About the Organization

Attorney General Kamala D. Harris is the state's chief law enforcement officer, responsible for ensuring that state laws are uniformly and adequately enforced. The California Department of Justice includes approximately 4,500 employees who provide legal and law enforcement services to the state, including representing the People of California in civil and criminal matters before trial courts, appellate courts and the supreme courts of California and the United States, and law enforcement activities such as criminal investigations, apprehending criminals, and exchanging criminal intelligence using state-of-the-art technology. Position and Length of Term

The Consumer Law Fellowship program will be awarded on a competitive basis. It is a one-year program for a lawyer who is committed to public service and consumer protection. Fellow will have the opportunity to work on substantive, high-impact consumer legal matters, as well as the chance to help formulate wide-ranging policy initiatives. Additionally, program participant will receive training and mentorship advice from some of the most senior members of the Attorney General's office. For the 2014-2015 program, the fellow will be based in the Los Angeles Attorney General's office.

Minimum Qualifications

Program is open to lawyers in at least their fourth year of practice with experience providing direct legal services related to foreclosures and other housing issues. Program requires a one year commitment, beginning in December 2014.

Additional Desired Qualifications

Demonstrated interest in public service and talent for detailed legal research and cogent writing; outstanding oral advocacy skills, and an ability to work well under pressure. Distinguished academic record at an accredited law school. Applicants in the top 10% of their class strongly preferred. Must be admitted to the California Bar.
