**I N D I C T M E N T**

The Grand Jury charges:

JEFF LIVINGSTON,

defendant herein, as follows:

COUNT ONE: [18 U.S.C. § 1168(b) - Theft by Officers or Employees of  
Gaming Establishments on Indian Lands]

**I. INTRODUCTION:**

1. At all times material to this Indictment, JEFF LIVINGSTON  
was an employee of the Chukchansi Gold Resort Casino ("Chukchansi").

2. At all times material to this Indictment, JEFF LIVINGSTON  
was employed at Chukchansi as the General Manager.

3. At all times material to this Indictment, Chukchansi is  
owned and operated by the Picayune Rancheria of the Chukchansi  
Indians, a federally recognized Indian tribe.

1           4.       Beginning in or about June of 2007 and continuing until  
2 in or about July of 2007, within the Eastern District of California,  
3 defendant JEFF LIVINGSTON, being an employee of Chukchansi Gold  
4 Resort Casino, a gaming establishment owned and operated by the  
5 Picayune Rancheria of the Chukchansi Indians pursuant to an ordinance  
6 or resolution approved by the National Indian Gaming Commission, did  
7 willfully and knowingly embezzle, abstract, purloin, misapply, or  
8 take with the intent to steal, any moneys, funds, assets, and other  
9 property of such establishment of a value in excess of \$1,000,  
10 namely: using a Chukchansi corporate credit card to pay for down  
11 payments on personal vehicles, all in violation of Title 18, United  
12 States Code, Section 1168(b).

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1 COUNT TWO: [18 U.S.C. § 1168(b) - Theft by Officers or Employees of  
2 Gaming Establishments on Indian Lands]

3 5. The allegations contained in paragraphs 1 through 3 of  
4 Count 1 are hereby re-alleged and incorporated herein.

5 6. In or about May of 2007, within the Eastern District of  
6 California, defendant JEFF LIVINGSTON, being an employee of  
7 Chukchansi Gold Resort Casino, a gaming establishment owned and  
8 operated by the Picayune Rancheria of the Chukchansi Indians pursuant  
9 to an ordinance or resolution approved by the National Indian Gaming  
10 Commission, did willfully and knowingly embezzle, abstract, purloin,  
11 misapply, or take with the intent to steal, any moneys, funds,  
12 assets, and other property of such establishment of a value in excess  
13 of \$1,000, namely: using a Chukchansi corporate credit card to  
14 purchase a personal vacation package to Hawaii all in violation of  
15 Title 18, United States Code, Section 1168(b).

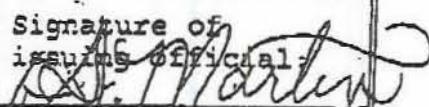
