Customer Incentive Program

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Blacksheep Casino Company may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001375) will be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Blacksheep Casino Company at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Required amount of time to be played and corresponding points earned
- The date(s) and time(s) the activity shall be offered
- All prizes offered and specific amount of points required for each prize
- The time frame in which the points earned are valid
- When the bonus prize(s) will be offered throughout the promotion
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Customer Incentive Program shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Blacksheep Casino Company at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Customer Incentive Program is a house funded program open to all Blacksheep Casino Company patrons. The promotion will reward players with points based on time of play at designated tables during predetermined and posted time periods ranging from 10 minutes to 365 days. The range of points per hour played will range from 1 to 200,000. During predetermined and posted times, bonus rates may be offered by the Casino (for example, double points may be offered during off-peak hours).

Player's Card Computer System Description

The player's card shall include the casino name, some descriptive language regarding restrictions for the card, and the problem gambling phone number. There shall also be a bar code or magnetic strip for identification.

- The card shall be non-transferable and revocable at any time.
- If the Player's Card is lost or stolen, players can ask a casino representative for a replacement at no cost to the player.
- Player information shall be maintained in a secure database accessible only by casino management. Access to the database shall also be tracked by casino management
- Player's time is tracked by having a casino representative either scan or manually enter the card information into the compute device.
- A printable record of the amount of time a player has accumulated during the promotional period shall be available at any time it is requested by the player.
- If the Player's Card Computer System should stop working during the promotion, the tracking would be paused until the computer system is working.

Customer Incentive Program

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points shall be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player that plays at a predetermined and posted table and has their player's card scanned by a casino representative will earn points based on time played, which can be redeemed for prizes during or at the end of a predetermined and posted promotional period. The range of points per hour played will range from 1 to 200,000. During predetermined and posted times, bonus rates may be offered by the Casino (for example, double points may offered during off-peak hours).

Example: A player signs up for the Customer Incentive Program at the cashier and receives a player's card. The player presents the card to a casino representative at the gaming table. The casino representative enters the player into the tracking software and will input the type of game and average wager per hand in 15-30 minute increments. At the end of the gaming session, the player will be logged out by the casino representative. The tracking software tabulates the amount of points the player earned based on time played and adds it to the player's account.

How Player Rewards Points are Redeemed

Players may redeem their points for prizes at any time during the promotion or at the end of the promotional period. All prizes shall have a predetermined and designated value. Points shall be earned by the amount of time played during the promotional period. After a player has accumulated a predetermined and specific amount of points, a player may redeem the accrued points for a predetermined and designated prize. When predetermined and posted, points may also be redeemed for money in these cases 1 point will be worth \$0.01 to \$100.

- After a player has been awarded a prize, they may also be eligible for multiple and subsequent prize(s) until the end of the promotion.
- Players may redeem their points for multiple prizes so long as the total amount of points required for all prizes is within the player's point balance.
- Once points are redeemed by the player, they are deducted from their point balance.

- Backline bettors are not eligible for this promotion.

- A patron who assumes the player-dealer position will not be logged out of the system and shall continue to have their time tracked.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this promotion.

Customer Incentive Program

Prize

The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$1 to \$100,000. Prizes include cash, live casino chips, Bonus Chips (GEAR-000965), Free Play Chips/Match Play Coupons (GEAR-000968), vehicles, promotional merchandise, food, entry into tournaments (GETR-000112), or entry into the Prize Drawing Promotion (GEAR-000966).

Funding

The Customer Incentive Program shall be fully funded by Blacksheep Casino Company. No additional fees of any kind shall be taken for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

Blacksheep Casino Company shall not retain any administrative fee as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Customer Incentive Program does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary Table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Object and Summary

A player who obtains a predetermined qualifying hand during a predetermined and posted time period will be given a predetermined number if drawing ticket(s) that will enter them into a drawing. Simultaneously, players who play for a predetermined amount of time will be given 1-10 drawing ticket(s) per hour played that will enter them into a drawing. The ticket shall be filled out with the player's name, game played, and date. The ticket will then be placed into a barrel and the ticket(s) will be drawn at posted times. The player whose ticket is drawn will be awarded a predetermined fixed amount or be eligible to spin a prize wheel for a random amount. Prize Drawing

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Patrons must present at the time of the drawing to win the prize.
 - o If the player is not present, another ticket will be drawn until the prize is awarded.
- Players will have one minute to claim the prize once called. If a prize is not claimed
 within the allotted time, the prize will be available for another player or the prize will be
 rolled to another drawing.
- Tickets do not carry over. Tickets are only eligible for the time period posted. The tickets expire when the promotional period ends and will be disposed.
- Drawing tickets are non-transferrable and may only be used by the player who earned them. The winning patron will have their identification verified by a casino representative.

Administrative Fees

Blacksheep Casino Company shall not retain an administrative fee, as this activity is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Prize Drawing shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Prize Drawing. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Dragon Slayer Jackpot

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Black Sheep Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Black Sheep Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-00963) listed below shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Dragon Slayer Jackpot gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Black Sheep Casino at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games, dates and time periods.
- Qualifying hands and their corresponding prize amounts.
- Amount of jackpot collection fees.
- Amount of administrative fees.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- All procedures, times and prize amounts shall be displayed prominently via any form of advertisement that the casino wishes to use, including but not limited to printed flyers, digital display, the Casino's website, or any other form of advertisement.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Game

The Dragon Slayer Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at Black Sheep Casino, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• EZ Baccarat (GEGR-001758)

Object and Summary

The Dragon Slayer Jackpot features a progressive and fixed jackpot prize. A prize is awarded when a player makes a pre-determined and designated hand. Any player who would like to participate in the jackpot places a \$5 jackpot fee before the house dealer pulls the first card of the hand. The house dealer will keep the participating player's jackpot fee on a designated Dragon Slayer Jackpot spot until the hand is resolved. The house dealer will then drop the collected fees in the drop box designated for the jackpot fees.

Qualifying Hands

When a qualifying hand is made, all players who paid the jackpot fee shall be eligible to win their share of the posted Dragon Slayer Jackpot progressive prize amount or win a fixed prize amount, as shown below. Only the following hands that have been Bureau approved, predetermined, and designated by the Casino are eligible. The qualifying hands within the chart below must be offered together at all times.

Dragon Slayer Jackpot

To qualify for the fixed and progressive prizes, the player and banker must draw a third card. Below are the qualifying hands and associated prize payouts.

Example: At the beginning of a round of play, 4 players on a Baccarat game paid a jackpot fee. A qualifying hand was dealt (a three-card player hand with a value of 8 or 9 won over a three-card banker hand with a value of 7) and the posted prize jackpot was \$20,000. Each of the four players would then receive \$5,000.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A player qualifies for this jackpot by paying the jackpot collection fee before the house dealer pulls the first card in any eligible game offered at the casino. The winning hand must be verified by the floor person on duty.
- The fixed prize shall be paid once the hand is verified. The Floor Service Representative will oversee the payout.
- The progressive prize shall be paid once verified by a Floor Service Representative and a Casino Manager. A check will be produced and paid no later than 72 hours after the hand is verified.
- There shall be no limit to the number of fixed and progressive prizes that can be won by a single player within a promotional period.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS), on and off duty, are not eligible to participate in this gaming activity.
- Casino Employees are eligible to participate and win the Dragon Slayer Jackpot when off duty and out of uniform.
- Backline bettors are eligible to participate and qualify for this gaming activity.

Prize

The Dragon Slayer Jackpot is comprised of a fixed and progressive prize with a minimum value of \$500 and a maximum value of \$250,000. The progressive payout shall be split evenly among the players who were dealt into the hand and paid a jackpot fee. The fixed amount will be given to each eligible player who paid a jackpot fee. Object and Summary

The Poker Buy-in Bonus Promotion will be open to all patrons who buy-in to a pre-determined game, for a pre-determined amount, and at pre-determined times. Players who buy-in a poker game for a pre-determined amount at a pre-determined time will be given and additional pre-determined amount of live casino chips for the poker game based on the length of time they participate in the poker game. The prize will be awarded to the player at the conclusion of a pre-determined length of play for a predetermined amount in live casino chips. Players' time will be recorded using a specific promotion sheet that will track the name, start time, end time, and all promotion monies received for each player. The floor service representative will authorize the release of the prize(s). Once the player receives the prize, the chips will be played as normal.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Bonus chip values.
- Buy-in amount for Bonus Chips
- Procedures to redeem Bonus Chips.
- Any other applicable restrictions and/or information.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Bonus Chip Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at the Black Sheep Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to all patrons who buy-in to a pre-determined game for a pre-determined amount ranging from \$10-\$100,000. Participants will receive a specific amount of bonus chips in any controlled game listed above. Players may purchase bonus chips at the cage at pre-determined and posted times, or when patrons buy-in to a pre-determined and posted amount ranging from \$10 to \$100,000, they will receive an amount ranging from \$1 to \$10,000 in bonus chips for buying into a pre-determined game. The prize shall be awarded to a player when he/she redeems one of the aforementioned advertisements. The player will receive the advertised amount of bonus chips. The bonus chips are a different style and design from the standard casino chip. The bonus chips cannot be exchanged for cash and must be played on the gaming table. Once the bonus chip has been placed as a wager the following applies:

- If the wager wins, the player will receive live chips for his/her bet from the player-dealer. The player retains the bonus chips and can reuse the bonus chips on another wager.

The Pai Gow Poker Jackpot features a progressive jackpot prize and fixed jackpot prize element and will be player-funded via a mandatory \$1 jackpot collection fee. The mandatory jackpot collection fee shall be taken from the player-dealer position every hand the jackpot is being offered. A progressive prize is awarded to players participating in a jackpot game when a designated hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand, and a fixed prize is awarded when a designated hand is achieved. The winning hand can be from any player's hand or the player-dealer's hand. A casino floor person will confirm the winning and losing hands and those players with the qualifying hand shall receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize. The posted jackpot prize known as the table share will be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as listed above. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the percentage division of the posted jackpot prize.

Qualifying Hands

Players who achieve one of the below advertised and designated hands will be eligible to win their share of the Pai Gow Poker Jackpot, as shown below. Only pre-determined, and designated winning and losing hands are eligible. A joker may be used in the bad beat winning or losing hand, except when making the 9 or 10 High Hand. Patrons shall be given ample notice of the specific hand being offered. Furthermore, Pai Gow Poker Jackpot will be displayed prominently displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the Pai Gow Poker Jackpot is being offered for play.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of three hands must be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for the players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the jackpot.
 - One player may bet on two hands and the player-dealer must play a hand also to be eligible.
- The player-dealer must hold one qualifying hand and one player must hold the other qualifying hand in order to qualify for the progressive element of the jackpot.
- A casino floor person will verify all qualifying hands. Any deviation from a standard deck shall nullify the jackpot.
- The 9 and 10 High Hands shall not use a joker to complete their hand.
- If during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying losing or winning hands (progressive element), only the hand with the highest ranked losing and highest ranked winning Pai Gow Poker hands will receive the posted prize percentage of the jackpot for the losing and winning hand. The remaining player(s), including those who had lower ranked qualifying hands, shall receive the posted prize percentage of the table share. If two or more players have the exact same hand, then they will split the posted progressive prize payout.
- If during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying hands for the fixed prize element, all players who achieve the qualifying hand will be paid the fixed prize amount associated with the qualifying hand.
- Any backline bettors who wager on a winning or losing hand shall receive an equal portion of the posted progressive prize percentage for the hand. The backline bettor shall receive the full amount of the posted fixed prize payout.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS), on and off duty, are not eligible to participate in this gaming activity.
- Off duty and out of uniform casino employees are eligible.

Prize

Prizes will be awarded as a cash value. The progressive prize value will range from \$500-\$50,000. The fixed prize value will range from \$250-\$500. The progressive prize will increase daily by a set amount from \$10 to \$300 and will be posted prominently in the Casino. This jackpot has a cap of \$50,000.

Backline bettors are entitled to whatever portion of the progressive winnings they are owed. If the backline bettor wagers on the same hand as the 40% portion of the losing hand, then they would split the 40% share of the progressive jackpot prize with the other player(s) who achieved the hand; same rule applies for winning hands, and table share. The backline bettor shall receive the full amount of the posted fixed prize amount.

When a player achieves a hand to win the jackpot, a casino floor person will verify the qualifying jackpot hand is valid. Once verified, the floor person will gather all the necessary information from the jackpot winner(s). A manager will be notified and will authorize the release of the funds.

Prize Payout Structure

Players who achieve the qualifying hands, as pre-determined and designated by the Casino, shall be eligible to win their share of the Pai Gow Poker Jackpot prize amount, based on the payout table, as shown below.

Funding

The Pai Gow Poker Jackpot utilizes a progressive prize pool and fixed prize amounts and will be player-funded via a mandatory \$1 jackpot collection fee. The mandatory jackpot collection fee shall be taken from the player-dealer position per hand.

The Casino will initially seed the jackpot with a minimum amount of \$500. The Casino will be refunded the seeded jackpot amount from the jackpot reserve account once the reserve is sufficient and the funds become available. Additionally, whenever the Casino is required to seed the jackpot or cover the shortfall due to inadequate funds in the reserve account, the Casino will be reimbursed from the jackpot reserve account once the reserve is sufficient and funds become available. If and when the jackpot reaches the cap of \$50,000, all other jackpot collection fees will be placed in the jackpot reserve account.

The fixed prize payout will be paid out from the reserve account. The Casino will cover any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient funds in the reserve account. When a progressive qualifying hand is achieved, the jackpot will be re-seeded by the Casino, or from the reserve account, in an amount ranging between \$10 and \$5,000. The jackpot collection fees will be kept in a separate drop box from the regular collection fees and will be kept in a separate account for tracking and accounting purposes. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of the prize amount.

Administrative Fees

The Black Sheep Casino will retain an administrative fee of \$3 to \$10 per table per hour from all eligible tables. The administrative fees shall be taken from the reserve fund. If enough funds are not available in the reserve fund, the administrative fees shall be logged and accounted for and will be taken once there are sufficient funds. This fee will be used to cover a portion of the cost for security, accounting, equipment, surveillance, and gambling enterprise personnel who administer the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Pai Gow Poker Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Pai Gow Poker Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Free Play Chips Promotion

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Black Sheep Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-000968) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Black Sheep Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible dates and time periods.
- Eligible games attached to a Free Play Chip or Match Play Coupon.
- All prizes and/or discounts available.
- Process of redeeming Free Play Chips or Match Play Coupons.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Free Play Chips Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at the Black Sheep Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Patrons are awarded Free Play Chips or Match Play Coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, etc. Players who receive a Free Play Chip(s) or Match Play Coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount on the chip and/or coupon.

Free Play Chip

The Free Play Chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being they cannot be exchanged for cash. Free Play Chips shall initially be in the form of a coupon, which shall be offered to all patrons that wish to come to the Casino and use them to play. When a patron receives a Free Play Coupon he or she shall take the coupon to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the Free Play Chip(s) to be used in a live game. Free Play Chips shall be used as the player's wager on the betting circle. Free Play Chips shall not be taken into the house dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the house dealer's tray.

A player will use a Free Play Chip to place a wager on an eligible game to try and win a hand.

• If a player uses a Free Play Chip and wins his or her hand, the player will receive the value of the Free Play Chip in live chips, paid by the player-dealer. The Free Play Chip shall be collected by the house dealer and given to a key employee. The key employee shall take the Free Play Chip to the cage to be logged and exchanged. The Free Play Chip value in live chips shall be brought back and reimbursed to the player-dealer.

Free Play Chips Promotion

Example: The player would place the \$5 Free Play Chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection fee (if applicable) and the game would play. If the player wins the hand, the person in the player-dealer position would pay him/her the \$5 just as if they placed a \$5 wager with a live cash-value chip. The Free Play Chip will then be collected by the house dealer and given to a key employee. The key employee shall take the \$5 Free Play Chip to the cage to be logged and exchanged for \$5 in live chips, and brought back to the player-dealer.

• If a player uses a Free Play Chip and loses his or her hand, the player will only lose the Free Play Chip. The Free Chip will be collected by the house dealer and given to a key employee. The key employee will verify it has been used and lost by the player. He or she shall void the chip and take it to the cage.

Example: The player would place a \$5 Free Play Chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection fee (if applicable) and the game would play. If the player loses the hand, the house dealer shall collect the Free Play Chip and shall give the Free Play Chip to a key employee to be voided.

• If a player uses a Free Play Chip and pushes his or her hand, the player will retain the Free Play Chip to be used again until he or she wins or loses.

Match Play Coupon

A player shall take a Match Play Coupon to an eligible game and place a wager that equals the amount on the coupon.

• If a player uses a Match Play Coupon and wins his or her hand, the player will receive the combined value of the Match Play Coupon and the equal wager placed by the player, paid by the player-dealer. The house dealer shall have a key employee sign the voucher verifying the coupon has been used. The Match Play Coupon will be taken to the cage to be logged and exchanged for live chips. The live chips will be brought back to the player-dealer.

Example: The player would place a \$5 Match Play Coupon and an equal wager of \$5 in live chips on the gaming table. If the player wins his or her hand, he or she will receive \$10 from the player-dealer just as if they placed a \$10 bet. The coupon will be collected by the house dealer and shall be verified and signed by a key employee. The key employee will log and exchange the coupon at the cage and return its value in live chips to the player-dealer.

- If a player uses a Match Play Coupon and loses his or her hand, the player will lose the Match Play Coupon as well as their equal live chip wager. The player-dealer shall be paid the live chip wager of the bet. The Match Play Coupon will be collected by the house dealer and given to a key employee. The key employee will verify it has been used and lost by the player. He or she shall void the coupon.
- If a player uses a Match Play Coupon and pushes his or her hand, the player will retain both
 the Match Play Coupon as well as the equal live chip wager to be used again until he or she
 wins or loses.

Free Play Chips Promotion

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- There are no minimum or maximum players needed for this promotion to be active.
- Free Play Coupons and Match Play Coupons shall contain all relevant information for the specific promotion being offered, including expiration date and location.
- Backline bettors are eligible to participate and win in this promotion.
- The redemption of all Free Play Coupons, Free Play Chips, and Match Play Coupons are tracked on an in-house spreadsheet. This spreadsheet will include the name of the person who redeemed the coupons/chips.
- Depending on the specific promotion, players may be restricted to the number of Free Play Chips or Match Play Coupons that are used in a promotional period. If a restriction is established for a promotional period, all coupons and advertisements will state the restriction. Limitations will be enforced with the use of the in-house spreadsheet.
- Players shall not exchange the Match Play Coupons or Free Play Chips for live chips.
- All applicable collection fees shall be paid when using a Free Play Chip or Match Play Coupon.
- Free Play Chips and Match Play Coupons may not be used to pay collection fees or jackpot fees.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate and win in this promotion when off duty and out of uniform.
- Third-Party Players of Proposition Player Services are not eligible in this promotion.
- All procedures, times, qualifying hands, and prize amounts must be displayed prominently via any form of advertising the casino wishes to use, including but not limited to printed flyers, digital displays, the casino's website, etc.

Prize

Free Play Chip(s) and/or Match Play Coupons shall have a value ranging from \$5 to \$500 for each Free Play Chip or Match Play Coupon. Players shall not exchange Free Play Chip(s) or Match Play Coupons for live chips.

Funding

The Free Play Chips promotion shall be fully funded by Black Sheep Casino. There shall be no additional promotion fees or jackpot fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

Administrative Fees

There will be no administrative fee(s) collected by Black Sheep Casino for this promotion.

No Purchase Necessary

The Free Play Chips Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

High Hand Jackpot

Advertising

The Black Sheep Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-000969) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Black Sheep Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Qualifying hands and the restrictions for those hands.
- Jackpot prize amount.
- Black Sheep Casino's discretionary increases to the jackpot prize and specific time periods the jackpot prize will be increased.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Daily amount added to the High Hand Jackpot.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this jackpot.

Eligible Controlled Games

The High Hand Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Black Sheep Casino, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Texas Hold'em (GEGR-001752)

Object and Summary

The player who obtains the highest ranking poker hand during a pre-determined and posted time period will win a predetermined and posted prize ranging in value from \$25 - \$5,000. At the beginning of a pre-specified time period, the qualifying high hand of "full house or better" shall be announced. When a player receives a full house or better, an announcement shall be made and all players will then try to beat the qualifying hand. If no one receives a higher hand, the player with the full house or better receives the posted prize. If the qualifying hand is not hit within the promotional time period no prize will be awarded. The player with the qualifying hand that meets all the eligibility requirements shall have their hand verified by the Floor Service Representative.

Qualifying Hands

The qualifying hand will be pre-determined as any "full house or better." Only one qualifying hand per game shall be offered at any one time. If a minimum qualifying hand is not achieved within the promotional period, no prize will be awarded. Furthermore, the minimum qualifying hand shall be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the High Hand Promotion is being offered for play. - A player is eligible to win this promotion by making the highest-ranking hand during the eligible time periods for this promotion.
- There is no minimum or maximum amount of players that must be dealt into the game in order for the table to qualify for the promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible when off-duty and out of uniform only.
- When a player completes the highest poker hand in the pre-determined designated time period, that player shall receive 100% of the posted prize amount.
- All qualifying hands must be verified by the Floor Service Representative in order to be eligible. Any deviation from a standard deck shall nullify a hand.
- In the event that two or more players have the exact same qualifying hand the prize shall be equally split amongst each player.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the promotion.
- There is no restriction to the number of times a player is eligible for this promotion. All players shall be eligible for this promotion as often as it is offered.
- The winning player does not need to be present to win, but must collect their prize within 72 hours or they shall forfeit the prize amount. The forfeited prize amount shall be added to the next promotional period.
- The casino will notify all winners via text or any other communication the player provides.
- The casino will clearly post the winning name for all patrons to view.

<u>Prize</u>

- Qualifying hands and the restrictions for those hands.
- Jackpot prize amount.
- Black Sheep Casino's discretionary increases to the jackpot prize and specific time periods the jackpot prize will be increased.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Daily amount added to the Aces Cracked Jackpot.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this jackpot.

Object and Summary

The Aces Cracked Jackpot features a fixed jackpot element attached to the game of Texas Hold'em. A prize awarded to the players participating in a jackpot game when a better hand at the showdown beats a second hand containing a pair of "Pocket Aces." Pocket aces are when the player has two aces as their hole cards.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make a specific pair of "Pocket Aces" and loses to a better hand will be eligible to win the Aces Cracked Jackpot prize amount. Only one qualifying hand per game shall be offered at any one time or all qualifying hands with the cards specified in the chart below must be offered together at all times.

- When a qualifying hand is announced, the Floor Service Representative will verify that both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- In order to qualify for the jackpot, the player must use both hole cards.
- In order to qualify for the jackpot, the player must complete play on all four rounds of the hand, which includes the pre-flop, flop, the turn, and the river and not fold their hand.

- In order to qualify for the jackpot, the player must lose the hand on the "showdown," after the final round of betting.
- In the event that during a round of play, two (2) or more players have qualifying hands, each qualifying hand will receive the full amount of the jackpot.
- The jackpot will not be valid during tournament play and is only valid during "live" game play.

Prize

A player that receives the qualifying hand will receive a pre-determined prize amount ranging from a value of \$1-\$500. The casino will post the jackpot amount(s).

Funding

The Aces Cracked Jackpot will be funded from the reserve account for the High Hand Jackpot (GEAR-000969).

Administrative Fees

Black Sheep Casino will not retain an administrative fee for the Aces Cracked Jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Aces Cracked Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. The casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Aces Cracked Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Poker Tournaments

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Black Sheep Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GETR-000112) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Black Sheep Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- Entry Fee will be retained by the Casino to offset the cost of operating the tournament. This fee will not be included in the prize pool.
- Service Charge will be retained by the Casino and used exclusively to pay tournament staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.
- House Appreciation Fee will be retained by the casino and used exclusively to pay tournament management staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament.
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid.
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid.
- Any other restrictions that apply to poker game tournaments.

Tournament Log

The Black Sheep Casino shall maintain all completed tournament logs for at least seven years. These logs shall be maintained in either paper or electronic format. The cardroom shall also retain and make available the most recent three months of the tournament logs for inspection by a representative of the Bureau during all hours of operation. Upon request of the Bureau, a licensee shall provide the Bureau with copies of such tournament logs. Tournament logs shall contain the following information:

- Name of gambling establishment.
- Day, date, time and name advertised for the tournament.
- Total number of tables used.
- Name of controlled games offered.
- Method of entry.
- Number and amount of re-buys and/or add-ons offered.
- Number of participants.
- Name of each fee charged, amount of each fee charged, total number of each fee collected, and cumulative amount collected.
- Source of all funds for tournament prize pool.
- Amount of the prize pool.
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool.
- Name of gaming activities offered (when applicable).
 - Funding source.
 - Prize amount.
 - o Total number of prizes awarded.

Poker Tournaments

- o Total amount deducted from prize pool (when applicable).
- Results of the tournament, including the total amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament.
- Printed name and signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament.

Eligible Controlled Games

The controlled games that may be played during poker game tournaments at the Black Sheep Casino shall only be those listed below. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Texas Hold'em (GEGR-001752)
- Omaha High/Low (GEGR-001753)
- Omaha (GEGR-001754)

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure will be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament will not change once sign-ups begin.
- Promotional materials will not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided will be equal for the initial buy-in and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament or a Bureau approved gaming activity. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- More than one method of entry for a specific tournament may be utilized.

^{*}The Entry Fee will be retained by the Casino to offset the cost of operating the tournament. This fee will not be included in the prize pool.

^{**}The Service Charge will be retained by the Casino and used exclusively to pay tournament staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.

^{***}The House Appreciation Fee will be retained by the Casino and used exclusively to pay tournament management staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.

Poker Tournaments

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

Regular Prize Pool

• The tournament prize pool will consist of the sum of all buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons for each tournament event, and paid cash to the winner(s).

Guaranteed Prize Pool

Black Sheep Casino may guarantee a tournament prize pool amount, ranging in value from \$1 to \$1,000,000 in the form of cash. In this case, if the tournament prize pool paid to the player(s) from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons (if applicable) does not equal the amount guaranteed for the tournament prize pool, the Black Sheep Casino will cover the shortfall. If the total of the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons (if applicable) is greater than the amount guaranteed, the tournament prize pool will be increased by the excess funds.

Added Prize Pool

 Black Sheep Casino may add additional funds to a tournament prize pool amount, ranging in value from \$1 to \$1,000,000 in the form of cash. In this case, the tournament prize pool will be paid to the player(s) from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons, as well as the additional monies added to the tournament prize pool.

Tournament Prize Structure

When the prize is not guaranteed, the prize structure will be broken down by the number of paid entries and percentage paid. The percentage paid out will always equal 100%. Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Blacksheep Casino Company at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Poker Progressive Jackpots prize pool amount
- Initial and Re-seed amounts
- Amount and frequency of money added to the prize pool
- Qualifying Hand Option
- Prize Payout Structure Option
- Any prize multiplier
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this jackpot

Eligible Controlled Games

The Poker Progressive Jackpots shall be attached to all Bureau approved poker games offered at Blacksheep Casino Company at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Poker Progressive Jackpots (jackpot) features a player-funded progressive prize. The object of the jackpot is for a player to form a qualifying hand that is beaten by a better hand at the showdown of the base game.

To participate in the jackpot players will need to participate in an eligible game, at a table with three or more active players. Players shall place their wagers according to the base game rules, after all initial wagers have been placed, the house dealer will collect a \$1 jackpot fee from the pot. The jackpot fee will be collected before the flop. After the jackpot fee has been collected the house dealer will follow approved procedures for dealing the base game.

When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with qualifying hands shall receive the corresponding posted percentage of the jackpot prize pool amount, as shown in the Prize Payout Structure below.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make one of the following advertised qualifying hands shall be eligible to win their share of the jackpot prize pool as shown below. In order to qualify for the promotion, players dealt the qualifying hands must use two hole cards (in games that have hole cards). Only winning and losing hands that have been Bureau approved, predetermined, and designated by the Casino are eligible. Only one of the following qualifying hand options shall be offered at a time. Any combination of different qualifying hand options shall not be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of three players required to be seated and actively playing in an above mentioned game for the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- In the event two or more players make a qualifying winning and/or losing hand, the
 player with the highest qualifying winning and losing hand shall win the posted
 percentage of the prize pool for the hand; all other players shall win the posted
 percentage of the table share.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative shall verify both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- The players with the qualifying winning and losing hands must complete the applicable bets on each round and play through the final betting round (the showdown) in order to qualify for the jackpot.
- The losing hand must be the second-best hand, in the base game, to qualify for the jackpot.
- There is no restriction on the number of times a player may qualify for this promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate when on or off duty and in or out of uniform.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this jackpot.

Prize

The progressive jackpot prize pool shall range in value from \$1,000 to no maximum amount. The actual jackpot prize pool amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at and the amount that has accumulated from the daily progressive increase each day. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative once all proper paperwork has been filled out. The casino representative will pay the winners in live casino chips, cash, or a check. All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and/or on a handwritten log to be maintained by the Casino for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

- Under no circumstances shall the jackpot pool amount be decreased once predetermined and posted.
- The jackpot prize pool shall increase daily at an amount between \$50 and \$10,000.
 - The daily increase amount will come from the reserve fund.
 - o If there are not sufficient funds in the reserve fund, the casino will make up the short fall and will not be reimbursed.

- The daily jackpot prize pool increase shall be done at a predetermined and designated time.
- Patrons shall be given ample notice of the actual jackpot pool prize amount.
 Furthermore, the amount of the progressive jackpot prize pool shall be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times that the jackpot is being offered for play.

Prize Multiplier

Prize Multiplier is an optional element of the Poker Progressive Jackpot prize. The Prize Multiplier element allows the Casino to increase the progressive prize amount by multiplying the prize pool amount by a predetermined and posted multiplier. The multiplier will range between 2x and 5x. The Casino will be able to offer the Prize Multiplier during specific, days, hours, game limits, or tables as long as it is predetermined and posted. Prizes will be awarded as normal and according to the selected prize structure option.

- The posted jackpot prize pool amount will not change when the Prize Multiplier is being offered, as the amount is calculated from the posted prize pool amount.
- The posted amount that is shown on the jackpot prize pool will be paid from the jackpot prize pool, the additional prize amount will be paid from the reserve fund.
 - In the event there are insufficient funds in the reserve fund, the Casino shall cover any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.

Prize Payout Structure

Players that make the designated qualifying hands will be eligible to win their share of the Poker Progressive Jackpots prize pool, based on the payout structure option being used, as shown below. Only one of these prize payout structure options shall be offered at any one time that the jackpot is being offered for play. No combination of the prize payout structure options shall be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered.

Patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of which prize payout structure option is being offered for play. Once the Casino designates a prize payout structure option, the payout structure shall not be adjusted or changed until the jackpot has been hit and awarded. Furthermore, the prize payout structure will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

- Players who obtain a qualifying Losing Hand shall win the corresponding percentage of the prize pool, depending on the selected prize payout structure option.
 - If multiple players obtain a qualifying Losing Hand, only the highest ranked Losing Hand will win the Losing Hand share of the prize pool.

- If multiple players obtain the same qualifying Losing Hand, all eligible players will win and evenly split the Losing Hand share of the prize pool.
 - If there is an odd number of chips the player closest to the dealer in a clockwise direction will be awarded the extra chip.
- Players who obtain the qualifying Losing Hand will not be eligible for the Table Share or the Floor Share.
- Players who obtain a qualifying Winning Hand shall win the corresponding percentage of the prize pool, depending on the selected prize payout structure option.
 - o If multiple players obtain a qualifying Winning Hand, only the highest ranked Winning Hand will win the Winning Hand share of the prize pool.
 - If multiple players obtain the same qualifying Winning Hand, all eligible players will win and evenly split the Winning Hand share of the prize pool.
 - If there is an odd number of chips the player closest to the dealer in a clockwise direction will be awarded the extra chip.
 - Players who obtain the qualifying Winning Hand will not be eligible for the Table Share or the Floor Share.
- Active players who are at the same table where the qualifying losing and winning hands are obtained, will split the Table Share percentage of the prize pool, depending on the selected prize payout structure option.
 - o If there is an odd number of chips the Casino will make up the short fall and will not be reimbursed.
- Active players who are at a table, within the Casino, where the table limit is the same as
 the table limit for the table where the losing and winning hands are obtained, will evenly
 split the Floor Share percentage of the prize pool, depending on the selected prize pool
 structure option.
 - o If there is an odd number of chips the Casino will make up the short fall and will not be reimbursed.

Funding

The Poker Progressive Jackpots consists of a player-funded progressive prize pool. During all eligible games, when three or more players are dealt in on a hand, a \$1 jackpot fee is taken from the pot, before the flop, and will then be placed in a separate and locked jackpot fee box, which will be separate from the regular house collection fees. Jackpot fees will be added to the reserve fund. If the hand does not reach the flop the jackpot fee will not be collected and the Poker Progressive Jackpots will not be offered for that hand.

The Casino shall initially seed the jackpot with an amount ranging between \$1,000 and \$100,000. When the jackpot prize has been awarded, the jackpot prize pool will be re-seeded, by the Casino, at an amount between \$1,000 and \$100,000. The Casino will not be reimbursed for the initial seed or the re-seed.

The jackpot prize pool shall increase daily at an amount between \$50 and \$10,000. The amount shall be predetermined and posted. The daily jackpot prize pool increase shall be done at a predetermined and designated time. The daily increase to the jackpot prize pool will come from the reserve fund. If there are not sufficient funds in the reserve fund, the Casino will make up the short fall and will not be reimbursed.

Additionally, whenever the Casino is required to seed the jackpot prize pool or cover a shortfall due to inadequate funds in the reserve fund, the Casino shall not be reimbursed.

All fee collections and table limits for the designated controlled game are Bureau approved, predetermined and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall retain an administrative fee of \$15 to \$25 per table per hour. The administrative fee shall be taken from the reserve fund. This fee shall cover the costs associated with prizes, administering and accounting for the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Poker Progressive Jackpots shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Poker Progressive Jackpots. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts
- Administrative Fees
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Three Card Poker Progressive shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Blacksheep Casino Company, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Three Card Poker 6 Card Bonus (GEGR-001757)

Object and Summary

The object of the Three Card Poker Progressive is for participating players to achieve a qualifying hand, as shown below, in order to win a fixed or progressive prize.

- 1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. Players may optionally place any bonus bets and optional \$1 jackpot fee. Players who do not make a base game wager are not eligible to place a jackpot fee.
- "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position.
 These discs have a sensor and will detect when a live casino chip is placed on them.
 Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
 - a. Should the sensor malfunction, the chips will be returned to the players and no jackpot will be offered during that time, until the malfunction is fixed.
- 3. Once all players place their controlled game wagers, any bonus bets, and jackpot fees, the house dealer will press "Coin In" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the gaming activity. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees shall be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection box and accounted for separately.
- 4. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the controlled game. Any player who makes a qualifying hand will be paid out, as described below.

Qualifying Hands

When a player is dealt an ace, king and queen of the same suit, the player is paid 100% of the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter. Any straight flush, a hand consisting of three cards of the same suit in consecutive ranking, other than ace, king and queen, receives a fixed prize amount. The fixed prize payout does not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter. All qualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two active players, including the player-dealer, are required to qualify for this gaming activity.
- Only seated players, who have placed the optional \$1 jackpot fee and are dealt a designated hand, are eligible for payout.
- Backline betting is not permitted in this gaming activity.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot only when off duty.
- Third-Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to place a
 jackpot collection fee and become eligible for this gaming activity when either in the
 player-dealer or player capacity.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player may win a fixed and/or progressive prize during the promotional period.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this gaming activity.
- A player may qualify to win a prize regardless of the base game outcome.
- Players who are playing multiple hands are eligible to place a jackpot fee and win on each hand.

Prize

The Three Card Poker Progressive features both progressive and fixed prizes. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative. Once all proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.

Progressive Prize

The progressive prize will range from a minimum of \$1,000 and will have no maximum amount. The actual amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at, as well as the amount collected from the jackpot fees.

- When a player is dealt an ace, king, queen of the same suit, they are paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter.
 - o Progressive prize payouts will be paid from the Three Card Poker Progressive meter.
- All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter.

- If multiple progressive prize-winning hands hit at the same time all winning players will evenly split the posted progressive jackpot amount.
 - If there is an odd number of chips the odd chip will be awarded to the player who received action on the hand first according to the base game rules.

Fixed Prizes

When a player is dealt a straight flush, they are paid a fixed prize amount according to the payout table above.

- If more than one fixed prize winning hand hits at the same time all winning players will be paid the corresponding fixed prize amount.
- All fixed prize payouts will be paid from the Three Card Poker Progressive reserve fund.
 - If the reserve fund is depleted the Casino will make up the short fall and will not be reimbursed.

Envy Bonus

When a player hits a hand associated with any envy pay and is awarded the Progressive Prize, players who place a \$1 jackpot fee will qualify for an Envy Bonus payout. The Envy Bonus payout is a fixed prize amount according to the payout table above.

- \$100 will be awarded to players who placed a \$1 jackpot fee and are seated at the same table as a player who wins the Progressive Prize.
- The player who wins the Progressive Prize will not qualify for the envy payout.
- If a player's hand triggers an Envy Bonus payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the dealer will lock up the cards. The dealer will then move on to the next player.
- The house-dealer pays any Envy Bonus payouts at the end of the round.
- All Envy Bonus payouts will be paid from the Three Card Poker Progressive reserve fund
 - o If the reserve fund is depleted the Casino will make up the short fall and will not be reimbursed.
- In the event that multiple players achieve a hand associated with an envy pay then all eligible players will win multiple Envy Bonus payouts.

All monies paid out will be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log to be maintained by the gambling enterprise, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Funding

The Three Card Poker Progressive is a player-funded jackpot with both fixed and progressive prizes. The jackpot is funded by an optional \$1 jackpot fee, which is paid by players in order to be eligible for the prizes mentioned above. The \$1 jackpot fee, paid by each player, will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.20 will be immediately posted on the jackpot meter.
- \$0.80 will be tracked in the Three Card Poker Progressive Jackpot reserve fund.

The Casino will initially seed the jackpot meter at the amount of \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from this reserve fund. There is no cap to the Three Card Poker Progressive meter.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, the jackpot meter will be re-seeded by the reserve fund at an amount of \$1,000. In the event the reserve fund cannot cover the reseed, the Casino will reseed the jackpot and will be reimbursed for the amount of the reseed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund.

All increases and decreases to the Three Card Poker Progressive reserve fund and jackpot meter shall be documented in the accounting records.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will retain an administrative fee ranging from \$12 to \$32, taken per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee shall be used for the operation costs and the administration of the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Three Card Poker Progressive shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Three Card Poker Progressive. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- 1. When a player has a progressive winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- 2. The house dealer shall then contact a casino representative.
- 3. Once a casino representative verifies the progressive win, a casino representative shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- 4. Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table, and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
- 5. When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), they will press "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- 6. Once the "J-pot" button is pressed, the prize is logged into Game Manager.

Object and Summary

The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot considers the best hand possible among each individual player's cards.

- 1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may optionally place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1. A minimum of two players are required to play for the progressive jackpot.
- 2. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
- 3. Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Game Start" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees shall be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection box and accounted for separately.
- 4. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. All seven cards will be considered. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.
- 5. When a player has achieved a winning hand, the house dealer shall press the appropriate button on the keypad. A casino representative will then be responsible for verifying the winning hand.

 jackpot fee are eligible for payouts. Backline bettors are not eligible to participate in this
 gaming activity.
- A minimum of two players (player and player-dealer) are required for this gaming activity.
- A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game, regardless of the outcome of the base game.
- Winning players will be paid in live casino chips by a casino representative at their seat once their hand has been verified by a casino representative.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player can qualify for and win either the fixed or the progressive prize.
- Players can use zero, one or two hole cards in order to qualify for the jackpot. Players
 do not need to use any hole cards to qualify for the Community Royal.
- A player may place a base game wager as well as the optional jackpot fee on any unoccupied seat, as well as their own, and become eligible for multiple payouts.
- Casino employees are eligible to play when off duty and out of uniform.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to participate in this promotion.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to place a
 jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive
 gaming activity when either in the player-dealer or player capacity.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this promotion.

Prize

Progressive and Fixed Prizes

 A Royal Flush is paid 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.

- All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will cover any shortfall at their own expense.
- In the event more than one progressive meter pay or any other qualifying hand hits during the same round, all winning players will be paid the posted progressive prize or the posted fixed amount. When more than one progressive meter pay hits, one progressive pay will be paid from the meter and the others will be paid from the reserve fund. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall at their own expense. All hands will be paid 100% of the posted prize.
- All fixed payouts will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper paperwork
 has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner in live casino chips.
 The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.

Envy Bonus

- A player paying the \$1 jackpot fee also qualifies to win an envy payout. If another player
 at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other players who paid the \$1
 jackpot fee win the envy pay. The player hitting the hand receives the normal prize pay
 only, and does NOT receive the envy pay. All envy payouts are paid from the reserve
 fund.
- If a player's hand triggers an envy payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the house dealer will lock up the cards. The dealer will then move on to the next player.
- The house dealer pays any envy bonuses at the end of the round. In the event that more than one player is involved in a qualifying envy pay, then all players win multiple envy payouts.

Funding

The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot is player funded with both fixed and progressive elements. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive Jackpot fund reserve, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. After the progressive jackpot is hit, the progressive meter will be re-seeded by the reserve fund at a minimum of \$1,000. In the event the reserve fund cannot cover the reseed, the Casino will reseed the jackpot and will be reimbursed for the amount of the reseed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund. The progressive prize pool shall increase daily based solely on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. There is no cap on the progressive jackpot. Furthermore, the Casino will cover any shortfall.

Each \$1 jackpot fee paid by a player will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.35 will be immediately posted on the progressive meter.
- \$0.65 will be tracked in the reserve fund. The reserve fund will be utilized to payout all fixed prize amounts, reseed the metered progressive jackpot prize at a minimum of \$1,000, and pay administrative fees.

All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that shall be maintained by the Casino, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will take an administrative fee ranging from \$8 to \$32 per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee will cover the costs associated with the complicated computer system and program in addition to technicians having to service the systems.

No Purchase Necessary

The Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Ultimate Texas Hold'em Progressive. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- When a player has a progressive winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer shall then contact the casino representative.
- Once the Casino verifies the progressive win, the casino representative shall press "Confirm", then swipe the authorization card. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), he/she presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- Once the "Confirm" button is pressed and the authorization card swiped, the prize is logged into Game Manager.
- If the electronic software or digital reader malfunctions or breaks down, the jackpot will not be offered.
