Machinegun Inventory, Acquisition, Disposition and Manufacture INSTRUCTIONS

REQUIREMENTS:

The sale of a machinegun to a law enforcement agency, military agency, or a California machinegun permittee requires the possession of a California machinegun license. The machinegun license holder (licensee) must maintain current records of inventory, acquisitions, dispositions, and manufacture of machinegun possessed and/or manufactured in California pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 11, section 4130, subdivision (a). Current records must be maintained on form BOF 041, or a computer generated printout using the same format. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 11, § 4130, subd. (a)(1).) The licensee must make these records available to any peace officer or other persons designated by the Attorney General upon request. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 11, § 4130, subd. (h).)

The licensee must also submit to the Department of Justice (DOJ) an annual report of inventory, acquisitions, dispositions, and manufacture of machinegun(s) possessed and/or manufactured in California. The annual report shall list all machinegun(s) possessed by the licensee at any time during the reporting term. All acquisitions, dispositions, manufacture, lost or stolen machinegun(s), and machinegun(s) in continued possession from the prior permit term must be reported. The annual report must be submitted to DOJ with the Annual Dangerous Weapons License/Permit(s) Renewal Application, form BOF 031. Or, upon termination of the permit, a final report detailing all remaining unreported activities must be submitted to DOJ.

Completing the Machinegun Report of Inventory, Acquisition, Disposition, and Manufacture form:

This form allows you to report up to three separate machinegun(s). Make as many copies of this form as required to complete the reporting requirement. Place a sequential entry number in the indicated space for each reported activity. **Please complete the following fields for all entries:**

- Acquisition Type & Date
- Transferor Name & Type
- Transferor Permit Number (Machinegun License or Out-of-State FFL)
