TO: ALL APPLICANT AGENCIES

Effective January 1, 2013, Chapter 256, Statutes of 2012 (Assembly Bill 2343) amends Penal Code section 11105 pertaining to the release of Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI).

On January 1, 2013, any authorized agency, organization or individual must expeditiously furnish a copy of the CORI to the person to whom the information relates if the information is a basis for an adverse employment, licensing, or certification decision. When CORI is furnished other than in person, the copy will be delivered to the last known contact information provided by the applicant.
