Advertisement Requirements

Ocean View Card Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Bargain Buy-in Promotion.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be displayed conspicuously and prominently in the Ocean View Card Room at all times:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Necessary amount to buy-in in order to receive the additional chips, and the amount
 of additional chips that will be received.
- Procedures to redeem the additional chips.
- Time requirements in order to keep the additional chips.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Controlled Game

The Bargain Buy-in Promotion shall be attached to all limits and versions of the currently approved games offered at the Oceanview Card Room, as listed below.

- Texas Hold'em GEGA-001118
- Texas Hold'em High-Low Split GEGA-001112
- Crazy Pineapple GEGA-001117
- Crazy Pineapple High-Low Split GEGA-001108
- Omaha GEGA-001116
- Omaha High-Low Split GEGA-001110

All base game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Prize

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion features a fixed prize element ranging in value from \$5 to \$200 in the form of casino chips, as pre-determined and designated by the Ocean View Card Room.

Rules of Play

This promotion will award players who play during the pre-determined and specifically posted hours with instant cash in the form of card room chips. For example, Players will receive a fixed amount of \$60.00 in chips for the purchase price of \$30.00 in cash during live play. Players will receive the chips at the time they buy in. Players are required to play between one and four hours to retain the additional bonus chips. Players must play for the required one to four hours or go bust. Players shall be required to fulfill the pre-determined and designated time in order to keep the bonus chips. If the player has lost all of their chips before they have fulfilled the required amount of time, including the bonus chips, then they have fulfilled the time requirement. In the event that a customer has to leave before the required amount of playing time has been fulfilled, then that customer shall return the entire bonus chip amount or any remaining amount of chips up to the bonus chip amount, as long as they have enough left in

play. If the amount of chips left in play does not equal the amount of bonus chips given, the Ocean View Card Room shall not require a player to pay the difference.

In order to keep track of the bonus chip distribution and time of play, a floor person shall maintain a daily log during the promotional period, which shall be used to track the time of play for each player that participates. The log will contain the player's name, the current date, time in, time out, and the starting and ending date of the promotional period in which players may participate in the promotion. Each daily log sheet will be manually recorded, tracked, maintained, and stored by the Ocean View Card Room. It is the player's responsibility to sign in at the start of their game with the floor manager, as well as to sign out with the floor manager when they leave. Furthermore, the player must initial their log for credit of time played. Time accumulated during the promotional period for each player shall be by the Ocean View Card Room.

Eligibility

- The required buy-in shall range from \$20 to \$200 in order to qualify for the bonus casino chips.
- To be eligible for the promotion, players must be in the card room during the hours that the promotion is being offered.
- Players are required to play for a specific time period between one and four hours in order to keep the bonus chips.
- Eligible time periods will occur daily and will be pre-determined and posted. Players who
 buy-in for the pre-determined and specified amount of chips and play in a qualifying
 game beginning at a pre-determined and posted time will receive a pre-determined and
 specified amount of promotional chips.
- There is no minimum or maximum number of players required to be playing in a poker game in order to qualify.
- Casino employees are eligible to win this promotion; however, they must be off duty and out of uniform. They will be required to wear their card room badge.
- A player is eligible to participate in this promotion up to three times in a 24-hour period.
- There are no other entities or persons other than the gambling enterprise involved in this gaming activity.
- All procedures, times, and prize amounts shall be displayed prominently at all times the Bargain Buy-In Promotion is being offered for play via any form of advertising that the Ocean View Card Room wishes to use, including but not limited to printed flyers, digital display, the Card Room's website, etc.

Funding

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion shall be fully funded by the Ocean View Card Room. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate. All collection fees and table limits are for the designated controlled game and are Bureau approved, pre-determined, and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

The Ocean View Card Room shall not retain an administrative fee as the gaming activity is funded by the Ocean View Card Room.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Match Play/Free Play Promotion

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Oceanview Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-004651) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Oceanview Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Coupon and/or free play chip value(s).
- Procedures to redeem coupons or free play chips.
- Any other applicable restrictions.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Match Play/Free Play Promotion may be attached to all limits and versions of the currently Bureau approved California games offered at the Oceanview Casino. All base game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control.

Object and Summary

Players who receive a match play or free play coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the coupon if he/she places a wager on an eligible game equal to the amount listed on the match play coupon or if they place a free play chip without placing a wager.

Match Play Coupon

The Casino will offer match play coupons having a face value from \$5 to \$500 per coupon. The amount will be clearly stated on the coupon. Each coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) that the voucher may be used on. The wager must be equal to the amount of the match play coupon and a player's winning hand will be paid his/her wager as well as the listed amount on the match play coupon. When the player uses a match play coupon and the hand loses, the player will only lose his/her original wager and the match play coupon is collected and voided. The player-dealer will then have a key employee sign the voucher verifying that it has been won. All winning vouchers are verified and signed by a key employee. Winning vouchers may be taken to the cage by the key employee, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the coupon(s). That amount is then returned to the player-dealer. If a player loses, the player-dealer collects the money part of the wager, and the voucher is voided and collected as well. If the player pushes (receives no action), the voucher may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a match play voucher with a value of \$5.00 that specifically states it may be used to place a wager on the Blackjack table. The person would place the voucher on the gaming table; place a bet that matches the amount on the voucher, and pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play. The collection fee is based only on the wager and not the coupon. If the player wins the hand, he/she will receive \$10.00 just as if they had placed a \$10.00 bet and the player-dealer will collect the voucher.

Match Play/Free Play Promotion

Free Play Chip

The Casino will offer free play chips having a face value from \$5.00 to \$500.00 per chip. The free play chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash.

The free play chips shall initially be in the form of a coupon, which shall be offered to all patrons that wish to come into the Casino and use them to play. Patrons may be awarded free play coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, transportation to the Casino via the Casino's bus system, etc. When a patron receives a free play coupon he/she shall take the coupon to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the free play chip(s) to be used in a live game. There are no restrictions on the amount of free play chips a player may use. Each coupon shall state the specific qualifying game(s) that the free play chip(s) may be used on. The associate in the cage will then exchange the coupon for the corresponding free play chip, which can then be used for play.

Free play chips shall be used as the player's bet and placed on the betting circle. Free play chips shall not be taken into the dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray. The person in the player/dealer position will collect the free play chip. The player-dealer will then have a key employee verify that the chip has been played. A key employee verifies all played free play chips.

The free play chip is taken to the cage by a key employee, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the chip. That amount is then returned to the player-dealer. If the player loses the hand, the free play chip is forfeited and will be collected by the casino dealer and dropped in the drop box for accounting purposes. If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a free play chip coupon for \$10.00 that specifically states it can be used to place a wager on the Blackjack table. The player would take the coupon to the cage. Cage personnel would log the redemption code of the coupon and exchange the coupon for a promotional free play chip. The player would then place the free play chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection (if applicable), and the game would play.

Eligibility Requirements

The promotion will be open to all players who are seated and playing at the above listed games during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the promotion.

- A minimum of two (2) players, a player and a player-dealer, is required to be playing in any of the games, as listed above, in order for the game to qualify.
- Each coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) that a player may use the coupon at.
- Players shall not exchange the coupons for live chips or give them to another player.
- The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a key employee.
- Casino Employees, on and off duty and in and out of uniform, are not eligible for the promotion

Match Play/Free Play Promotion

- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible for the promotion.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this promotion.

Prize

The match play coupons and/or free play chips shall have a value ranging from \$5 to \$500 for each coupon or free play chip. Players shall not exchange match play coupons or free play chips for live chips. Additionally, players shall not give match play coupons or free play chips to another player. The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a key employee.

<u>Funding</u>

The Match Play/Free Play Promotion shall be fully funded by the Casino. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

No Purchase Necessary

The Match Play/Free Play Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Oceanview Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should Oceanview Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-002223) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Poker Tournaments. Furthermore, all rules and procedures for Poker Tournaments, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Oceanview Casino at all times that a Poker Tournament is offered for play:

- How a player may enter the tournament.
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament.
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by Oceanview Casino, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution.
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament.
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid.
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid.
- The rules and procedures for any and all gaming activities that are being offered in conjunction with the Poker Tournaments.
- Any other restrictions that apply to the Poker Tournaments.

Tournament Log

Oceanview Casino shall maintain all completed tournament logs for at least seven years. These logs shall be maintained in either paper or electronic format. The cardroom shall also retain and make available the most recent three months of the tournament logs for inspection by a representative of the Bureau during all hours of operation. Upon request of the Bureau, a licensee shall provide the Bureau with copies of such tournament logs. Tournament logs shall contain the following information:

- Name of Gambling Establishment.
- Day, date, time and name advertised for the tournament.
- Total number of tables used.
- Name of controlled games offered.
- Method of entry.
 - If the method of entry used is different than the advertised entry method, then specify what the method is (gaming activity, points system, etc.). If the method of entry is through a gaming activity, then specify the gaming activity name and BGC ID.
- Number and amount of rebuys and/or add-ons offered.
- Source of all funds for tournament prize pool.
- Number of participants.
- Name of each fee charged, amount of each fee charged, total number of each fee collected, and cumulative amount of charged fees.
- Amount of the prize pool.
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool.
- Name of gaming activities offered (when applicable).
 - o Funding source

- o Prize amount
- Total number of prizes awarded
- Total amount deducted from prize pool (when applicable)
- Results of the tournament, including the amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament.
- Signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament.

Eligible Controlled Games

The tournament games that may be played during Poker Tournaments at Oceanview Casino shall only be those as listed below. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Crazy Pineapple Hi-Lo (GEGA-001108)

Gaming Activities Offered During Tournament Play

Bounties

Bounty targets are tournament players who are selected prior to the start of the tournament. During the play of a tournament, either a single player or multiple players in a tournament may be designated as bounty targets. If a bounty target player loses all of their tournament chips during a hand of play and is eliminated from the tournament, the winner of that hand shall win a pre-determined and designated amount of money ranging in value between \$1 and \$10,000. The bounty prize maybe house funded or funded from the prize pool. It will be pre-determined and posted if the bounty is funded from the prize pool. If the bounty target player is in the final table of the tournament, and the final table decides to split the prize pool evenly, the bounty prize will become part of the total to split.

Points System

Object and Summary

During a predetermined and posted time period, Oceanview Casino may offer tournament players a predetermined amount of points that will entitle a player to a prize and/or entry into a freeroll or grand finale tournament. The range of points will be from 1-100. A casino employee will track players' points on a log. At a minimum, the log will contain the player's name, how points were earned, and how many points earned. Once a player uses points, to earn a prize or to be entered into another tournament, the points used will be deducted on the log. Players can check their total amount of points at any time by asking a casino employee. Points are non-transferrable and will only be valid for specific time purposes.

EXAMPLE: There are twenty-four (24) tournament events held during the Legends of Poker Tournaments at the Casino. Ten (10) of the tournaments will be pre-designated as points tournaments where the players who finish in the top 25 will be awarded a

predetermined number of points (depending on which place they finish in) that will accumulate during the month. At the end of the point qualification, the winner of the top points winner could win a car or the top nine (9) winners will be granted a free entry into the \$10,000 main event.

Eligibility Requirements

 Casino employees are eligible when off duty. Third Party Proposition Players are not eligible to participate in Poker Tournaments.

Prize

Players may qualify for prizes ranging in value from \$10-\$25,000, in the form of cash or chips. Players may also gain entry into a future tournament by utilizing the Points System.

Funding

The Points System will be house funded.

Tournament Variation

Freeroll Tournament

- It shall be predetermined and posted when a freeroll tournament shall be offered.
- Entry is gained by utilizing 1-100 points from the points system awarded during specified tournament play. This shall be displayed prior to the start of any qualifying tournament.
- The freeroll tournament prize pool is funded by \$5, which is taken from the buy-in for each tournament
- The house may add extra funds to the existing freeroll tournament prize pool to increase the amount.

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure will be on any and all Oceanview Casino advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure shall not change once sign-ups begin.
- Promotional materials will not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the number of tournament chips provided shall be equal and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament or via a promotion. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- More than one method of entry for a specific tournament may be utilized.

- *\$5 from every buy-in shall be placed into a prize pool to fund free roll tournaments.
- **The entry fee shall be retained by the Casino to run the tournament and/or to pay expenses and tips for the dealers and staff.
- ***The service charge is used exclusively to pay the tournament staff for tips, etc. This is not income for the Casino.
- ****The dealer appreciation fee shall be retained by Oceanview Casino and used exclusively to pay tournament staff. This shall be an optional fee that tournament entrants may pay in exchange for additional tournament chips. This fee shall not be included in the tournament prize pool.

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

The prizes will be the cumulative amount of buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. The prizes may also be guaranteed. The cardroom may provide prizes or add funds to the prize pool for special events.

- When the prize amount is guaranteed, the payout will be a cash value ranging from \$100 \$25,000. The cash will be paid to players from the buy-ins, rebuys, and add-ons. If there is not enough cash to cover the guaranteed prize amount, the casino will fund the difference.
- When the prize is a non-cash item(s), the item(s) value will range from \$100 \$25,000. The prize(s) cost will be reimbursed from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. If there is not enough cash to cover the cost of the prize(s), the casino will fund the difference.
- When the prize pool is not base solely on buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons (freeroll)
 Oceanview Casino will determine and set the payout structure.

Tournament Prize Structure

When the prize is not guaranteed, the prize structure shall be broken down by the number of paid entries and percentage paid. The percentage paid out will always equal 100%. In the event the players decide to forgo the payout structure and "split" the total prize pool among them, it shall be permitted and shall be noted in detail on the casino's tournament log. All active players must agree on how the prize pool will be split.

Additional Prizes

Other prizes may include merchandise such as clothing, gift cards, vehicles, jewewlry, etc., and/or entry into other tournaments.

No Purchase Necessary

The gaming activities attached to the Poker Tournaments shall be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminant basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary (NPN) game. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for patrons who request to participate in the gaming activities attached to the Poker Tournaments without paying any entry into the tournament. The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the tournament player. All advertisements shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the gaming activities offered during the Poker Tournaments.
