Advertising Requirements

All base game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control.

Rules of Play

Players earn cash or prize equivalent based upon a qualifying event of getting their "pocket" Aces beaten. This occurs when a player has two Aces as their hole cards then subsequently gets beaten by a higher hand and that player does not win the pot.

Prize Amount

When a player has his/her "Aces Cracked", the floor person on duty will verify the hand and pay the pre-determined prize or prize amount. The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000 in the form of casino chips, or it may be in the form of merchandise, tournament entries, restaurant discounts or meals. All prizes for this promotion shall be pre-determined and posted in advance, throughout the gaming floor and in all literature promoting such an event.

Eligibility

The promotion shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at a poker table during the pre-determined and specified times designated for this promotion.

Aviator Casino Aces Cracked Promotion

- A player qualifies for this promotion by having their "Aces Cracked". The winning hand must be verified by the floor person on duty.
- In the event that two or more players tie a qualifying hand, the pot shall be evenly distributed between each tying player. If the prize is a non-cash prize, it will be doubled, and each player shall receive a prize of equal value.
- There is no minimum or maximum amount of players that must be dealt into the game in order for the table to qualify for the promotion.

Funding

There will be no administrative fees attached to the Aces Cracked promotion.

No Purchase Necessary

The Aces Cracked promotion shall be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a no purchase necessary (NPN) game. Aviator Casino shall provide no purchase necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in this promotion without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the live player. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Aces Cracked gaming activity. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

The Aviator Casino will offer a prize ranging in value between \$10 and \$10,000 to any pre-designated and determined specific hand.

This prize may also be in the form of food, prizes or merchandise, tournament entries, on the condition that it was designated as such prior to the commencement of the promotion.

4. If a cash prize is involved, is the amount of the prize progressive (increases) or a fixed amount?

Fixed amount.

5. Explain if the gaming activity is house funded or player funded.

House funded.

All prizes will be awarded by The Aviator Casino.

Prizes will be awarded based on a customer hitting an exact specified hand, or better, (if designated as such) during a pre-designated time period. This hand

will be displayed prominently where applicable and on all advertisements for this promotion.

Players that make one of the following advertised qualifying hands shall be eligible to win the posted prize. Patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of which qualifying hand option is being offered for play, as well as the requirements for the qualifying hand. Hole cards must play.

In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying hands the prize will be split equally.

In the event that a player qualifies to win two or more promotions at the same time, the player must choose which prize he/she wishes to receive.

Example: A player receives a bonus hand that was specified as a Royal Flush, but during this same hand he also qualifies for a Bad Beat jackpot. For all approved poker games, a player wishing to play for NPN will be seated at a designated NPN table and a dealer will be assigned to deal the requested game by the patron. The patron will choose a seat and the dealer will deal a full handed game with all cards being delivered face up. If the patron is dealt a qualifying bonus hand in their selected seat, they will be awarded 100% of the posted prize. There is no collection taken, nor wagers of any kind, and the patron may play for as long as they wish with no restrictions.

If the mystery bounty wins the tournament, he/she is paid the cash prize.

- When the prize amount is guaranteed, the payouts will be a cash value ranging from \$1 to \$500,000,000. The cash will be paid to players from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. If there is not enough cash to cover the guaranteed prize amount, the casino will fund the difference.

SUMMARY

Based on customer demand and industry trends, The Aviator Casino (AC) proposes to add a gaming activity for all currently approved controlled games. The promotion will allow a player to eat for from or at a discount from a selected menu when they play for a qualifying period of time in any Poker and/or California game. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the amount of time that a player must play in order to be eligible for the "Player's Menu." Furthermore, the time requirements and "Player's Menu" shall be displayed prominently within The Aviator Casino at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play.

PRIZE

The prize will be allowing a player to purchase a selected "Player's Menu" item at a discounted price, or for free. For players that complete the time requirement, items on the "Player's Menu" with a value of \$1 - \$25 will be for free and items on the menu with a value of \$5 - \$50 will be offered at a discounted price.

FUNDING

This promotion will be solely funded by AC. There will be no extra collection or fees of any kind assessed to the players.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

The Food Reward Program does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

ELIGIBILITY TO WIN

All players who wish to participate will be tracked by an AC customer service representative. A player will receive a card from the customer service representative, which will then be time stamped with the required time that a player must play in order to be eligible. Once the player has played a predesignated and posted time period, as stamped on the card, which has been verified by an AC customer service representative, they will be given a choice of discounted or free item(s) from the "Player's Menu."

- The time that a player must play at a table or game will range from 30 minutes up to 4 hours, as pre-determined and designated by the AC.
- A player may qualify for this promotion a maximum of three times within a 24-hour period.
- Time will be tracked by each minute of play and may be added together as a running total through the 24-hour period. However, all time accrued during a 24-hour period will expire after that period and may not be carried over from one 24-hour period to another 24-hour period.

Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive gaming activity shall be attached to all limits and versions of the currently approved games offered at the Casino, listed below. All base game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Fortune Pai Gow Poker Joker's Wild (GEGA-003154)

Rules of Play

- 1. Fortune Pai Gow Poker progressive considers the best hand possible among each individual player's cards.
- 2. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may optionally place any bonus bet wagers along with the jackpot fee of \$1.00. A minimum of two players are required to play for the progressive jackpot.
- 3. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
- 4. Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Coin In" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees shall be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection box and accounted for separately.



5. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. All seven cards will be considered with the 5 card and 2 card hands. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.

Qualifying Hand

When a player is dealt a 7 Card Straight Flush (No Joker) or a 7 Card Straight Flush (w/Joker), they are paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter. Any 5 of a kind, royal flush, straight flush or 4 of a kind receives a fixed prize amount according to the pay table below.

Eligibility Requirements

- Only seated players, who are dealt a designated hand, are eligible for payouts.
- Back-line bettors or not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee or receive the prize amount for a qualifying hand.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Fortune Pai Gow Poker prize only when off duty.
- A Third-Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPPS) is not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the Fortune Pai Gow Poker Progressive gaming activity when either in the player-dealer or player capacity.

<u>Prize</u>

All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that shall be maintained, by the gambling enterprise, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

a. A 7 Card Straight Flush (No Joker) is paid 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.



- b. A 7 Card Straight Flush (w/Joker) is paid 25% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.
- c. All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the casino will make up any shortfall.
- d. In the event more than one progressive meter pay hits during the same round, the winning players will split the posted progressive.
- e. In the event more than one fixed prize hits during the same round, all winning players will be paid the posted fixed amount. All fixed prize winners will be paid from the reserve fund. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the casino will make up any shortfall. All hands will be paid the posted prize.
- f. All fixed payouts will be paid by a Casino floor person. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the floor person will pay the winner(s) in casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the Casino dealer's tray.
- g. When a player has a progressive winner, the dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- h. The house dealer shall then contact the floor person.
- i. Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the floor person shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- j. Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table, and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
- k. When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player/dealer), he/she presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- I. Once the "J-pot" button is pressed, the prize is logged into Game Manager.

Funding

The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$1,000.00. Once there are sufficient monies in the Fortune Pai Gow Poker jackpot fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino and shall be documented in the accounting records. After the progressive jackpot is hit it will be reserved by the reserve fund as designated in the paytable chosen. It will be reserved at \$1,000.00. The progressive prize pool shall increase daily based solely on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. Furthermore, there is no cap on this progressive prize pool.



Administrative Fees

Each \$1.00 jackpot administrative fee paid by a player will be broken down as follows:

- a. \$0.14 will be immediately posted on the meter.
- b. \$0.71 will be tracked in a reserve fund. The reserve fund will be utilized to immediately reseed the metered progressive jackpot prize at \$1,000. In addition this reserve fund will payout all fixed amounts.
- c. \$0.15 will be retained by the Casino as an administrative fee.

poker rankings, the player will receive 100% of the prize amount. In the event of a tie, the player that had the high hand first in the designated time frame will receive the full prize amount.

The current high hand will be displayed prominently in an area that is easy for customers to view. At the conclusion of the time period, an appropriate employee of the casino will announce for all dealers to complete the hand they are dealing. If no new high hands occur, the prize will be awarded to the player that was listed on the display board. A hand is considered to have begun on the 1st riffle of a hand shuffled game, and the pressing of the shuffle button on a machine shuffled game.

These time frames, eligible games, and prize amounts will be displayed prominently and conspicuously and on applicable advertisements with an amount ranging from \$10 to \$10,000. This dollar amount may be in the form of food, prizes or merchandise, as long as it is designated as such before commencement of the promotion.

wager is collected by the player/dealer, and the voucher is voided and collected as well. If the player pushes (receives no action), the voucher may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

"Free Play Chip(s)"

The Casino will offer free play chips having a face value from \$5.00 to \$500.00 per chip. The chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash.

The free play chips are initially in the form of a coupon, which will be offered to all patrons that wish to come into the Casino and use them to play. If the player wins the hand, he/she would be paid \$10.00 by the person in the player/dealer position just as if he/she had placed a \$10 bet. All played free play chips are verified by a key employee. The free play chip is taken to the cage by a key employee, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the chip. If the player loses the hand, the free play chip is forfeited and will be collected by the casino dealer and dropped in the drop box for accounting purposes. If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

The Player Rewards Program features a promotional element attached to the games listed above. This gaming activity is a loyalty reward program open to all Aviator Casino patrons. This promotion will reward players with points based on time of play at designated table games during pre-determined and eligible periods, as well as for routine tracking purposes.

How Player Rewards Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points shall be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player that plays a certain table game during live play will, at certain times, receive points, which will gain them eligibility to win a pre-determined and designated prize(s). At the beginning of each hour, players have to check in with a floor person, for their hours to be tracked. Players will receive tickets for each hour of play, where they write their name and player number. They then place the tickets in a drum to be collected. At the end of the day, the floor person counts the collected tickets and tracks how many hours each player has played on a log. The range of points will be 1 to 100 points for each hour of play. The points are tracked manually by a floor person. Prior to the promotional period a sign(s) will state how many points will be earned per hour and any other details and/or restrictions. The Aviator Casino may offer bonus rates (for example, double points) on play during off-peak hours or in specific games, within the range as shown above. Patrons will be given ample notice of how many points will be awarded, as well as, the amount of time required to earn points for each eligible game.

How Player Rewards Points are Redeemed

Players may either redeem their points at any time during the promotion or at the end of the promotional period. All prizes shall have a pre-determined and designated value. After a player

has accumulated a pre-determined and specific amount of points, based on time of play, a player may redeem the accrued points for a pre-determined and designated prize.

- The amount by which the jackpot increases daily.
- Any other restrictions that apply.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Poker Jackpot will be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Aviator Casino, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Texas Hold'em (GEGA-002103)
- Mexican Poker (GEGA-002115)

Object and Summary

The Poker Jackpot features a progressive jackpot prize. A prize is awarded to players participating in an eligible poker game, as stated above, when a designated second hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand at the showdown. When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with the qualifying jackpot hands will receive the posted percentage of the progressive jackpot prize. A posted percentage of the jackpot prize, known as the table share, will be evenly distributed amongst all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated games, as shown above. In all instances, players will be provided with ample advance notice of the rules and restrictions in order to qualify for the Poker Jackpot.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make one of the following advertised qualifying hands will be eligible to win their share of the Poker Jackpot prize amount, as shown below. In order to qualify for the promotion, the player dealt the qualifying hand must use both hole cards if in Texas Hold'em or must use all cards in Mexican Poker. The following qualifying hand options will not be offered together at any time nor may any combination of the different qualifying hand options be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered. Only a winning and losing hand that has been Bureau approved and pre-determined and designated by The Aviator Casino is eligible. Players will be provided with ample advance notice of which qualifying hand option is being offered for play, as well as the requirements for the qualifying hand. Furthermore, the qualifying hand, as well as the prize amount, will be displayed prominently within The Aviator Casino at all times the Poker Jackpot is being offered for play.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Players with qualifying winning and losing hands must play through the final betting round in order to qualify for the jackpot. If a player with one of the qualifying hands folds prior to the final betting round, the table will be ineligible for the jackpot.
- A player with a missed blind button will be ineligible to win any portion of the jackpot.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a floor person will verify that both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- Four or more players are required to be dealt in during an eligible game in order for players to be eligible and the tables to qualify for Poker Jackpot prize amount and table share percentage, as well as for a jackpot collection fee to be dropped. If there are three or less players dealt in during an eligible game, the table will be in-eligible for the Poker Jackpot and the jackpot collection fee will not be dropped.
- In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying losing or winning hands, only the player with the highest ranked losing and winning poker hands will receive the posted prize percentage of the Poker Jackpot for the losing and winning hand. The remaining player(s), including those who had lower ranked qualifying hands, will receive the posted prize percentage of the table share.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate and win the jackpot at any time.

<u>Prize</u>

The jackpot prize is progressive with a minimum value of \$1,000 and a maximum value of a range between \$5,000 and \$100,000. The jackpot prize will be paid in the form of cash, check or casino chips. The actual progressive jackpot prize amount will depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at, as well as how many days have transpired in order for the posted jackpot prize to increase progressively each day. Players will be given ample notice of the actual jackpot prize amount. Furthermore, the amount of the progressive jackpot prize pool will be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the Poker Jackpot is being offered for play. When the winning and losing qualifying Poker Jackpot hands are made, the posted jackpot prize will be awarded. In all instances, players will be provided with ample advance notice of the prize amount.

Poker Jackpot

Prize Payout Structure

Players that make one of the advertised qualifying hands, as shown above, will be eligible to win their share of the posted Poker Jackpot progressive prize amount, according to the payout option, as shown below. For the prize payout structure, 50% of the posted progressive jackpot prize amount will be awarded to the player that makes the qualifying losing hand, 30% of the posted progressive jackpot prize amount will be awarded to the posted progressive jackpot prize amount will be avarded to the player that makes the qualifying losing hand, 30% of the posted progressive jackpot prize amount will be awarded to the player that makes the qualifying winning hand and 20% of the posted progressive jackpot prize amount will be evenly divided and distributed amongst all other players who are seated and participating at the qualifying table, referred to as the table share. Furthermore, the prize payout structure will be displayed prominently within The Aviator Casino at all times the Poker Jackpot is being offered for play.

Funding

The Poker Jackpot utilizes a progressive prize pool which will be player funded. A \$1 collection fee will be taken from each pot to fund this jackpot. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot in an amount ranging between \$1,000 and \$20,000. The Casino will not be reimbursed the first initial seed hereunder. The jackpot will increase daily in an amount ranging between \$10 and \$500 until the jackpot cap of an amount ranging between \$5,000 and \$100,000 has been reached. When the jackpot prize pool reaches its cap, all daily increases will be applied to the reserve fund. When a qualifying jackpot hand is made, it will be re-seeded from the reserve fund in an amount ranging between \$1,000 and \$20,000. The Aviator Casino will cover any shortfall.

Administrative Fees

The Aviator Casino may retain an administrative fee of \$3-\$8 per table, per hour from the reserve fund. The administrative fee will be utilized to cover expenses incurred by the Aviator Casino for administering the Poker Jackpot such as equipment, digital displays, drop boxes, labor costs, surveillance and accounting for the jackpot amount.

No Purchase Necessary

The Poker Jackpot will be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>, to players who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. The Casino will provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all players who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material will state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Poker Jackpot</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.
Advertisement Requirements

The Aviator Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the</u> <u>Aviator Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID listed below shall be referenced</u> <u>on all advertisements relating to the Poker Tournaments.</u>

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for Poker Tournaments, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Aviator Casino at all times that a Poker Tournament is offered for play:

- How a player may enter the tournament.
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament.
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by the Aviator Casino, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution.
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament.
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid.
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid.
- Any other restrictions that apply to the Poker Tournament.
- The amount that shall be withheld from the buy-ins to fund free roll tournaments.
- Information related to points that can be earned during tournaments

Controlled Games

The tournament games that may be played during Poker Tournaments at the Aviator Casino shall only be those as listed below.

• All Approved Poker Games

All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Gaming Activities Offered During Tournament Play

Bounties

Bounty targets are tournament players who are selected prior to the start of the tournament. During the play of a tournament, either a single player or multiple players in a tournament may be designated as bounty targets. If a bounty target player loses all of their tournament chips during a hand of play and is eliminated from the tournament, the winner of that hand shall win a pre-determined and designated amount of money ranging in value between \$1 and \$10,000. The bounty money may be deducted from the tournament prize pool or may be guaranteed and paid for by Lucky Lady Cardroom. Patrons shall be given notice of how the activity shall be funded prior to the tournament being offered.

Freeroll Tournament

A freeroll tournament shall be offered at least once a month. Entry is gained via Bureau approved promotions earned during specified tournament play. This shall be displayed prior to the start of any qualifying tournament. The freeroll tournament prize pool is funded by an amount ranging from \$1-\$1,000, which is taken from the buy-in for each

tournament. The house may add extra funds to the existing freeroll tournament prize pool to increase the amount.

Points System

The casino may offer a points system to reward players with cash, casino chips, free rolls, prizes, tournament entries, etc. Players may earn points through various methods:

• Live Game Play

Players can earn a predetermined and posted number of points for each hour of live game play that they participate in. Points can be increased for playing during a specified time period.

• *For example:* players may earn double points during limit games, or may earn triple points for all live games from 12 am-6am.

• Tournament Entry

Players can earn a predetermined and posted number of points for entering into a pre-designated tournament hosted by the Aviator Casino.

• Placement in a Tournament

Players can earn points by finishing in a certain place in a tournament.

• *For example*, if a player finishes in 1st place, they earn 1000 points, which can be used toward future tournament entries, cash, casino chips, etc.

Points are tracked through the Player Rewards Card for points earned during live game play. The Player Rewards Card may not be offered by the Aviator Casino until written notice is received from the Bureau of Gambling Control. Points earned during tournament play will be tracked on a log, to be maintained by the Aviator Casino. Prizes earned utilizing the points system must fall within a range of \$5-\$100,000. Examples of prizes are cash, casino chips, tournament entries, clothing, food, gift shop items, etc. All information related to points must be clearly posted by the Casino prior to offering for patrons.

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure shall be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament shall not change once sign-ups begin.
- Promotional materials shall not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided shall be equal and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament, playing in a daily tournament or live game, or points earned in tournament and live play. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- More than one method of entry may be utilized for specified tournaments.

• Partial entry can also be used to offset full entry fees for specified tournaments.

*\$1-\$1,000 from every buy-in shall be placed into a prize pool to fund free roll tournaments.

**The entry fee shall be retained by the Aviator Casino as income, and/or to pay expenses. This fee shall not be included in the tournament prize pool.

***The service charge is used exclusively to pay tournament staff. This is not income for the Aviator Casino.

****The dealer appreciation fee is used exclusively to pay tournament dealers. This is an optional fee that tournament entrants can pay in exchange for tournament chips. This fee shall not be included in the tournament prize pool, and is not income for the Aviator Casino.

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

- The prize pool shall consist of the sum of all buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons for each event, and the payouts shall be a percentage, as noted in the chart below.
- When the prize pool is guaranteed, any shortfall shall be covered by the Aviator Casino.
- Special tournaments may be fully funded by the Aviator Casino.
- Promotional prizes may consist of fixed cash amounts; merchandise; trips; tournament entries; tournament chips; and vehicles.
- Patrons shall be given ample notice of what prize is being offered and it shall be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

These tickets will be stored in a barrel or other suitable non-electronic randomizer for purposes of determining a winner at a pre-designated time and date. Prizes will range in value from \$10 to \$10,000.

This prize may also be in the form of food, prizes or merchandise, tournament entries, on the condition that it was designated as such prior to the commencement of the promotion.

4. If a cash prize is involved, is the amount of the prize progressive (increases) or a fixed amount?

Fixed amount.

5. Explain if the gaming activity is house funded or player funded.

House funded.

All prizes will be awarded by The Aviator Casino.

Tickets indicating all table and seat numbers in the Casino will be placed in a nonelectronic randomizing barrel or other suitable container. An appropriate employee of the casino (Key Employee or under the supervision of a Key Employee) will draw a ticket at the pre-designated drawing time. The winning table and seat number will win 100% of the prize listed. In the event that an empty table or seat is drawn, another draw will take place immediately and will continue until a winner is chosen.

Customers must be present to win. A customer who is not present in his seat at the time of the drawing will result in a second drawing to determine a winner. The winning table and seat will be announced at a minimum of three (3) times. In the event that a player still has not claimed his winning ticket, the player will have 30 seconds to make him or herself present before their ticket will be removed from contention.

Customers are not eligible to win if they have missed blind buttons, or if they were not dealt in on the hand immediately prior to the announcement of the drawing. Tournament game tables are not eligible for this gaming activity. Casino employees are not eligible to participate in the promotion at any time. A Third Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPPS) is not eligible to participate in this gaming activity, regardless of whether that player is in the player-dealer position or a player position. If a TPPPPS is occupying a lucky seat, another ticket shall be drawn immediately.

The Aviator Casino may also offer this promotion with the time frames unlisted to the public. In the event that this option is chosen, the casino will have the exact times for the drawing on a card and time stamped prior to commencement of the promotion. The public will always know the amount of drawings that are to take place, but not the exact times. Only Key Employees are privy to the drawing times. This card must be adhered to with utmost accuracy and is subject for DOJ inspection at any point. At the end of the promotional period, any customer may request to see that the drawing times on the card were followed accurately.

Example: The Aviator Casino decides to offer this promotion between the hours of 2p and 10p. On all applicable advertisements, the casino states that twenty (20) secret giveaways will take place during this time period. The qualification to be eligible is to be in a seat playing when the time comes for the drawing. On a card in the Key Employee's pocket, it shows drawing times of 2:15p, 2:34p, etc. This card will be time stamped to indicate that the times were determined prior to the promotion. Without this option, players will sit down at the exact time of the drawing and then get up once the drawing is over, thereby ceasing play (and revenue) immediately. 8. Players with the corresponding winning ticket will receive 100% of the listed prize.

All prizes are house funded and paid by The Aviator Casino.

The patron will choose a seat and the dealer will deal a full handed game with all cards being delivered face up. If the patron's table and seat number are drawn, they will be awarded 100% of the posted prize. There is no collection taken, nor wagers of any kind, and the patron may play for as long as they wish with no restrictions.

Players participating in pre-designated games may request a "punch card" (or other suitable recording form) and play for the prize displayed on that card. The Aviator Casino will list the hand qualifications for each game, as well as the prize for each punch card, before commencement of the promotion.

The punch card has no expiration date, but is subject to the cancellation of the promotion at any time.

The punch card will be non-transferable, and a player will need to show proper identification before being assigned a card. The punch card will have the first and last name of the player displayed on it.

15. Describe the type of table and equipment utilized for the gaming activity.

There is no additional gaming table or equipment other than that needed to offer any of the listed approved games, as well as a punch card to record the progress of the participating player.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Aviator Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-004734) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Aviator Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Qualifying games.
- Eligible dates and time periods.
- Minimum qualifying hand restrictions.
- Prize value.
- In the event two or more players have the exact same qualifying hand at the end of the promotional period, the prize will be split equally among the players.
 - If the prize is a non-cash prize, then the cash value of the prize will be split among those players.
- The Royalty is in the Cards Promotion will be funded from the Mini Jackpot (GEGA-003060) reserve account.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Royalty is in the Cards Promotion shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Aviator Casino, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• All Approved Poker Games

Object and Summary

Players, who achieve a designated qualifying hand, as listed below during a pre-determined and posted time period, will win the pre-determined and posted prize.

Qualifying Hands

Players who make one of the following advertised qualifying hands shall be eligible to win the posted prize. A Royal Flush is a five card hand consisting of an ace, king, queen, jack and ten of the same suit. Furthermore, the qualifying hand(s), and corresponding prize, shall be displayed prominently within the Aviator Casino at all times the Royalty is in the Cards Promotion is being offered for play:

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Players must be present to win a prize.
- There is no minimum or maximum amount of players required to be playing in a designated game in order for the table to be eligible for the promotion; other than what is required for game play.
- On and off-duty employees are eligible to participate in this promotion.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a floor person will verify the hand meets the qualifying criteria. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the promotion.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player dealt the qualifying hand must use both hole cards if the game requires hole cards.
 - If the game does not require hole cards or just one hole card, the player will use the cards as dealt.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player must complete the applicable bets for each round, and thus not fold the hand; the player must win the hand on the showdown, after the final round of betting.
 - The player must call and/or raise a bet on all rounds of the hand.
 - This also applies to games with a pre-flop, flop, turn, and river community cards.
 - If the player goes all-in, this is considered to have completed all bets.
- Tournament games are not eligible for the promotion.
- All procedures, times and prize amounts shall be displayed prominently via any form of advertisement the Casino wishes to use, including but not limited to printed flyers, digital display, the Casino website, or any other form of advertisement.

Prize

When players make the qualifying hand, they shall be awarded the prize, and the prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from a \$20 to \$100,000. Prizes shall be in the form of cash or chips. Other prizes such as merchandise including: jewelry, electronics, clothing, vehicles, watercraft, gift certificates, sporting and concert tickets, food comps, entry into tournaments and travel may be available. All prizes for this gaming activity shall be pre-determined and posted in advance, throughout the gaming floor and in all literature promoting such an event. If a minimum qualifying hand is not achieved within the promotional period, no prize will be awarded.

Prize Payout Structure

Each qualifying hand will have its own separate prize pool. This prize pool will progress separately from the other suits. There will be four boxes on the casino floor, each box marked to represent each card suit (spades, hearts, diamonds and clubs). The boxes are made of clear, heavy duty Lucite, with the dimensions approximately one foot by four foot, secured with a padlock. When a player completes one of the designated qualifying hands, they will receive the amount in the box for that suit the player qualified with. Each day, casino staff will add chips and/or prizes ranging in value from \$5-\$100 into each box.

- In the event two or more players have the exact qualifying hand at the end of the promotional period, the prize amount in the box will be divided equally. The Casino will cover any shortfall.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any additional fees as this promotion is house-funded.

Aviator Casino Splash Pots Promotion

Advertising Requirements

The Aviator Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the</u> <u>Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID listed above shall be referenced on all</u> <u>advertisements relating to this gaming activity.</u>

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Aviator Casino at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games.
- Eligible time period(s).
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Amount to be added to the pot (prize amount).
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Controlled Game

The Splash Pots promotion shall be attached to all limits and versions of the currently approved games offered at the Aviator Casino, as listed below:

• All approved poker games.

All base game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control.

Rules of Play

The Splash Pots gaming activity features a promotional element which shall be attached to all poker games currently approved at the Casino. The Splash Pots gaming activity involves a covered glass jar with ping pong balls that are numbered with the table numbers. During pre-determined times and intervals of the promotional period, a casino employee shall announce the commencement of the drawing. The casino employee shall then select an eligible table by randomly choosing a ping pong ball from the randomizer. A ping pong ball shall depict a number that corresponds to each eligible poker table. The ping pong balls which are equally sized and colored, shall be mixed within the randomizer. Then, one shall be selected. Once that table number is determined, the employee shall place the pre-determined and posted prize into the pot on the table, at the start of the next hand. New players may enter the game in between these hands. Betting procedures and play shall proceed as a normal round of play would. The player with the winning hand shall win the pot, including the added prize amount. In the event of a tie, the winning players shall split the pot evenly.

Prize Amount

When a table is selected, the prize amount shall be added to the pot of that table. The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000 in the form of casino chips, or it may be in the form of merchandise, tournament entries, restaurant discounts or meals. All prizes for this promotion shall be pre-determined and posted in advance, throughout the gaming floor and in all literature promoting such an event.

Aviator Casino Splash Pots Promotion

No Purchase Necessary

The Splash Pots promotion shall be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a no purchase necessary (NPN) game. Aviator Casino shall provide no purchase necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in this promotion without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the live player. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Splash Pots gaming activity. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Casino at all times:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts.
- Administrative fees.
- No Purchase Necessary Information.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Games

Three Card Poker Progressive gaming activity shall be attached to all limits and versions of the currently approved games offered at the Casino, as listed below. All base game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Three Card Poker 6 Card Bonus (GEGA-002119)

Rules of Play

- 1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may optionally place any bonus bet wagers along with the jackpot fee of \$1.00. A minimum of two players are required to play for the progressive jackpot.
- 2. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
- 3. Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Coin In" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees are dropped in a separate and locked jackpot collection box affixed to the left side of the gaming table.
- 4. The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).
- 5. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game.



Qualifying Hands

When a player is dealt a ace, king, queen, of the same suit, they are paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter. Any straight flush, a hand that consists of three cards of the same suit in consecutive ranking, other than ace, king and queen, receives a fixed prize amount according to the pay table below.

Envy Bonus:

- A player paying the \$1.00 jackpot fee also qualifies to win an envy payout. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other players who paid the \$1.00 jackpot fee win the envy pay. The player hitting the hand received the normal prize pay only, but does NOT receive the envy pay.
- If a player's hand triggers an envy payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the dealer will lock up the cards. The dealer will then move on to the next player.
- The house dealer pays any envy bonuses at the end of the round. In the event that more than one player is involved in a qualifying envy pay, then all players win multiple envy payouts.

Eligibility Requirements

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Back-line betting is not permitted in this game.
- In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying hands, each player will receive the posted prize amount for their designated hand.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Three Card Poker prize only when off duty.
- A Third-Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPPS) is not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the Three Card Poker Progressive gaming activity when either in the player-dealer or player capacity.

Prize Amount

Progressive Prize

- When a player is dealt a ace, king and queen, of the same suit, they are paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter.
- All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter.
- In the event there is more than one progressive winner at the same time, the winning players will split the posted progressive prize.
- When a player has a progressive winner, the dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer shall then contact the floor person.



- Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the floor person shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table, and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
- When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player/dealer), he/she presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.

The Three Card Poker Progressive gaming activity shall be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary (NPN) game. The Casino shall provide NPN tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisements shall state ANo Purchase Necessary@ for the Three Card Poker Progressive gaming activity.

- Qualifying games.
- Eligible dates and time periods.
- Minimum number of qualifying hand restrictions.
- Prize value.
- Alternate cash prize values.
- Any other restrictions that apply.
- No Purchase Necessary Opportunity.

The Wheel and Cash Promotion shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at The Aviator Casino, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Players that acquire one of the qualifying hands listed below will qualify to spin the wheel to win cash and/or prizes. Qualifying players will spin a wheel decorated with prizes and cash grouped by numbers. The player will win the cash and/or prizes associated with the number the pointer attached to the wheel lands on.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make one of the designated hands listed below will be eligible to spin the prize wheel, or receive the cash prize with a value ranging from \$5 to \$2,000; players may elect to take the posted cash prize ranging from \$5-\$2,000 in lieu of spinning the wheel. The specific hand(s) eligible to qualify for a chance to spin the prize wheel will be prominently displayed at or near the eligible tables for this promotion. To participate in this promotion, players will be required to qualify with up to five hands from the chart listed below; any combination of hands from the chart listed below will qualify a player to participate in this promotion. Qualifying hands will be tracked manually on a Punch Card. Each player who wishes to participate in this promotion will be provided their own Punch Card and tracking sheet with their name clearly

Qualifying Hand Table

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two players (Including the player-dealer for California Games) are required to participate in an eligible game to qualify for this promotion.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino floor person will verify the hand meets the qualifying criteria. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the promotion.
- Players are not required to win the hand/round to qualify for this promotion.
- Players may qualify to spin the wheel on each qualifying hand they hit; there are no limitations on the number of spins each player can qualify for.

- Players will be eligible to qualify for other promotions that are concurrently offered.
- In the event of a tie hand, both players will receive a spin and a chance to win prizes individually.
- The wheel must make one complete rotation to qualify as a legal spin. If a player does not complete a legal spin on their first try, they may re-spin the wheel until it has made a complete, legal rotation.

The Wheel and Cash Promotion is fully funded by The Aviator Casino. There will be no additional fees or collection fees taken for this promotion. All fee and collections are for the designated base games and are Bureau approved, pre-determined and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any additional fees as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Wheel and Cash Promotion shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Wheel and Cash Promotion. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

<u>Equipment</u>

The wheel has a stand or is wall mounted and is large enough for all players to view throughout the casino. The wheel is balanced and has rods on the face protruding forward. An elastic/rubber pointer falls between the rods. The wheel will have 38 spaces with numbers 1 through 36 and zero and double zero. Each space between the rods is designated with a number that is decorated by corresponding prizes
