

Release Notes August 2017, pdf

The 4.10.0 CAPSS Release was successfully implemented after thorough system testing on Thursday August 10, 2017. The majority of changes were dedicated to improving the submission searches and the various reports that may be used by various law enforcement clients including the licensing administration that manage the licensing process. The CAPSS team is in the process of finalizing the last few enhancements to the system that will facilitate the navigation and data file submissions for all required entities. All Second Hand Dealers and Pawn Brokers that are required to submit property transactions pursuant to Business & Professions Code 21628 should be utilizing CAPSS for reporting purposes. The Department of Justice will soon be advising all LEA's that the functionality to enter *Pawn or Buy* transactions via the Automated Property System will no longer be available.

Please note, no system program changes are required for this release.

The enhancements for this release included:

- Addition of a new feature allowing LEAs the ability to view both successful and unsuccessful submission transactions
- Added wildcard (*) search functionality to specified searches
- Addition of new reports for LEA clients
- Improved email notifications

Next Planned Release is tentatively scheduled for late October 2017.

Release **4.11.0** enhancements will include:

- Improve Multi-store management
- Improve the view and display of data for various searches
- Add a "system alert" when specified situations or events occur
- Tighten up the process for modifying the SERIAL (SER) or OWNER APPLIED NUMBER (OAN) fields
- Improve query performance

Enhancements or changes scheduled for the **4.11.0** Release will not require any system program changes.
