FEES

The BOF's initial dangerous weapons license/permit fee (minus the \$32 state and \$19 federal fingerprint fees already paid to obtain electronic fingerprints at an approved Live Scan station), is \$321 for the first license or permit, plus \$22 for each additional license or permit.

While dangerous license permit inspection fees pursuant to Penal Code sections 18910, 31110, 32670, and 33320 do not apply to the initial application, please remain mindful inspection fees are charged with each renewal application at the following rates: 0 to 4 inventory, \$165; 5 to 25 inventory, \$750; 26 or more inventory, \$1500; out-of-state permit holders with no California based location, \$100.





Collector In-State Acquisition of Curio or Relic Long Gun Report Requirements

Federally licensed collectors (FFL type 03) in California who have a current COE may acquire curio or relic long guns from non-licensees without completing the transfer through a licensed firearms dealer only if he/she completes and submits this report to the California Department of Justice within thirty (30) days of taking possession of the long gun. Your failure to comply with this reporting requirement could result in criminal prosecution. (Pen. Code, §§ 27590 & 27966)

The following must be submitted with your application and mailed to the Department of Justice, Bureau of Firearms-C&R, P.O. Box 820200, Sacramento CA 94203-0200:

- \$19.00 processing fee (check or money order made payable to the Department of Justice) (Pen. Code, § 28230, (a)(3))
- A copy of your California driver license or identification card. (Cal. Code Reg., tit 11, § 4045.1)
- If your California driver license or identification card has "FEDERAL LIMITS APPLY" on the front, you shall also submit proof of lawful presence in the United States, in the form of one of the following documents:

Once approved, you will receive a confirmation notice of your Collector In-State Acquisition of Curio or Relic Long Gun Report.

This form may not be used to report ownership of assault weapons defined in Penal Code sections 30510 through 30530. It is the responsibility of the applicant to determine if the firearm being reported is an assault weapon. 


