## Public Rights Division - Environmental Justice and Protection Section & Natural Resources Law Section - Sacramento



The Environmental Justice and Protection Section and Natural Resources Law Section of the California Attorney General's office seek interested law students and recent graduates for volunteer internship positions in Sacramento. These sections work on behalf of the people of the State of California, representing dozens of state agencies and the Attorney General in his independent capacity to achieve environmental justice, maintain clean air and water, ensure public access to state lands and beaches, and combat environmental pollution. The sections practice before all state and federal trial and appellate courts.

Interns can expect broad exposure to the practice of law in the public sector and may draft motions and pleadings, conduct research on complex and challenging questions of law, draft discovery requests and responses, and review and assess evidence. Interns can also expect frequent opportunities to attend client meetings, depositions, court hearings, and trials.

Applicants should possess excellent writing, research, and analytical skills. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis for remote and hybrid internships. Interviews are conducted on a rolling basis, so potential applicants are encouraged to apply as soon as their materials are ready. However, the deadlines to apply are as follows: Summer internships: January 31; Fall externships: July 15; Spring externships: November 15.
