Section 100. CHANGES WITHOUT REGULATORY EFFECT

Pursuant to Title 1, Division 1, Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 100(b)(3), of the California Code of Regulations (CCR), the California Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement, Bureau of Gambling Control (Bureau) hereby submits this written statement explaining why the proposed changes to CCR Title 11, Division 3, Chapter 1, Article 8, sections 2084, 2086, 2088, 2089, 2090, 2091, 2092, 2095, 2096, 2107, and 2019, have no regulatory effect.

Changes to Text

In each regulatory section incorporating forms amended to this Section 100 action, revision dates have been updated given non-substantive changes to the forms, described below.

Changes to forms incorporated by reference

Update of application revision dates

All revision dates of forms in this Section 100 (reflecting the changes described below) are updated on the form itself and in references within other forms, if applicable.

Update of the Bureau's phone number

Effective July 5, 2017, the Bureau moved to a new address and received a new contact phone number. All references or instructions regarding the Bureau's phone number have been changed to the new phone number.

These changes do not materially alter any existing requirements for applicants or those submitted the required forms. The changes are necessary to ensure that forms include updated information where constituents are able to reach the Bureau in the event they need assistance.

Deletion of Bureau fax number

The fax number for the Bureau has been deleted from applications as applicable because it is unnecessary. No forms for this program have been received via fax. The proposed change concerning the removal of the fax number does not alter any of the Bureau's existing practices or the rights of applicants with respect to the application process.

For those forms that require a fee, because the Bureau does not have the capability or systems to process payments via fax or electronically, the following four forms may only be submitted in hardcopy, either in person, via mail or express delivery and will only be processed when submitted with required fees:

- Major League Sports Raffle Eligible Organization Registration Form (BGC 200)
- Major League Sports Raffle Manufacturer and Distributor of Products or Services Annual Registration Form (BGC 201)

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- Major League Sports Raffle Manual Draw Supervisor Annual Registration Form (BGC 202)
- Major League Sports Raffle Eligible Organization Registered Event Registration Form (BGC 204)

The three remaining forms required as part regulations for the Major League Sports Raffle Program do not require a fax number because 1. There are no fees associated or required for the use or submission of the form(s); 2. Those which require submission to the Bureau (BGC 203 and BGC 205) have not been received via fax during the program's history of operation; 3. Those which require submission to the Bureau (BGC 203 and BGC 205) have occasionally been submitted to the Bureau's e-mail address that is included in the instruction and not via fax; and, 4. The remaining form (BGC 206) is completed and maintained by the eligible organization and not submitted to the Bureau:

- Major League Sports Raffle Eligible Organization Annual Report (BGC 203)
- Major League Sports Raffle Eligible Organization Equipment Registration Form (BGC 205)
- Major League Sports Raffle Electronic Raffle System and Equipment Checklist and Test Draw (BGC 206)

To reiterate, no forms for this program have been received via fax. Those forms which require a fee in order for the form to be processed for registration cannot be received via fax as the Bureau does not have the capability or systems to receive payments via fax or electronically.

In conclusion, the above changes are nonsubstantive and conforming. They have no regulatory effect, as they do not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription, or other regulatory element of any CCR provision.

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
