The method for determining which table will receive the posted Splash Pot prize involves a drawing where a bin, basket, or other non-electronic randomizer shall be used. During predetermined times and intervals of the promotional period, a casino employee shall announce the commencement of the drawing. The casino employee shall then select an eligible table by randomly choosing a card, ball, or other lammer from the randomizer. A card, ball, or other lamer shall depict a number that corresponds to each eligible poker table. The cards, balls, or other lammers, which are pre-printed, equally sized and colored, shall be mixed within the randomizer, and one will be selected and announced. Once the table number is determined, the casino employee shall place the predetermined and posted prize into the pot at that table and can be won at the start of the selected table's next hand.

Splash Pot

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is no minimum amount of time played required for a table to qualify for this promotion.
- In the event that two or more players tie, the pot shall be evenly distributed between each player with the winning hand. If the prize is a non-cash prize it will be doubled, and each player shall receive a prize of equal value.
- A minimum of four players must be dealt into the game in order to qualify for the promotion. A table without four players will not be represented by a card, ball or other lammer when the table selection occurs.
 - o In the event that the table falls to three players after the table was selected for the splash pot prize, the splash pot prize will still play on that table but will not be a prize option until there are four players at the table.
- A player must call all bets, complete all rounds and have the winning hand to be eligible to win the pot with the added prize.
- Casino employees are eligible for this promotion when on or off duty, in or out of uniform
- Tournament games do not qualify for the promotion.
- There is no limit to the amount of times a player may win a prize during any given promotional period.
- One or more tables may be selected at each drawing. The number of tables to receive prizes will be clearly posted.
- When an eligible table is drawn, the card, ball, or other lammer will be placed back into the bin, basket, or lottery ball machine with the availability to be drawn again.
- New players may be seated at the selected table number in between the time that the
 table number is selected and the start of the next round of play, when the Splash Pot
 prize shall be added to the pot. However, they will not be eligible for the Splash Pot
 unless they participated in the previous hand before the table was selected.
 - o In the event that the new player wins the next hand, they will win the normal pot but not the Splash Pot. However, in the next round, the new player will then be eligible to win the Splash Pot since they will have participated in the previous round.
- A table can be selected and receive the "splashed prize" amount multiple times in a promotional period with no limit.

Prize

The fixed prize for the Splash Pot shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$10,000. The prize shall be paid in the form of live casino chips, merchandise, event tickets or gift certificates.

Funding

This promotion will be fully funded by Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom. Therefore, there shall be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom shall not retain an administrative fee as this promotion is house funded.

Splash Pot

No Purchase Necessary

The Splash Pot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Splash Pot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001253) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Prize amount or item and corresponding time period during the sports game that it shall be awarded
- Eligible controlled games and time periods
- Schedule of what and when prizes shall be awarded including if a sports game goes beyond its normal stopping point
- Amount of time required to be played in order to win a square
- Number of squares awarded based on time played
- Any No Purchase Necessary opportunity
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Sports Giveaway shall be attached to all Bureau approved poker games offered at Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Tracking Sheet

For each Sports Giveaway conducted, a Tracking Sheet must be completed. The tracking sheet shall be made available upon request from the Bureau during all hours of operation. The tracking sheet must have the following information:

- The BGC ID for the gaming activity
- Day, date, time and name advertised for the gaming activity
- Name of player and the table number they are playing at
- The teams playing in the sporting event
- The start and end time of the player playing the controlled game, along with the amount of hours played



Object and Summary

During a predetermined and posted sporting event and time, Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom shall allow "live" poker players, who have played between 1-100 hours, to put their name in a blank square on a board for the Sports Giveaway promotion. Each player's hours shall be tracked either manually by a casino representative using a tracking sheet (see above **Player Tracking Sheet**) or through the Player's Club Card (GEAR-001257). When manually tracked by a casino representative, it is the player's responsibility to check in or out with the casino representative. If a player does not check in, the gaming hours will not be counted towards the promotion. A player is no longer counted as accumulating play time once they have received their first "missed blind."

The board shall have 100 squares (10 squares by 10 squares), as shown below. Before the start of the sporting event and before players choose their square(s), numbers shall be drawn to determine the numbers assigned to each column and row. Numbers 0 through 9 shall be randomly drawn one by one from a bucket by a casino representative. The numbers shall be selected approximately one hour before the sporting event. The home team shall be represented on the top row of the diagram and the visiting team down the left side of the diagram. The assignment of the numbers shall correspond with the home team from left to right and the visiting team from top to bottom. After the numbers have been selected, players will be eligible to select their squares an hour before the start of the game on a first come first serve basis.



Squares are issued on a first come, first serve basis. Players can qualify to receive more than one square by playing for more hours. If a player qualifies to receive more than one square, the player picks one square at a time. Once all eligible players have picked their first square, players who qualify to receive more than one square can pick their next square in rotation until all squares are selected. The numbers on the board shall correspond to the score of the game. The numbers assigned to each square are determined by the point where each vertical and horizontal line intersects on the board. At the conclusion of each designated period (quarter, inning, period, halftime, and final), the player who selected the box that matches the final digit of the score from the top column and the side row would win the posted prize amount. Only the last digit of each team's score shall be applied to the numbers on the board. For example: Player A selected the box that has Denver 0 and San Diego 4. The score at the end of halftime is San Diego 14 and Denver 10, so Player A wins.

If the game goes beyond its normal stopping point, as in the case of a tie, the promotion shall continue and prizes shall continue to be awarded according to the advertised prize schedule. The rules for the event shall state the designated time(s) during the game for which prizes shall be awarded. All participants at these events shall have an equal chance to win prizes.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of two players required to be dealt in a base game for players to qualify for this promotion.
- Players must play in a poker game between 1-100 hours in order to be eligible for the promotion.
- Players may change tables at any time during the promotion, per existing casino procedures.
- Players are eligible to win more than one prize during any given promotional period.
- Players are eligible to receive more than one square on the board by playing more hours. Players are awarded one square for each hour they are actively gaming. There is no limit to the amount of squares a player can win in a promotional period.
- Only players seated and playing at a table, at the end of the designated scoring period, shall be eligible for the prize.
- This promotion is restricted to Player's Club members (GEAR-001257).
- The winning player must be present to win. The winner has five minutes to claim their prize or the posted prize amount shall be added to the next sporting event.
- If the score were to land on a blank square, the prize shall be rolled over to the next sporting event.
- Tournament tables shall not be eligible to participate in this promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in this promotion on or off duty, in or out of uniform.

Prize

The amount of the prize for the Sports Giveaway promotion will be fixed. The prize will range from \$5 to \$100,000. The prize shall be paid in the form of cash, live casino chips, merchandise, clothing, vehicles, or electronics.

Funding

The Sports Giveaway shall be fully funded by Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

Administrative Fee

Hemphill's Lounge and Cardroom shall not retain an administrative fee as the gaming activity is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Sports Giveaway shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Sports Giveaway</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Ace & Vine may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GETR-000133) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed or readily available in the Ace & Vine at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- How a player may enter the tournament
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by the Casino, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid
- Any other restrictions that apply to the Poker Tournaments

Tournament Log

- Amount of the prize pool
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool
- Name of gaming activities offered (when applicable)
 - Funding source
 - o Prize amount
 - Total number of prizes awarded
 - o Total amount deducted from prize pool (when applicable)
- Results of the tournament, including the total amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament

 Printed name and signature of the casino staff responsible for administering the tournament

Eligible Controlled Games

The Poker Tournaments shall be attached to all Bureau approved Poker controlled games offered at the Ace & Vine at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Gaming Activities Offered During Tournament Play

Bounties

- If there is a bounty offered for the tournament; when "player x" knocks out the "advertised bounty" player(s) by ending their play in the tournament, then "player x" will be awarded their bounty.

This gaming activity shall be open to all tournament players playing at any of the above listed controlled games during predetermined specified hours and posted for the gaming activity. Listed below are specific eligibility requirements:

- Players will qualify for a freeroll tournament by playing for a minimum of 1 hour in a qualifying live game. The top 10 – 100 players will be entered into the freeroll tournament, tracked with a spreadsheet maintained by the Casino.
- Players entered into the freeroll tournament will either not be required to pay an entry fee or will have their entry fee reduced.
- All procedures, times and point amounts will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

Prize

The prize pool will range from \$100 - \$100,000.

Funding

- Only open to Player's Club Card members (GEAR-001257)
- Opportunity for No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Hot Seat Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved games for Ace & Vine. All base game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control.

Object and Summary

The Hot Seat Promotion is a house funded fixed bonus prize promotion that awards players who are dealt in a card game a chance for their seat to be drawn and for that person to win a predetermined prize. Ace & Vine will choose one of the two predetermined qualifying options, listed below, as the method to qualify for the prize. This promotion is restricted to Player's Club Members (GEAR-001257). Only one option will be used at any given time.

Option 1 - Pick a Seat/Pick a Table

Numbered placards or balls corresponding to a seat will be drawn manually from a drum or similar non-electronic device, to randomly select a "hot seat" number. Once the "hot seat" number has been determined, it will be announce on the casino floor followed by a drawing for a table number. When a designated qualifying hand is beaten by a better hand, the house dealer will inform a casino representative. The casino representative will verify both hands via video surveillance. Once the winning and losing hands are confirmed by video surveillance, those players with the qualifying jackpot hands shall receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize amount immediately from the cage by the casino representative.

Also, the table where the Bad Beat Jackpot is made at shall be eligible for a posted percentage of the jackpot prize, referred to as the Table Share (when applicable). Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of five players required to be seated and actively playing in an above mentioned game for the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- In the event two or more players make a qualifying winning and/or losing hand, the player with the highest qualifying winning and losing hand shall win the posted percentage of the prize for the hand; all other players shall win the posted percentage of the table share.

- Corresponding time played and possible points to accrue.
- The date(s) and time(s) the gaming activity shall be offered.
- The corresponding points and prize amount.
- The prize(s) offered to players meeting the requirements of the gaming activity.
- Any other applicable restrictions.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Player's Club Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Ace & Vine at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Player's Club Promotion features a promotional element attached to Bureau approved games offered at the Casino. This gaming activity is a player reward loyalty reward program open to all casino patrons. This promotion will reward players with points based on time played at designated table games during predetermined and eligible periods.

The Player's Club Promotion is fully funded by Ace & Vine. Players interested in joining the Player's Club Promotion program will be issued a plastic tracking card. This contains their name and number given by the system based on sequential order of the player being registered. Upon coming to a Bureau approved game, the player will place the card on the table and they will be tracked by the time played on that approved game. At any time, a player may view the amount of points they have earned by scanning their card at an available Player's Club Card kiosk and may redeem their points for prizes at any time.

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Prizes shall be earned by the amount of time played. Each player that plays a Bureau approved game shall have a designated casino employee swipe or scan their Player's Club Card and have their hours played tracked. Each hour will account for 1 to 1,000 points. Each point will be worth \$.50 to \$10 each.

How Points are to be Redeemed

Players may redeem their points for prizes at any time during the promotion. All prizes shall have a pre-determined and designated value. Prizes shall be earned by the amount of time played during the promotional period.  logical units for the purposes of data redundancy, performance improvement, or both.
 The system is backed up every 24 hours.

Eligibility Requirements

The Morning Chip Bonus will be open to all players who buy-in to a predetermined game, for an amount of \$10 or more; and who verbally agree to participate in an eligible game for two hours. Those players will receive standard live casino chips in the amount of their buy-in and will also receive a predetermined amount of additional live casino chips ranging from \$1 and \$1,000, which are to be used to buy-in to a predetermined eligible game.

Procedures:

- Players will buy-in to an eligible game for a predetermined minimum amount of at least \$10.
 - The player will receive live casino chips equal to the amount of their buy-in.

- A designated jackpot wagering spot is located in front of each betting position. Wagers for the jackpot will be placed in these spots before the hand is dealt.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two active players, including the player-dealer, are required to qualify for a fixed or progressive prize.
- Only seated players, who are dealt a designated hand and placed the optional jackpot fee, are eligible for payouts.
- Backline bettors are not eligible to place a jackpot fee or receive the prize amount for a qualifying hand.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Face Up Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive Jackpot only when off duty and out of uniform.

Funding

The Face Up Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive Jackpot is a player-funded progressive jackpot which features both progressive and fixed prizes.

The Casino will initially seed the jackpot in an amount between \$1,000 and \$50,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Face Up Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino and shall be documented in the accounting records. There is no cap to the Face Up Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive Jackpot.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded by the reserve fund at an amount between \$1,000 and \$50,000. In addition, the reserve fund will be used to pay out all fixed prize amounts. The progressive prize pool shall increase daily based solely on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. In the event that the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall. Once there are sufficient monies in the Face Up Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the re-seed amount will be reimbursed to the Casino and shall be documented in the accounting records.

Each \$1 jackpot fee paid by a player will be broken down as follows:

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- When a player has a progressive winning hand, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer shall then contact the casino representative.
- Once the Casino verifies the progressive win, the casino representative shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.

- Third-Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible for this gaming activity.

Prize

The Three Card Poker Progressive features both progressive and fixed prizes. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative. Once all proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.

Progressive Prize

The progressive prize will range from a minimum of \$100 and will have no maximum amount. The actual amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at, as well as the amount collected from the jackpot fees.

- 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter shall be awarded to players who are dealt a Mini Royal Flush.
 - o Progressive prize payouts will be paid from the Three Card Poker Progressive meter.
- If multiple progressive prize-winning hands hit at the same time all winning players will evenly split the posted progressive jackpot amount.
 - If there is an odd number of chips the odd chip will be awarded to the player who
 receives action on the hand first according to the base game rules.

Fixed Prizes

Fixed prizes will be awarded at a set amount of \$100 to players who are dealt a Straight Flush.

- If more than one fixed prize-winning hand hits at the same time all winning players will be paid the corresponding fixed prize amount.
- All fixed prize payouts will be paid from the Three Card Poker Progressive reserve fund.
 - o In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed from the reserve fund once there are sufficient monies.

Envy Bonus

The Envy Bonus is a fixed prize which will be awarded at a set amount of \$100. When a player achieves a Mini Royal Flush and is awarded the Progressive Prize, players who placed a \$1 jackpot fee will qualify for an Envy Bonus payout.

- The Envy Bonus will be awarded to players who placed a \$1 jackpot fee and are seated at the same table as a player who wins the Progressive Prize.
- The player who wins the Progressive Prize will not qualify for the envy payout on their own hand.
- If a player's hand triggers an Envy Bonus payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the dealer will lock up the cards. The dealer will then move on to the next player.
- The house-dealer pays any Envy Bonus payouts at the end of the round.
- All Envy Bonus payouts will be paid from the Three Card Poker Progressive reserve fund.
 - o In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed from the reserve fund once there are sufficient monies.
- In the event that multiple players, in the same table, achieve a Mini Royal Flush then all eligible players will win multiple Envy Bonus payouts.
 - The players who win the Progressive Prize will only qualify for Envy Bonus payouts for hands other than their own.

Alternative Prize Option

When predetermined, posted, and offered, winners of the jackpot will have the option to claim a prize in the form of merchandise, vehicle, trips, gift certificates, clothing, or jewelry in lieu of the entire posted jackpot prize. These alternative prize options will be assigned a monetary value that will be less than their actual retail value. The cost assigned will be reimbursed to Ace & Vine and any difference will be borne solely by the gambling establishment. Only one item will be offered, and it will be up to the winners to decide who will get it. If the winners cannot come to an agreement, the cash prize will be awarded as normal.

Example: A Vespa scooter that costs \$2,381 will be displayed in the gambling establishment with an assigned value of \$2,000. In this example, a player wins a jackpot with a posted prize of \$5,000. They will have the option of taking all of the posted prize or taking \$3,000 and the scooter which will total \$5,000. The Casino will be reimbursed (from the progressive meter) only \$2,000 and they will expense the remainder (\$381) within their bookkeeping. The rest of the progressive prize will be awarded as normal.

- Once a winner is determined, the chosen player must decide how they will claim their progressive prize.
 - Either the original prize or a combination of the original prize and the posted alternative prize.
- One Alternative Prize Option (when offered) will be available per jackpot per winner.
- All eligibility and prizes will be predetermined and posted.

All monies paid out will be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log to be maintained by the gambling enterprise, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Prize Pavout Structure

Players that make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown above, will be eligible to win a prize according to the payout table as shown below. Patrons will be provided with ample advance notice of the prize payout being offered for play. Furthermore, it will be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the Three Card Poker Progressive is being offered for play. All prizes within a chart must be offered together at all times.

Fundina

The Three Card Poker Progressive is a player-funded jackpot with both fixed and progressive prizes. The jackpot is funded by an optional \$1 jackpot fee, which is paid by players in order to be eligible for the prizes mentioned above. The \$1 jackpot fee, paid by each player, will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.20 will be immediately posted on the jackpot meter.
- \$0.80 will be tracked in the Three Card Poker Progressive reserve fund.

The Casino will initially seed the jackpot meter at the amount between \$500 and \$5,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from this reserve fund. There is no cap to the Three Card Poker Progressive meter.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, the jackpot meter will be re-seeded by the reserve fund at an amount between \$100 and \$5,000. In the event that the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the re-seed amount will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund.

All increases and decreases to the Three Card Poker Progressive reserve fund and jackpot meter shall be documented in the accounting records.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will retain an administrative fee ranging from \$16 to \$30, taken per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee shall be used for the operation costs and the administration of the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Three Card Poker Progressive shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Three Card Poker Progressive. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- 1. When a player has a progressive winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- 2. The house dealer shall then contact a casino representative.
- 3. Once a casino representative verifies the progressive win, a casino representative shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- 4. Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table, and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
- 5. When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), they will press "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
