I love my job and the atmosphere I work in. As an employee at Players Casino, I'm paid a good wage that allows me to provide for myself and my family. I'm also working in a safe, smoke-free environment that allows me to maintain my health. At Players Casino, I'm more than a name - I'm valued, supported, and part of a team that takes care of each other. In addition the majority of our customers are local. The environment is like a large extended family in the community.

The changes your organization has proposed to player-dealer games would seriously impact our card room, our many local customers and my life. Loss of revenues from these games to my card room could mean the loss of my job and my ability to earn a living as well as viewed as a significant negative by our many customers.
