Notice published November 21, 2022

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8, subdivision (c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Justice (Department) is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation sections 300, 301, 303, 305, existing 308 (renumbered to 313), 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, 319, 320, 321, 322, and 323. The Department is also providing notice of changes made to the forms incorporated by reference. Further, the Department proposes to delay the effective date of the above-listed regulation sections to January 1, 2024.

This proposed regulation was the subject of a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking published in the California Register (Register 2022, No. 21-Z) on May 27, 2022. These changes are in response to comments received regarding the proposed regulation and for clarification purposes.
