California Penal Code section 11105.2(d) states, in part, that any agency which submits the fingerprints of applicants for employment, licensing or certification or approval to the Department of Justice (DOJ) for the purpose of establishing a record of the applicant to receive notification of subsequent arrests, shall immediately notify the department when employment, license or certification is terminated or the applicant is not hired or issued a license. Agencies must submit NLIs to the Bureau of Criminal Information and Analysis through the Applicant Justice Agency Connection System.

**Authority**

Pursuant to California Penal Code section 26225, subdivision (b), a licensing authority shall notify the Department of Justice (DOJ) immediately when a license is issued under Chapter 4 (commencing with Section 26150) of Division 5 of Title 4 of Part 6 of the Penal Code has been denied or revoked. It is at the discretion of the licensing authority to determine when a license is no longer permissible, unless the DOJ notified the licenses authority that the applicant is prohibited by state or federal law from possessing, receiving, owning, or purchasing a firearm in which case the license must be revoked immediately. (Pen. Code, § 26195. subd. (b).)
