INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTRATION FUNDRAISING COUNSEL FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES (FORM CT-3CF)



WHO MUST FILE

Every fundraising counsel for charitable purposes in California must register with the Attorney General's Registry of Charities and Fundraisers Charitable Trusts prior to planning, managing, advising, counseling, consulting or preparing material for, or with respect to, the solicitation in this state of funds, assets or property for charitable purposes. "Fundraising counsel for charitable purposes" is defined in California Government Code section 12599.1, subdivisions (a) and (b).

WHEN TO FILE

Fundraising counsel for charitable purposes must register annually in California for each calendar year of activity. The deadline for filing the registration form is January 15 of the applicable year.

FEE MUST ACCOMPANY REGISTRATION

A registration fee of \$500 must accompany each annual registration form. Checks should be made payable to the ATTORNEY GENERAL'S REGISTRY OF <u>CHARITIES AND FUNDRAISERS</u> CHARITABLE TRUSTS. Registration forms not accompanied by full payment will not be processed and will be returned.

PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO REGISTER

Failure by a fundraising counsel to register with and report each person, corporation, or other legal entity for whom the fundraising counsel has performed any services to the Registry of Charities and Fundraisers Charitable Trusts is unlawful. A fundraising counsel for charitable purposes is subject to the Attorney General's supervision and enforcement to the same extent as a trustee for charitable purposes. Government Code section 12586.1 authorizes the Attorney General to charge late fees for each month or part of the month for registrations not received annually by January 15. This code section can be found on the Charitable Trusts Section website at-www.oag.ca.gov/charities under "Laws & Regulations."
