Collection and Use of Personal Information. The Public Rights Division in the Department of Justice collects the information requested on this form as authorized by Government Code sections 11180, 11181, and 11182, and Business and Professions Code sections 17550 et seq. The Public Rights Division uses this information in its review of your application to register, renew, or update your registration as a Seller of Travel. (Bus. & Prof. Code section 17550.1.) We may also use this information to investigate any alleged misconduct and in any law enforcement action based on that misconduct. In addition, any personal information collected by state agencies is subject to the limitations in the Information Practices Act and state policy. Providing Personal Information. All the personal information requested in the form must be provided.

Access to Your Information. You may review the records maintained by the Public Rights Division in the Department of Justice that contain your personal information, as permitted by the Information Practices Act. See below for contact information.

In order to review your registration application, renewal, or registration update as a Seller of Travel, we may need to share the information you give us with other government agencies. This may include sharing any personal information you gave us. We may also need to share the information to further any investigation of any claim against you by the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, or a government or law enforcement agency. In addition, some of your information, including the name of the business owner and the business's address, will be available and searchable on our website.

The information you provide may also be disclosed in the following circumstances:

- With other persons or agencies where necessary to perform their legal duties, and their use of your information is compatible and complies with state law, such as for investigations or for licensing, certification, or regulatory purposes;
- To another government agency as required by state or federal law.
