For the period January through December, 1995,

Of 2,626 victims of hate crimes,

- Most (2,286) were individuals. Of these,
  - 71.0 percent (1,622 individuals) were victims because of their race/ethnicity.
  - 11.0 percent (251 individuals) were victims because of their religion.
  - 17.9 percent (410 individuals) were victims because of their sexual orientation.
  - .1 percent (3 individuals) were victims because of their physical/mental disability.
