This emergency action by the Department of Justice (DOJ) establishes the qualifications necessary to become a Carried Concealed Weapon (CCW) DOJ Certified Instructor; establishes the grounds for revoking a CCW DOJ Certified Instructor's certification; establishes the process for the CCW license applicant's background check so DOJ can determine the applicant's eligibility to possess, receive, own, or purchase a firearm; and provides the manner for a licensing authority to send certain CCW license records to DOJ. This action is a deemed emergency and exempt from OAL review pursuant to Penal Code section 26225(d).

OAL filed these emergency regulations with the Secretary of State and will publish the emergency regulations in the California Code of Regulations.
