

21 THIS MATTER is before the Court on *Plaintiff's Request for Entry of Default*  
22 *Judgment* against Defendant **GTC INDUSTRIES, LTD., also known as GOLDEN**  
23 **TOBACCO COMPANY** (hereafter, "**GTC INDUSTRIES**"). This Court has considered  
24 *Plaintiff's Request for Entry of Default Judgment* and accompanying declarations, papers and  
25 exhibits thereto, and the entire record in this matter and hereby finds as follows:

26 1. The Attorney General of the State of California brings this action on behalf of  
27 Plaintiff, the People of the State of California, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code  
28 section 104557(c), to enforce the reserve fund requirements of California Health and Safety Code

1 sections 104555-104557.

2           2. The Defendant, **GTC INDUSTRIES**, is a company that has transacted and is  
3 transacting business in California and manufactures cigarettes as defined in California Health and  
4 Safety Code section 104556(i)(1).

5           3. At least thirty (30) days have passed since the date of service of the First  
6 Amended Summons and First Amended Verified Complaint and **GTC INDUSTRIES** has failed  
7 to appear and defend in this court.

8           4. **GTC INDUSTRIES** was not at the time of service of said Summons and Verified  
9 Complaint, nor is now, an infant or minor, a financially incapable, incapacitated or incompetent  
10 person, nor in the military service as defined by Article 1 of the "Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil  
11 Relief Act of 1940" as amended (50 U.S.C. Appen. § 501 et seq.).

12           5. Jurisdiction has been reviewed and is proper pursuant to California Code of Civil  
13 Procedure, section 410.10.

14           6. Venue has been reviewed and is proper pursuant to California Code of Civil  
15 Procedure, section 393.

16           7. **GTC INDUSTRIES** has failed and continues to fail and/or refuse to comply or  
17 otherwise bring itself into compliance with the reserve fund requirements of California Health  
18 and Safety Code, sections 104555-104557 and implementing regulations (Title 11, Calif. Code of  
19 Reg., §§ 999.10a through 999.14).

20           8. **GTC INDUSTRIES** has engaged in and continues to engage in acts of unfair  
21 competition as defined in California Business & Professions Code, section 17200, in that **GTC**  
22 **INDUSTRIES** has failed to establish the required reserve fund and failed to certify compliance  
23 to the Attorney General, in violation of California Health and Safety Code sections 104555,  
24 104556, and 104557 and implementing regulations.

25           9. Notwithstanding notice, **GTC INDUSTRIES** failed to establish a Qualified  
26 Escrow Fund (as defined in California Health and Safety Code section 104556(f)) and also failed  
27 to make the annual deposits as required under California Health and Safety Code section 104557.  
28 Accordingly, **GTC INDUSTRIES**'s actions constitute "knowing" violations.

1           10. **GTC INDUSTRIES** has committed two or more knowing violations of  
2 California Health and Safety Code section 104557 and is therefore subject to the maximum  
3 sanctions and penalties provided for under the reserve fund requirements of California Health  
4 and Safety Code section 104557.

5           **THEREFORE**, default having been entered by the clerk against **GTC INDUSTRIES**,  
6 as requested by Plaintiff, **JUDGMENT** is accordingly entered in favor of the Plaintiff and  
7 against **GTC INDUSTRIES** with respect to all claims, **AS FOLLOWS**:

8           A. **GTC INDUSTRIES** shall, within fifteen (15) days of this Order, place into a  
9 Qualified Escrow Fund the following amounts as such amounts are adjusted for inflation as  
10 required by California Health and Safety Code section 104557(a)(2):

11                   **Sales during the year 2001:**

12                   **(11,826,080 units x \$0.0136125%) plus 9.68306% for inflation for a total of**  
13                   **\$176,570.47.**

14           B. **GTC INDUSTRIES** shall, within fifteen (15) days of this Order, provide Plaintiff  
15 with a list of the names of all cigarette brands manufactured by **GTC INDUSTRIES**, as well as  
16 unit sales information and supporting documentation for sales in California in 2001.

17           C. **GTC INDUSTRIES** shall, within fifteen (15) days of this Order, pay civil penalties  
18 in the amount of 300% of the escrow amounts improperly withheld, for a total of **\$529,711.41** for  
19 knowingly violating California Health and Safety Code section 104557(a)(2), (c), by failing to  
20 certify to the Attorney General for the State of California that it is in compliance with  
21 California's reserve fund statute and for knowingly failing to establish a qualified escrow fund  
22 as defined under California Health and Safety Code section 104556(f) and knowingly failing to  
23 deposit sufficient escrow funds into a qualified escrow fund as required under California Health  
24 & Safety Code section 104557.

25           D. Pursuant to California Health and Safety section 104557(c)(3), **GTC INDUSTRIES**  
26 is hereby enjoined and otherwise prohibited from selling *any* cigarettes in California for a two-  
27 year period commencing from the date of this Order, either directly or through a distributor,  
28 retailer or other intermediary, *including but not limited to*, the following brands: "Miss

1 Diamond” and “Double Diamond.”

2 E. Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 17206, **GTC INDUSTRIES** shall,  
3 within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order, pay a penalty of \$2,500.00 for each violation  
4 of Business and Professions Code section 17200 alleged in the Third Cause of Action, for a total  
5 assessed penalty of **\$2,500.00** in addition to the penalty specified in Paragraph C of this  
6 judgment.

7 F. **GTC INDUSTRIES** shall, within fifteen (15) days from the date of this Order, shall  
8 appoint an agent for service of process in California for enforcement of this judgment and order  
9 until this judgment is satisfied, the order is obeyed and the injunction is dissolved.

10 G. The Court shall retain jurisdiction in this matter.

11 H. **GTC INDUSTRIES** shall within fifteen (15) days of this Order, pay all Plaintiff's  
12 reasonable costs, including but not limited to filing fees in the amount of **\$241.50** pursuant to  
13 Government Code section 6103.5 and subject to modification and/or further relief as this Court  
14 deems just and proper.
