the prize wheel. At pre-determined and posted times, all amounts on the prize wheel may be doubled or tripled in value.

9. Quad prize re-seeding will be a minimum of \$10 to a maximum of \$1,000. Options include:

Name change

- 10. A minimum of 2 active playes must be at that table each dealt a hand for that table to be eligible for the quad prize.
- 11. No administrative fee
- 12. No Purchase Necessary (NPN). Any person who wishes to participate in the promotion may do so with NPN or at no cost to that person/customer. Upon request a NPN table will be set up, and be designated a live game and the requesting NPN player then may play for the jackpot prize. Chips will be issued that are designated no value chips, and play will commence. The NPN player must adhere to all rules.
- 13. At this time there are no flyers or available literature.
- 14. There are no other persons involved other than approved Limelight employees.
- 15. A standard Texas Hold'em table with house dealer and 2 to 10 players.

Quads Rules

Summary

The player with a quad hand, a Royal Flush or Straight Flush at the show down will receive s spin at the prize wheel. The cash prizes will range in value from \$10 to \$1,000. Every spot on the prize wheel contains a cash prize. Players who had a Straight Flush will receive double the amount showing on the prize wheel. Players who had a Royal Flush will receive triple the amount showing on the prize wheel. At pre-determined and posted times, all amounts on the prize wheel may be doubled or tripled in value.

Seed and daily percentage options:

Seed/Re-seed options

The quads promotion is fully funded by the house. Whenever the promotion is hit, the Limelight will pay the prize amount indicated on the prize wheel.

Quad Prize Signage

The current prize payout process for the Quad prize will be posted on a special Quad Prize Board. The jackpot board will be updated daily.

Eligibility to Win

Qualifying Hands:

Options for qualifying hand are: AAAA, KKKK, QQQQ, JJJJ, TTTT, 9999, 8888, 7777, 6666, 5555, 4444, 3333, 2222, AKQJT all same suit (Royal Flush), A2345 all same suit (Wheel Straight Flush).

Hand & Event Eligibilty

- 1. Players that make the qualifying hand must show their hand at the show down, the hand does not have to win.
- 2. The Player will qualify if it is the exact hand using the both cards in the player's hand and two cards from the community board cards.
- 3. There must be at leat 2 players at that table each dealt a hand.
- 4. There can be no verbal or attempt to signal other players that this hand is a Quads Prize Hand, or any assistance from the dealer. Any communication indicating the hand is a Quads Prize Hand prior to opening the hands to determine the winner will be declared a violation and disqualify the hand.
- 5. The dealer will notify the Floorman a Quads hand has occurred. The Floorman and on-duty Key Employee will verify with the dealer that the two players' showed hands at the show down and one was a qualifying hand, and eligible for the Quads prize.
- 6. Next the Floormanm and Key Employee will check the camera to verify that no collusion; cheating, or other rules were violated.
- 7. If for some reason a Quads prize is not awarded due to cheating or other rule violation, the camera recording the event will be saved for DOJ or law enforcement review. Further a complete text write up will be completed by the Floorman and Key Employee and witnessed by the dealer.
- 8. After the verification process is complete the Key Employee will inform the eligible player the Quads hand has won the Quads prize for that hand, and the payout process will proceed.

No Purchase Necessary

No Purchase Necessary will be clearly covered in all literature and card room signage.

Pay Out Process

- 1. The Quads-winning players will be paid either with cash or check.
- 2. At pre-determined and designated times the prize amounts may be doubled or tripled.
- 3. The Limelight reserves the right to pay any winning amount over \$5000 by check only for security reasons.

- The Limelight may require a 48 hour wait for payment due to weekends, holidays, or availability of someone with check signing privilages.
 All proper IRS and required parework will be completed with payment.

GLOSSARY

Quads	Quads is four of a kind, i.e. KKKK or 2222
Quads Prize	The cash prize for that day only if that Quad hand still qualifies
Seed/Re-seed	The Quads Prize promotion is a short term promotion, and depending on which seed/re- seed option is being used, is when the fixed amount is added to the prize pool.

Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot

Although the Bureau has approved this jackpot, jackpots with an electronic component are currently under Bureau review. The Bureau reserves the right to: (1) review the lawfulness of the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot; (2) notify all law enforcement agencies and gambling establishments if further review determines the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot to be unlawful; (3) require gambling establishments to cease and desist offering for play the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot if found to be unlawful; and (4) take action against those gambling establishments that decline to abide by the Bureau's cease and desist notification.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Limelight Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001194) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts
- Prize payout structure
- Availability of Alternative Prize Option & corresponding value
- Administrative fees
- No Purchase Necessary Information
- Any other restrictions applying to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Limelight Card Room, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Three Card Poker 6 Card Bonus (GEGA-003699)

Object and Summary

A player may win a progressive or fixed jackpot prize by placing an optional \$1 jackpot fee and making a predetermined qualifying hand listed below. Also, a player who places an optional \$1 jackpot fee qualifies to win an Envy payout.

- To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1. A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required to play for the progressive jackpot.
- "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.

- Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Coin In" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees are dropped in a separate and locked jackpot collection box affixed to the gaming table.
- The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game.

Qualifying Hands

Only hands that have been Bureau approved and pre-determined and designated by the Casino are eligible. Patrons will be provided with ample advance notice of what the qualifying hands are, as well as the requirements for completing the qualifying hands. Furthermore, the qualifying hands will be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot is being offered for play.

Players that make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown below, will be eligible to win their share of the posted prize amount, according to the payout options, as shown below. All qualifying progressive and fixed hands within a chart and listed below must be offered together at all times

Qualifying Hand Payout Chart

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- Backline bettors are not eligible to place a jackpot fee nor receive the prize amount for a designated hand.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player can win either the progressive or fixed jackpots.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot only when off duty and out of uniform.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to place a
 jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the prize when either in the player-dealer
 or player capacity.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to place an optional jackpot fee nor win a prize.
- Players who are playing multiple hands may place a jackpot fee for each hand and be eligible to win multiple prizes.
- In the event more than one fixed qualifying hand is hit during the same round, all winning players will receive the posted prize amount.
- In the event more than one progressive qualifying hand is hit during the same round, all winning players will share, in equal amounts, the posted progressive prize amount.
 - In the event there is an odd number of chips, the extra dollar will be awarded to the patron who received action on the hand first according to the game rules.
- In the event that more than one player achieves a hand associated with an Envy pay, all other players will receive multiple Envy payouts.

<u>Prize</u>

All monies collected and paid out will be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that will be maintained by the gambling establishment, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Fixed Prize

- When a player is dealt a straight flush, they are paid a fixed prize amount according to the payout table above.
- All fixed prize payouts will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper
 paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live
 casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray. All fixed prize
 payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund. Any shortfall will be
 covered by the Casino.

Progressive Prize

- When a player is dealt an ace, king, queen of the same suit, the player is awarded 100% of the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter.
- All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter.
- All progressive prize payouts will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper
 paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live
 casino chips. The progressive prize payouts will not be made from the house dealer's
 tray; the live casino chips will come from the cage.

Envy Bonus

- A player who placed the optional \$1 jackpot fee qualifies to win an Envy payout. If another player at the table achieves a hand associated with an Envy pay, all other players who paid the optional \$1 jackpot fee will win the Envy pay. The player who achieves a qualifying hand is only eligible for the normal prize and will NOT receive the Envy pay.
- In the event that more than one player achieves a hand associated with an Envy pay, all other players will receive multiple Envy payouts. The players who achieved the qualifying hands are only eligible for the normal prize and will NOT receive the Envy pay.
- If a player's hand triggers an Envy payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the house dealer will lock up the cards. The house dealer will then move on to the next player.
- All Envy Bonus payouts will be paid by a casino representative at the end of the round. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray. All Envy Bonus payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund.

Alternative Prize Option

When predetermined and offered, winners of the jackpot will have the option to claim a prize in the form of merchandise, vehicle, trips, gift certificates, clothing, jewelry, or tournament entries (GEGA-001950) in lieu of the entire posted jackpot prize. The merchandise will be assigned a monetary value that will be less than the actual retail value. The cost assigned will be reimbursed to Limelight Card Room and any difference will be borne solely by the gambling establishment. Only one item will be offered and it will be up to the winners to decide who will get it. If the players cannot come to an agreement, the cash prize will be awarded as normal.

Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot

Example: A Vespa scooter that cost \$2,381 will be displayed in the gambling establishment with an assigned value of \$2,000. In this example, a player wins a jackpot with a posted prize of \$5,000. They will have the option of taking all of the posted prize or taking \$3,000 and the scooter which will total \$5,000. The Casino will be reimbursed (from the jackpot prize pool) only \$2,000 and they will expense the remainder (\$381) within their bookkeeping. The rest of the jackpot prize will be awarded as normal.

- Once a winner is determined, the chosen player must decide how they will claim their jackpot prize.
 - Either the original prize or a combination of the original prize and the posted alternative prize.
- One Alternative Prize Option (when offered) will be available per jackpot.
- All eligibility and prizes will be predetermined and posted.

Funding

The Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot is a player funded progressive jackpot. The jackpot features both fixed and progressive prizes. There is an optional \$1 jackpot fee required to be eligible for the prize. The jackpot fee must be placed along with a base game wager in order to participate in the jackpot.

Each \$1 jackpot fee will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.20 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- \$0.80 will be tracked in a reserve fund.

The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino. There is no cap to the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded by the reserve fund in an amount ranging between a minimum of \$100 to a maximum of \$5,000. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall.

Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the re-seed amount will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. All increases and decreases to the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot fund shall be documented in the accounting records.

The reserve fund will also be used to pay out all fixed prize and Envy payout amounts. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.

Administrative Fees

Limelight Card Room shall retain an administrative fee of \$8-\$12 per table per hour and is taken from the jackpot reserve fund. The administrative fee shall be utilized to cover expenses incurred for administering the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- When a player has a progressive winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer shall then contact a Casino representative.
- Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the Casino representative shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table, and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
- When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), the house dealer presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- Once the "J-pot" button is pressed, the prize is logged into Game Manager.

Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot

Although the Bureau has approved this jackpot modification, jackpots with an electronic component are currently under Bureau review. The Bureau reserves the right to: (1) review the lawfulness of the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot; (2) notify all law enforcement agencies and gambling establishments if further review determines the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot to be unlawful; (3) require gambling establishments to cease and desist offering for play the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot if found to be unlawful; and (4) take action against those gambling establishments that decline to abide by the Bureau's cease and desist notification.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Limelight Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001184) will be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Limelight Card Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts
- Jackpot fee amount and breakdown
- Administrative fees
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot will be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Limelight Card Room, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Ultimate Texas Hold'em (GEGR-002083)

Object and Summary

Players may place an optional \$1 jackpot fee for a chance to win the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot. The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot considers the best advertised qualifying hand(s) among each individual player's cards. In addition, when a player places the optional \$1 jackpot fee, the player is eligible to win an Envy Bonus payout.

- 1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may optionally place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1. A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required to play to qualify for the progressive jackpot.
- 2. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.

- 3. Once all players place their bets and/or optional jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Game Start" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees will be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection box and accounted for separately.
- The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown below, will be eligible to win their share of the posted prize amount, according to the payout options listed below. All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.

*A Community Royal is a hand consisting of an ace, king, queen, jack and 10 of the same suit, all in the community cards. The Community Royal prize is paid to all players who place the optional \$1 jackpot fee on that hand, and did not use any hole cards to complete the hand.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required for this gaming activity.
- Only seated players, who have paid the optional jackpot collection fee and dealt a designated hand, are eligible for a prize. Backline bettors are not eligible for this promotion.
- There is no limit on the number of times a player may win the progressive prize or a fixed prize.
- A player may place a base game wager as well as the optional \$1 jackpot fee on any unoccupied seat, as well as their own, and become eligible for multiple payouts.
- Casino employees are eligible for the jackpot prize when off-duty and out of uniform only.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this promotion.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive jackpot when either in the player-dealer or player capacity.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible for this promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

Progressive Prize

- A Royal Flush pays 100% of the progressive prize as shown on the meter.
- The winner(s) will be paid in live casino chips by a casino representative once their hand has been verified.
- All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.

Envy Bonus

- A player paying the \$1 jackpot fee also qualifies to win an Envy payout. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an Envy pay, all other players who placed the optional \$1 jackpot fee will receive the Envy Bonus. The player who achieved the qualifying hand receives the normal prize pay only and does not receive the Envy pay.
- If a player's hand triggers an Envy payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the house dealer will lock up the cards. The house dealer will then move on to the next player.
- The house dealer pays any Envy Bonuses at the end of the round. The payouts will be paid from the cage, not from the house dealer's tray.

Fixed Prize

- All fixed payouts will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, a casino representative will pay the winners in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.
- All fixed payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund, not from the progressive meter. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.
- In the event more than one qualifying hand hits during the same round, all qualifying hands will be paid the posted fixed amount.

Funding

The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot is player funded with both fixed and progressive elements. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot in an amount ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and will be documented in the accounting records.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, the progressive meter will be re-seeded by the reserve fund in an amount ranging from \$5,000 - \$10,000. If there are not sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the Casino will cover any shortfall and shall not be reimbursed. The Casino shall only be reimbursed the initial seed.

The progressive prize pool will increase daily based solely on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. Furthermore, there is no cap on the progressive jackpot.
