

*Three Card Poker Progressive is owned, patented and/or copyrighted by ShuffleMaster Inc. Please submit your agreement with Owner authorizing play of Game in your gambling establishment together with any request for Bureau of Gambling Control (Bureau) approval to play this game. Please note that the Bureau is making the details of this game available to the public as required by subdivision (g) of Business and Professions Code section 19826, but the posting does not waive any rights to the game content which may be held by Owner. The terms of any agreement with Owner are to be negotiated between the gambling establishment and Owner, and any dispute or asserted breach related thereto are private matters which will not be resolved by the Bureau.

- 1. Three Card Poker Progressive adds a progressive jackpot element to the game of Three Card Poker played in California Cardrooms. The base game of Three Card Poker must be approved by the Bureau to be eligible to add Three Card Poker Progressive.
- 2. Three Card Poker progressive considers the best hand possible among each individual player's cards.
- 3. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. They may optionally place any bonus bet wagers along with the jackpot fee of \$1.00.
- 4. "Hockey Puck" discs will be attached to the table in front of each betting position. These discs have a sensor and will detect when a casino chip is placed on them. Players must place the optional jackpot fee on the sensor. The sensor will then light up.
- 5. Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the house dealer will press "Coin In" on the keypad. The sensors will then light up, indicating participation in the progressive jackpot. The house dealer will then remove all jackpot fees from the table. The jackpot fees are dropped in a separate and locked jackpot collection box affixed to the left side of the gaming table.
- 6. The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game.
- 7. Progressive Winners:
 - a. The AKQ Spades is paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter.
 - b. All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the amount shown on the meter.
 - c. In the event more than one progressive meter pay or any other qualifying hand hits during the same round, all winning players will be paid the posted progressive prize or the posted fixed amount. When more than one progressive meter pay hits, on progressive pay will be paid from the meter and the others will be paid from the reserve fund.
 - d. When a player has a progressive winner, the dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
 - e. The house dealer shall then contact the floor person.
 - f. Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the floor person shall insert the key and rotate it to "JPH" and then press "J-pot" button. This records the win onto the Game Manager. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
 - g. Returning the key to the "Run" position will restore normal operation of the table, and adjust the meter appropriately for the prize won.
 - h. When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player/dealer), he/she presses "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
 - i. Once the "J-pot" button is pressed, the prize is logged into Game Manager.



- 8. Envy Bonus:
 - a. A player paying the \$1.00 jackpot fee also qualifies to win an envy payout. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other player who paid the \$1.00 jackpot fee win the envy pay. The player hitting the hand received the normal prize pay only, but does NOT receive the envy pay.
 - b. If a player's hand triggers an envy payout, the house dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the dealer will lock up the cards. The dealer will then move on to the next player.
 - c. The house dealer pays any envy Bonuses at the end of the round. In the event that more than one player is involved in a qualifying envy pay, then all players win multiply envy payouts.
- 9. The prize distribution is as follows:

- 10. All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that will be maintained for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel. A sample log is attached.
- 11. All fixed payouts will be paid by a Casino floor person. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the floor person will pay the winner(s) in casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the Casino dealer's tray. All fixed payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund.
- 12. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at \$1,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Three Card Poker jackpot fund, the initial \$1,000 will be reimbursed to the Casino.
- 13. Each \$1.00 jackpot fee paid by a player will be broken down as follows:
 - a. \$0.15 will be immediately posted on the meter.
 - b. \$0.70 will be tracked in a reserve fund. The reserve fund will be utilized to immediately reseed the metered progressive jackpot prize at \$1,000. In addition this reserve fund will payout all fixed amounts.
 - c. \$0.15 will be retained by the Casino as an administrative fee.
- 14. Only seated players are eligible for payouts.
- 15. Any person wishing to participate in the Three Card Poker Progressive jackpot on a "No Purchase Necessary" (NPN) basis may do so. The assigned floor person will open a Three Card Poker table where the NPN participant will play in a simulated game on a general and indiscriminate basis with no restrictions. There will be no live wagers or monies used on the NPN table. All game rules for the live game will be adhered too.

Advertising

Casino M8trix may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001319) will be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Bonus Chip values
- Buy-in amount for Bonus Chips
- Procedures to redeem Bonus Chips
- Any other applicable restrictions and/or information

Eligible Controlled Games

The Bonus Chip Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at Casino Matrix at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to all patrons who buy-in for a predetermined amount ranging from \$10 to \$100,000; those patrons will receive a specific amount of Bonus Chips to play in any controlled game listed above. When patrons buy-in to a predetermined game for a predetermined and posted amount ranging from \$10 to \$100,000, they will receive a predetermined and posted additional amount of Bonus Chips ranging from \$5 to \$20,000. The Bonus Chips are of a different style and design from the standard live casino chip. The Bonus Chips cannot be exchanged for cash and must be played on the gaming table, at the predetermined game. Once the Bonus Chip(s) has been placed as a wager, the following applies:

- If the player wins, the player will receive live casino chips for their bet from the playerdealer. The player retains the Bonus Chips and can reuse the Bonus Chips on another wager.
- If the player pushes, the Bonus Chips will remain with the player until the hand loses.
- If the player loses, the Bonus Chips are given to the player-dealer. The losing Bonus Chips are verified by a casino representative and redeemed at the cage by the casino cage staff members for the player-dealer. A casino representative will exchange the Bonus Chips with live casino chips and are given to the player-dealer.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the abovelisted controlled games during the predetermined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- The Bonus Chip Promotion will be open to players who buy into a predetermined game and will receive a specific amount of Bonus Chips.
- Players may use Bonus Chips on bonus bets.

- Bonus Chips shall not be used to pay collection fees (if applicable).
- There is no limit to the number of times a player may participate in the Bonus Chip Promotion during a promotional period.
- When using Bonus Chips, a player shall pay all posted collection fees (if applicable) as if they were placing a normal live wager.
- Players cannot exchange Bonus Chips for live casino chips.
- Players can take the Bonus Chips and use them at a later date.
- Bonus Chips do not expire.
- Bonus Chips are non-transferable between players.
- Bonus Chips have no cash value and cannot be redeemed for cash at any time.
- There is a minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, required in the controlled game for this promotion.
- Bonus Chips will only be redeemed for the player-dealer after having been played and verified by a casino representative.
- Casino employees off duty and out of uniform are eligible for the promotion.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to use Bonus Chips.
- Backline bettors may participate in this gaming activity.
- Bonus Chips can be used in combination with live casino chips.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to use Bonus Chips.

<u>Prize</u>

When patrons buy-in to a predetermined game for a predetermined and posted amount ranging from \$10 to \$100,000, they will receive a predetermined and posted additional amount ranging from \$5 to \$20,000 in the form of Bonus Chips.

Funding

The Bonus Chip Promotion will be fully funded by Casino M8trix. There will be no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain any administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bonus Chip Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

Casino M8trix may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should Casino M8trix</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001312) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Casino M8trix at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Requirements for qualifying hands
- Prize payout structure
- Qualifying hands and corresponding jackpot prize amount
- Double Jackpot qualifying time periods, games and/or limits
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this jackpot

Eligible Controlled Games

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Casino M8trix, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Texas Hold'em (GEGA-000644)

Object and Summary

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot features a player-funded progressive jackpot prize. A prize is awarded to active players participating in any of the above controlled games when a designated qualifying hand is beaten by a better hand at the showdown. When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with qualifying hands shall receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize. The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot also features an optional Double Jackpot, which when offered, will double the amount of the posted jackpot prize. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample advanced notice of the percentage division of the posted jackpot prize.

Qualifying Hands

Players who make one of the following qualifying hands for any of the controlled games listed below shall be eligible to win their share of the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot prize amount, as shown below. Only Bureau approved winning and losing hands pre-determined and designated by the Casino are eligible. In order to qualify for the jackpot, both the winning and losing hands must independently use their two hole cards and three community board cards. Only one of these qualifying hand options shall be offered at any one time that the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot is being offered for play. No combination of the qualifying hand options shall be offered with ample advance notice of which qualifying hand option is being offered for play. Qualifying hand(s) will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other form of advertisement.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of five players required to be seated and actively playing in an above mentioned game for the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- In the event two or more players make a qualifying winning and/or losing hand, the player with the highest qualifying winning and losing hand shall win the posted percentage of the prize for the hand; all other players shall win the posted percentage of the table share.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative will verify both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- The players with the qualifying winning and losing hands must complete the applicable bets on each round and play through the final betting round (the showdown) in order to qualify for the jackpot.
- The losing hand must be the second-best hand to qualify for the jackpot.
- There is no restriction on the number of times a player may qualify for or win a prize.
- The prize will be paid at the completion of play for the qualifying hands. In the event of a tie, the prize will be equally divided amongst the winners.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate when on or off duty and out of uniform.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this jackpot.
- A player with a missed blind button will not qualify for any portion of the jackpot.

<u>Prize</u>

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot prize shall range in value from \$5,000 to \$100,000. A casino representative shall pay the winners in a combination of Casino M8trix gaming chips, and/or Casino M8trix checks. The actual prize amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at and the amount that has accumulated from the daily progressive increase each day. The minimum jackpot cap amount is \$15,000 and the maximum cap amount is \$100,000. Under no circumstances shall the jackpot amount be decreased once predetermined and posted. The Casino may choose to increase the jackpot amount above the posted amount at any time (within the minimum and maximum prize amount limits above) with advanced notice to patrons for predetermined, posted and limited designated time period. The actual jackpot prize amount and the amount that the jackpot shall increase by daily shall be posted within the Casino at all times the jackpot is being offered for play.

Patrons shall be given ample notice of the actual jackpot prize amount. Furthermore, the amount of the progressive jackpot prize pool shall be displayed prominently within the Casino at all time the jackpot is being offered for play.

Double Jackpot

Casino M8trix may designate certain times and days at which the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot prize in specified games and/or limits will be doubled. The qualifications for the Double Jackpot will be exactly the same as the currently running Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot. The qualifying periods for the Double Jackpot will be clearly posted and announced beforehand. The Double Jackpot promotion may be offered in all games, or only in specific games and limits. Eligible games and limits will be clearly specified before the start of the promotion. The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot progressive meter will not change when the Double Jackpot is being offered as the amount is calculated from the posted Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot amount. The amount that is shown on the progressive meter will be paid out and the other half of the Double Jackpot will be paid from the reserve fund. In the event there are insufficient funds in the reserve fund, the Casino shall cover any shortfall and shall be reimbursed once the reserve is sufficient and funds become available.

Example: a Double Jackpot may be offered from 6:00pm to 10:00pm every Monday night, in Texas Hold'em limit games only. If the Double Jackpot is being offered and the jackpot hits when the progressive meter reads \$50,000, the prize will be doubled and the other \$50,000 shall be paid from the reserve fund.

Once the proper paperwork has been complete and the hands have been verified, a casino representative shall pay the winners in a combination of Casino M8trix gaming chips, and/or Casino M8trix checks. All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and/or on a handwritten log to maintained by the casino for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Prize Payout Structure

Players that make the designated qualifying hands will be eligible to win their share of the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot prize amounts, as shown below. Only one of these prize payout structure options shall be offered at any one time that the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot is being offered for play. No combination of the prize payout structure options shall be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered. The posted percentage of the jackpot prize, known as the Table Share, shall be evenly distributed among all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game, as show below in Options A, B and C. Patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of which prize payout structure option is being offered for play. The prize payout structure will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

Funding

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot consists of a player-funded progressive prize pool. During all Texas Hold'em games, a \$1 jackpot fee is taken from the pot and then converted into a single specially branded and marked Casino M8trix Progressive nonredeemable and nonnegotiable jackpot chip when five (5) or more players are dealt in on a hand. The jackpot chip is placed onto the slider and then immediately dropped into the locked collection drop box. The employee house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the game. The casino shall initially seed the jackpot with an amount ranging between \$5,000 and \$100,000. Once there are sufficient funds in the jackpot reserve, the initial amount furnished by the Casino to seed the jackpot shall be repaid to the Casino from the jackpot reserve. The jackpot collection fees shall then be used to fund the jackpot fund. Additionally, whenever the Casino is required to seed the jackpot or cover a shortfall due to inadequate funds in the reserve account, the Casino shall be repaid from the jackpot reserve account once the reserve is sufficient and funds become available. When a qualifying jackpot hand is made, the jackpot will be re-seeded by the reserve fund, or by the Casino if there are insufficient funds in the reserve fund, in an amount ranging between \$100 and \$100,000. The jackpot shall increase daily in an amount ranging between \$100 and \$5,000 at pre-determined and designated times, based on the amount of the jackpot collection fees collected during live play at all eligible tables. All fee collections and table limits for the designated controlled game are Bureau approved, predetermined and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall retain an administrative fee of \$1 to \$10 per table per hour. The administrative fee shall be taken from the reserve fund. This fee shall cover the costs associated with prizes, administering and accounting for the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Eligible Controlled Games

The High Hand promotion shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Casino M8trix, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Texas Hold'em (GEGA-000644) •

Object and Summary

Players, participating in Texas Hold'em, who obtain the highest ranking poker hand during a predetermined and posted time period shall win a predetermined and posted fixed prize ranging in value from \$10 to \$10,000.

The qualifying High Hand made by players shall be digitally tracked and the current high hand will be shown on a monitor that is visible to all patrons. The player(s) with the highest ranking poker hand at the end of the designated time period shall win the predetermined and posted prize amount. The winning hand will be verified by a casino representative.

Qualifying Hands

To qualify for the High Hand prize a player must obtain a minimum qualifying hand of a Full House and must use both hole cards.

Full House	A hand that consists of a Three of a Kind and a Pair. Three aces and two kings is the highest ranked Full House and three 2s and two 3s is the lowest ranked Full House.

Eliaibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

High Hand

- A player is eligible to win this promotion by achieving the highest ranking hand during the posted times of this promotion.
- There is no limit on how many times a player may win this promotion.
- A minimum of five players must be dealt into the game, as listed above, in order for the game to qualify.
- In the event that the prize is not awarded during a promotional period the prize will be carried over into the next promotional period.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in the promotion when off duty and out of uniform.
- All qualifying high hands must be verified by the casino representative in order for the hand to be eligible.
- Players must be present to win. In the event the player is not present, the prize will be awarded to the player with the next highest hand that is present.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this promotion.

<u>Prize</u>

The High Hand promotion features a fixed prize that will range from a minimum of \$10 to a maximum of \$10,000. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative. Once all proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.

In the event that two or more players achieve the same qualifying hand the prize will be split evenly amongst the winners.

- In the event that the prize cannot be evenly split, the odd chip will be awarded to the player who achieved the winning hand first.
 - In the event that multiple players achieve the same qualifying hand at the same time, the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot reserve fund will make up the shortfall.

<u>Funding</u>

This promotion will be fully funded from the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot (GEAR-001312) reserve fund. There will be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken for this promotion.

All monies paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that shall be maintained by the gambling enterprise, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain an administrative fee other than what is already collected for the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot (GEAR-001312).

No Purchase Necessary

The High Hand shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the High Hand</u>. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Advertising

The Casino M8trix may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001315) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Object and Summarv

The Roval Flush Promotion features a progressive jackpot prize ranging in value from \$1 to \$20,000. Players participating the Texas Hold'em, during a predetermined and posted time period, will automatically be eligible to qualify for the Royal Flush Promotion.

To qualify for the Royal Flush Promotion, a player must achieve a Royal Flush hand using both of their hole cards.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make the following qualifying hand shall be eligible to win their share of the Royal Flush Promotion. Qualifying hands must use both of the player's hole cards and three community cards. All suits will be considered equal in rank. All gualifying hands within a chart must be offered together at all times.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of five players required to be dealt in during an eligible game in order for players to be eligible for the prize.
- A round of play does not have to make it to the showdown in order for a table to qualify for the Royal Flush Promotion.
 - A round of play may end before the river, but the player still qualifies as long as the qualifying hand has been made.
- A player needs to make it to the completion of a round of play in order to qualify for the prize.
- Players must show both hole cards on the table to be eligible.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative shall verify that the hand qualifies. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player may win a prize in any given promotional period.
- On-duty proposition players are eligible for this promotion.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this gaming activity.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in this gaming activity off duty and out of uniform.

<u>Prize</u>

The Royal Flush Promotion features a progressive prize pool that will range from \$1 to \$20,000. Patrons shall be given ample notice of the actual jackpot prize amount. Furthermore, the amount of the progressive jackpot prize pool shall be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the Royal Flush Promotion is being offered for play.

Players who achieve a Royal Flush will win 100% of the posted prize pool amount. In the event that more than one player achieve a qualifying hand at the same time:

Eligibility Requirements

The casino employee shall then select an eligible table by a random number generator or a manual numbered ball drawing. The drawing shall depict a number that corresponds to an eligible poker table. The Player Appreciation Promotion will be fully funded by Casino M8trix. There will be no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

No Purchase Necessary

The Player Appreciation Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

The Casino M8trix may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001320) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Casino M8trix at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Buy-In amount
- Amount of the additional live casino chips to be awarded.
- Amount of time needed to play to qualify
- Requirement of Player Rewards Card enrollment.
- If there is a cap to the number of participants, the Casino will advertise the predetermined number of participants
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Bargain Buy-In shall be attached to all Bureau approved poker games offered at Casino M8trix at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

For the Bargain Buy-In promotion a player will buy into an eligible game, at a predetermined date and time, for a predetermined amount, and will receive a predetermined amount of additional live casino chips for play. The additional chips will be awarded to players after they have completed a predetermined amount of time played.

Example: At the time of buy-in, during the promotional period, a player purchases and is handed \$30.00 in live casino chips. The player will then play Texas Hold'em for an hour. At the end of the hour the player will then be handed an additional \$20.00 in live casino chips for play.

The player's time played will be tracked through the Casino M8trix Player's Club Promotion (GEAR-001331).

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will not retain any administrative fee, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bargain Buy-In does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

Casino M8trix may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should Casino M8trix</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001347) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Casino M8trix at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Availability of the Double Jackpot element
- Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0 prize pool amount
- Initial and Re-seed amounts
- Amount and frequency of money added to the prize pool
- Qualifying Hand Option
- Prize Payout Structure Option
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this jackpot

Eligible Controlled Games

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0 shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at Casino M8trix, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

• Texas Hold'em (GEGA-000644)

Object and Summary

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0 (jackpot) features a player-funded progressive prize. The object of the jackpot is for a player to form a qualifying hand that is beaten by a better hand at the showdown of the base game.

To participate in the jackpot players will need to participate in an eligible game, at a table with five active players or more. Players shall place their wagers according to the base game rules, after all initial wagers have been placed, the house dealer will collect a \$1 jackpot fee from the pot. The jackpot fee will be collected before the flop and will be placed in a locked collection drop box. After the jackpot fee has been collected the house dealer will follow approved procedures for dealing the base game.

When the winning and losing hands are confirmed, those players with qualifying hands shall receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize pool amount, as shown in the Prize Payout Structure below.

When predetermined and posted the jackpot may also feature an optional Double Jackpot which, when offered, will double the amount of the posted jackpot prize.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make one of the following advertised qualifying hands shall be eligible to win their share of the jackpot prize pool as shown below. In order to qualify for the promotion, players dealt the qualifying hands must use both hole cards. Only winning and losing hands that have been Bureau approved, pre-determined, and designated by the casino are eligible. Only one of the following qualifying hand options shall be offered at a time. Any combination of different qualifying hand options shall not be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is a minimum of five players required to be seated and actively playing in an above mentioned game for the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- In the event two or more players make a qualifying winning and/or losing hand, the player with the highest qualifying winning and losing hand shall win the posted percentage of the prize pool for the hand; all other players shall win the posted percentage of the table share.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a casino representative shall verify both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- The players with the qualifying winning and losing hands must complete the applicable bets on each round and play through the final betting round (the showdown) in order to qualify for the jackpot.
- The losing hand must be the second-best hand to qualify for the jackpot.
- There is no restriction on the number of times a player may qualify for or win a prize.
- The prize will be paid at the completion of play for the qualifying hands.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate when on or off duty and out of uniform.
- Tournament games do not qualify for this jackpot.
- A player with a missed blind button will not qualify for any portion of the jackpot.

<u>Prize</u>

The jackpot prize pool shall range in value from \$5,000 to \$100,000. The actual jackpot prize pool amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at and the amount that has accumulated from the daily progressive increase each day. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative once all proper paperwork has been filled out. The casino representative will pay the winners in live casino chips or a check. All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and/or on a handwritten log to be maintained by the casino for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

- Under no circumstances shall the jackpot pool amount be decreased once predetermined and posted.
- The jackpot prize pool shall increase daily at an amount between \$100 and \$5,000, dependent on the amount of jackpot fees collected during live play.
 - The daily increase amount will come from the reserve fund.
 - If there are not sufficient funds in the reserve fund, the casino will make up the short fall and will be reimbursed.
- The daily jackpot prize pool increase shall be done at a predetermined and designated times.
- The Casino may choose to increase the jackpot pool amount above the posted amount at any time (within the minimum and maximum prize amount limits above) with advanced notice to patrons for predetermined, posted and limited designated time period.
- Patrons shall be given ample notice of the actual jackpot pool prize amount. Furthermore, the amount of the progressive jackpot prize pool shall be displayed prominently within the Casino at all time the jackpot is being offered for play.

Double Jackpot

Double Jackpot is an optional element of the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0 prize. The Double Jackpot element allows the casino to double the prize pool to an amount between \$10,000 and \$200,000. The casino will be able to offer the Double Jackpot during specific, days, hours, game limits, or tables as long as it is predetermined and posted. Prizes will be awarded as normal and according the selected prize structure option.

- The posted jackpot prize pool amount will not change when the Double Jackpot is being offered, as the amount is calculated from the posted prize pool amount.
- The posted amount that is shown on the jackpot prize pool will be paid from the jackpot prize pool, the other half will be paid from the reserve fund.
 - In the event there are insufficient funds in the reserve fund, the Casino shall cover any shortfall and shall be reimbursed once the reserve is sufficient and funds become available.

Example: a Double Jackpot may be offered from 6:00pm to 10:00pm every Monday night, in Texas Hold'em limit games only. If the Double Jackpot is being offered and the jackpot hits when the progressive meter reads \$50,000, the prize will be doubled and the other \$50,000 shall be paid from the reserve fund.

Prize Payout Structure

Players that make the designated qualifying hands will be eligible to win their share of the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0 prize pool, based on the payout structure option being used, as shown below. Only one of these prize payout structure options shall be offered at any one time that the jackpot is being offered for play. No combination of the prize payout structure options shall be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered.

Patrons shall be provided with ample advance notice of which prize payout structure option is being offered for play. Once the Casino designates a prize payout structure option, the payout structure shall not be adjusted or changed until the jackpot has been hit and awarded. Furthermore, the prize payout structure will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

- Players who obtain a qualifying Losing Hand shall win the corresponding percentage of the prize pool, depending on the selected prize payout structure option.
 - Players who obtain the qualifying Losing Hand will not be eligible for the Table Share.
- Players who obtain a qualifying Winning Hand shall win the corresponding percentage of the prize pool, depending on the selected prize payout structure option.
 - Players who obtain the qualifying Winning Hand will not be eligible for the Table Share.
- Active players who are at the same table where the qualifying losing and winning hands are obtained, will spilt the Table Share percentage of the prize pool, depending on the selected prize payout structure option.
 - In the event there is an odd number of chips, the Casino will make up the shortfall and will be reimbursed from the reserve fund.

Funding

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0 consists of a player-funded progressive prize pool. During all Texas Hold'em games, when five or more players are dealt in on a hand, a \$1 jackpot fee is taken from the pot and then converted into a single specially branded and marked Casino M8trix Progressive nonredeemable and nonnegotiable jackpot chip. The jackpot chip is placed onto the slider and then immediately dropped into the locked collection drop box and will be added to the reserve fund.

The casino shall initially seed the jackpot with an amount ranging between \$5,000 and \$100,000. When the jackpot prize has been awarded, the jackpot prize pool will be re-seeded at an amount between \$5,000 and \$100,000, from the reserve fund. If there are not sufficient funds in the reserve fund, the casino will make up the short fall.

The jackpot prize pool shall increase daily at an amount between \$100 and \$5,000, dependent on the amount of jackpot fees collected during live play at all eligible tables. The daily jackpot prize pool increase shall be done at a predetermined and designated times. The daily increase to the jackpot prize pool will come from the reserve fund. If there are not sufficient funds in the reserve fund, the casino will make up the short fall.

Additionally, whenever the Casino is required to seed the jackpot prize pool or cover a shortfall due to inadequate funds in the reserve fund, the Casino shall be repaid from the reserve fund once sufficient funds become available.

All fee collections and table limits for the designated controlled game are Bureau approved, predetermined and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall retain an administrative fee of \$1 to \$10 per table per hour. The administrative fee shall be taken from the reserve fund. This fee shall cover the costs associated with prizes, administering and accounting for the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0 shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot 2.0. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Advertising

Casino M8trix may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001331) will be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, will be prominently displayed in Casino M8trix at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Required amount of time to be played and corresponding points earned
- The date(s) and time(s) the activity shall be offered
- All prizes offered and specific number of points required for each prize
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Casino M8trix Player's Club Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Casino M8trix at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

The Casino M8trix Player's Club Promotion is a loyalty reward program open to all Casino M8trix patrons. The promotion will assign players with a player rewards card and reward players with points based on the amount of time played at designated tables during predetermined and posted time periods.

Player's Club Card Computer System Description

The Player's Club Card shall include the casino name, the casino logo, some descriptive language regarding restrictions for the card, and the problem gambling phone number. There shall also be a bar code and a player number unique to each player in the Casino M8trix Player's Reward management system.

- Players will receive a player's card once they sign up for the Casino M8trix Player's Club Promotion with a casino representative.
 - Players may sign up and receive a player's card at any time.
- Player information shall be maintained in a secure database accessible only by casino management. Access to the database shall also be tracked by casino management.
 - No one except the network administrator(s) has access to the back-end systems where the data is stored.
 - Access to the data is by user level with multiple levels based on the user's work needs.
 - Marketing managers will have access to customer data for marketing purposes.
- The Player's Club Card shall be non-transferable and can only be used by the player who the card is assigned to.
- The Player's Club Card may be revoked at management's discretion.
- If a Player's Club Card is lost or stolen, the player can ask a casino representative for a replacement at no cost to the player.

- Points in accounts with no new activity (points accrued) for a period of six months shall receive notice that they have six months to visit the casino to accrue or redeem points or their points will expire.
 - The account shall remain in the system indefinitely.
- A computer or mobile device, with a RFID reader or RFID Tag, may be affixed under the gaming table at specific spots designated by the gaming table layout, or a device may be mounted to the gaming table or/and casino podium.
- Player time is tracked by having a casino representative scan or manually enter the card information into the computer or mobile device, or the player places their RFID card on top of the gaming table or scans their RFID Tag with Player's mobile device
 - The player will accrue time until they leave the game and are checked out by a casino representative; or they pick up their RFID player card from the table or remove their mobile device from table; or
 - They temporarily leave the game, and the casino representative puts them in "lobby mode" and then checks back in when they resume play.
- If the Player's Card Computer System should stop working during the promotion, affected parts of the system failure will cease operation.
- A printable record of the amount of time a player has accumulated during the promotional period shall be available at any time it is requested by the player or available via any casino kiosk or player's mobile device.
- All data is backed up to an on-site computer. All data is stored in a RAID system so that single hard drive failures won't affect it. The system is backed up every 24 hours.

How Points are Earned Based on Time Played

Points shall be earned based on the amount of time played. Each player that plays at a predetermined and posted table and has their player's card scanned by a casino representative will earn points based on time played, which can be redeemed for prizes during or at the end of a predetermined and posted promotional period. The range of points per hour played will range from 1 to 1,000.

How Player Rewards Points are Redeemed

Players may redeem their points for prizes at any time during the promotion or at the end of the promotional period. All prizes shall have a predetermined and designated value. After a player has accumulated a predetermined and specific number of points, a player may redeem the accrued points for a predetermined and designated prize. When predetermined and posted, points may also be redeemed for money in these cases 1 point will be worth \$0.50 to \$10.

- After a player has been awarded a prize, they may also be eligible for multiple and subsequent prize(s) until the end of the promotion.
- Players may redeem their points for multiple prizes so long as the total amount of points required for all prizes is within the player's point balance.
- Once points are redeemed by the player, they are deducted from their point balance.
- Points are non-transferable and may only be redeemed by the player that earned them.

- Backline bettors are eligible for this promotion.
- Employees shall be eligible to participate in this promotion when they are on or off duty and in or out of uniform.
- Third Party Proposition Players are not eligible for this promotion at any time.
- Patrons in the player-dealer position will be able to accumulate time.
- Players may accumulate time while participating in tournaments.

<u>Prize</u>

The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging in value from \$1 to \$100,000. Prizes may be in the form of cash, live casino chips, additional Casino M8trix Player's Club Promotion points, jewelry, electronics, clothing, vehicles, watercraft, gift certificates, entertainment tickets, travel, entry into California Tournaments (GEGA-000546), and entry into Poker Tournaments (GEGA-000547).

All prizes for this promotion will be predetermined and posted in advance throughout the gaming floor, and in all literature promoting such events.

The Casino shall not retain an administrative fee, as this gaming activity is house-funded.

The Casino M8trix Player's Club Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary Table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Advertising

Casino M8trix may advertise various names for this gaming activity. <u>Should the Casino</u> advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001285) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts
- Jackpot fee amount and breakdown

Object and Summary

The Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot features both progressive and fixed jackpot prizes that are linked between games listed above (see Eligible Controlled Games). The object of the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot is to place an optional Jackpot fee and form a qualifying hand, as mentioned below, in order to win a corresponding prize.

1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. The players may optionally place any bonus bets along with the optional jackpot fee of \$1 onto a designated area on the table layout.

- 2. Once all players have placed their bets and optional jackpot fee(s), the Casino M8trix employee dealer (hereafter referred to as "employee dealer") shall then collect all jackpot fee(s), convert them into a Casino M8trix non-negotiable and non-redeemable jackpot chip(s) on the table layout, and then drop those Casino M8trix jackpot chip(s) into the locked collection box to be accounted for separately.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of two players, a player and a player-dealer, are required to play for this gaming activity.
- Only seated players, who have paid the optional \$1 jackpot fee and are dealt a designated hand, are eligible for payouts.
- Backline bettors are not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee or receive a prize for a qualifying hand.
- If a player with a qualifying hand folds prior to the final betting round, they will still be eligible for the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot payout.
- There is no limit to how many times a player may win a progressive or fixed prize within a promotional period.
- A seated player may place a base game wager, as well as the optional \$1 jackpot fee, on any unoccupied seat, as well as their own, and become eligible for multiple payouts.
- The Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot may run concurrently with other Bureauapproved jackpots for the eligible games listed above. Patrons are eligible to win a prize for each jackpot they qualify for.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible for this promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible for the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot when off-duty.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this gaming activity.

• Third-Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to place a jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot when in either the player-dealer or player capacity.

<u>Prize</u>

Once the proper paperwork has been filled out and the hands have been verified, a casino representative will pay the winners in the form of a check or live casino chips. All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked, recorded and maintained by the casino for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Progressive Prize

All progressive prizes shall be paid from the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot prize pool. The progressive prize pool has a cap of \$450,000. A player is paid 100% of the jackpot when dealt a qualifying hand, as shown above. A player is paid 10% of the jackpot when dealt a qualifying hand, as shown above.

- When a 10% prize is paid out, the total progressive jackpot prize is reduced by that amount.
- When a 100% prize is paid out, the prize pool is re-seeded from the reserve fund.
- In the event that a hand, or multiple hands, from the same table, during the same round, each qualifies for 100% or 10% of the jackpot, the prize will be split evenly amongst all qualifying players.
- In the event that more than one hand from different tables, dealt at nearly the same time, each qualifies for the 100% jackpot, a surveillance camera review will be utilized to determine the chronological order of completion of the qualifying hands. The hand which chronologically was completed first shall be awarded the primary jackpot prize. All subsequent qualifying hand(s), if any, shall be awarded the re-seed amount(s).
- In the event that a 100% and a 10% prize qualify on the same table, during the same round of play, the 10% prize shall be paid first and the remaining amount shall then be paid to the 100% jackpot qualifying hand.
- In the event that a 100% and a 10% jackpot from different tables, dealt at nearly the same time, a surveillance camera review will be utilized to determine the chronological order of completion of the qualifying hands. If the 10% jackpot hand was completed first, it shall be paid the associated prize amount and the remaining amount shall be awarded to the 100% jackpot qualifying hand. If the 100% jackpot hand is determined to have been completed first, then that hand shall be paid first and then the 10% prize from the original prize pool shall be awarded from the re-seed amount.
- In the event that more than one hand from different tables, dealt at nearly the same time, each qualifies for the 10% jackpot, a surveillance camera review will be utilized to determine the chronological order of completion of the qualifying hands. Those paid following the first 10% jackpot payout shall receive 10% of the remainder of the jackpot.
- For Progressive Jackpot prizes which require the stated outcome of multiple consecutive hands in order to trigger the associated prize(s), such as, but not limited to, Dragon-Dragon in Baccarat and four consecutive Natural 21's in Pure 21.5 Blackjack, a jackpot fee paid by the player associated with that hand, is required to have been placed prior to the delivery of cards for each of those hands. The employee-dealer shall lay a conspicuous lammer in front of each qualifying player for each hand that they've amassed toward the ultimate trigger outcome.

Fixed Prize

All fixed payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund. In the event that more than one qualifying hand hits during the same round, all fixed prize-winning players will be paid 100% of the posted fixed prize amount. In the event that the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will cover any shortfall. The Casino shall be reimbursed for any shortfall covered once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund.

M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot

Casino M8trix may designate specific times and days at which the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot prize in specified games and/or limits will be increased by an amount between a minimum of \$500 to \$100,000. The qualifications for the M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot will be precisely the same as the currently running Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot. The qualifying periods for the M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot will be clearly posted and announced beforehand. The M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot promotion may be offered in all games or only in specific games and limits. Eligible games and limits will be clearly specified before the start of the promotion. The Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot progressive meter will not change when the M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot is being offered. The amount shown on the progressive meter will be paid out, and the other amount of the M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot will be paid from the reserve fund. In the event there are insufficient funds in the reserve fund, the Casino shall cover any shortfall and shall be reimbursed once the reserve is sufficient and funds become available.

Example: A M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot may be offered from 6:00pm to 10:00pm every Monday night, in Baccarat games only. If the M8trix Mega Mega Jackpot is being offered and the jackpot hits when the progressive meter reads \$50,000, the prize will be increased by the specified amount and shall be paid from the reserve fund.

Prize Payout Structure

Patrons shall be given ample notice of the actual jackpot prize amount. Furthermore, the amount of the progressive jackpot prize pool shall be displayed prominently within the Casino at all times the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot is being offered for play.

Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot Pay Table

Funding

The Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot is a player funded progressive jackpot which features fixed and progressive prize elements. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at a minimum of \$5,000 to a maximum of \$250,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino and shall be documented in the accounting records. The progressive jackpot shall have a cap of \$450,000. Once the cap has been reached, any additional jackpot fees collected shall go to the reserve fund.

After the progressive jackpot is hit, it will be re-seeded by the reserve fund at an amount between a minimum of \$5,000 and a maximum of \$250,000. In addition, this reserve fund will payout all fixed amounts. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall. Once there are sufficient monies in the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot reserve

fund, the re-seed amount, up to the amount the Casino funded, will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. All increases and decreases to the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot fund shall be documented in the accounting records.

Each \$1.00 jackpot fee paid by a player shall be broken down as follows:

- \$0.20 shall be immediately posted on the meter.
- \$0.80 shall be tracked in a reserve fund.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall take an administrative fee of \$5 to \$20 per table per hour. The administrative fee shall be taken from the reserve fund. The fee shall cover the costs associated with administering and accounting for the jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Casino M8trix Progressive Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and digital reader related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by the Gaming Laboratories International, LLC (GLI).

- When a player has a progressive winner, the casino representative shall select the player spot corresponding to the player with the winning progressive hand.
- The casino representative shall then press the appropriate hand button on the display.
- Once the casino representative verifies the progressive win, the casino representative will press "Confirm", then enter their unique authorization pin. A record of this transaction will be recorded and saved.
- House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- When the casino representative reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), they press "Game Over." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
