NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8 (c), and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Justice (DOJ) is providing notice of changes made to the proposed regulations amending Sections 700 through 708, Article 1, Chapter 7, Title 11, of the California Code of Regulations (CCR). These regulations as originally proposed were the subject of a Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action published in the California Regulatory Notice Register, Register 2014, No. 38-Z, September 19, 2014, OAL Notice File No. Z-2014-0908-01.

Modification to Section 702. Accessing Criminal Offender Record Information.

As a result of revisions to the DOJ privacy notices on data collection forms, the Custodian of Records Application for Confirmation (Form Number BCIA 8374) and Custodian of Records Notification (Form BCIA 8375) have been updated. The new revision dates of these forms are reflected in this section. The Custodian of Records Notification (Form BCIA 8375), previously the Annual Custodian of Records Notification, was retitled to reflect changes to current law that removed the requirement for annual notification.

These changes are necessary to ensure that the forms incorporated by reference by these regulations are the most current versions and reflect what appears on the Attorney General's website.
