Turlock Poker Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Turlock Poker Room advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-000985) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Match Play Promotion.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this promotion, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Turlock Poker Room at all times the promotion is being offered:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Match Play Coupon and/or Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip values
- Procedures to redeem Match Play coupons or Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip.
- Any other applicable restrictions.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Match Play and/or Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip Promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved California games offered at the Turlock Poker Room at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Patrons are awarded Match Play or Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, location placement (e.g. come into the bar and receive a Match Play or Lucky Buck coupon), during pre-determined and posted times (e.g. come in between 7am-9am and receive a Match Play or Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip coupon), first time players, etc. After a player receives a coupon, he/she shall write their name or player rewards card number (GEGA-002831) on the back for identification and record keeping. Players who receive a Match Play will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the coupon if he/she places a wager on an eligible game equal to the amount listed on the coupon. Players who receive a Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the chip without placing a wager.

Match Play Coupon

The Casino will offer Match Play coupons having a face value from \$5 to \$50 per coupon. The amount will be clearly stated on the coupon. Each coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) for which the coupon may be used. When playing the Match Play coupon, the player must place a wager next to the Match Play coupon, in the betting circle, which is equal to the amount of the Match Play coupon. The player will pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play. The collection fee will be based solely on the player's wager and does not include the Match Play coupon's value as part of the collection. A player's winning hand will be paid his/her wager as well as the listed amount on the Match Play coupon by the player-dealer. The player-dealer will then have a floor person sign the coupon verifying that it has been won. Winning coupons are taken to the cage by the floor person, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the coupon(s). That amount is then returned to the player-dealer. If a player loses, the money part of the wager is collected by the player-dealer, and the coupon is voided and collected by the house dealer. If the player pushes (receives no action), the coupon may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

Match Play Promotion

EXAMPLE: A person receives a Match Play coupon with a value of \$5 that specifically states it may be used to place a wager on the Pai Gow Poker table. The person would place the coupon on the gaming table; place a bet that matches the amount on the coupon, and pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play. If the player wins the hand, he/she will receive \$10 just as if they had placed a \$10 bet and the player-dealer will collect the coupon.

Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip

The Casino will offer Lucky Buck/Lucky Chips having a face value from \$5 to \$50 per chip. The Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash.

The Lucky Chips shall initially be in the form of a Lucky Buck coupon which shall be offered to all patrons that wish to come into the Casino and use them to play. Patrons may be awarded Lucky Buck coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, location placement (for example come into the bar and receive a Lucky Buck coupon), during pre-determined and posted times (for example come in between 7am-9am and receive a Lucky Buck coupon), first time players, etc. When a patron receives a Lucky Buck coupon he/she shall take the coupon to the cage for verification, logging, and redemption of the Lucky Chip(s) to be used in a live game. Each coupon shall state the specific qualifying game(s) that the Lucky Chip(s) may be used on.

Lucky Chips shall be used as the player's bet and placed on the betting circle. The player will pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of play. Lucky Chips shall not be taken into the dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray. The Lucky Chip will be collected by the person in the player-dealer position who will then have a floor person verify that the chip has been played. The Lucky Chip is taken to the cage by a floor person, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the chip and the amount designated on the Lucky Chip is paid to the player-dealer. If the player loses the hand, the Lucky Chip is forfeited and will be collected by the casino dealer and dropped in the drop box for accounting purposes. If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip(s) may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: A person receives a Lucky Buck coupon for \$10 that specifically states it can be used to place a wager on the No Bust Blackjack table. The player would take the coupon to the cage. Cage personnel would log the redemption code of the coupon and exchange the coupon for a promotional Lucky Chip. The player would then place the Lucky Chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection (if applicable), and the hand would be played.

Eligibility Requirements

The promotion will be open to all players who are seated and playing at the above listed games during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the promotion.

- A minimum of two (2) players, a player and a player-dealer, is required to be playing in any of the games, as listed above, in order for the game to qualify.
- Each Match Play or Lucky Buck/Lucky Chip coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) that a player may use the coupon at.

During the promotion, players playing in the above listed controlled game will be eligible for 100% of the Mexican Poker Bad Beat Jackpot prize. A prize is awarded to players participating in a predetermined game when a designated hand is beaten by a better qualifying hand at the showdown. When the winning and losing hands are confirmed by a casino representative, the players with the qualifying hands will receive the posted percentage of the jackpot prize. Additionally, the posted table share prize shall be evenly distributed amount all other players at the qualifying table who have participated in the designated game.

Qualifying Hands

Players that make the following qualifying hands shall be eligible to win their share of the Mexican Poker Bad Beat Jackpot prize amount, as shown below. Texas Hold'em, Omaha Hi-Lo, Lowball, Pineapple Hi-Lo, Pai Gow Poker, Pure 21.5 Blackjack, Three Card Poker and Three Card Hold'em. The games being offered in this promotion will be pre-designated and posted well in advance of the promotion beginning.

3. Describe any Jackpot or any other type of prize awarded:

A cash amount (paid in casino chips) will be awarded to a pre-determined number of players who play a pre-determined and specific number of hours (not to exceed 3 hours) in a controlled game.

TPR may also offer merchandise to include, but not limited to electronics, gift cards, merchandise, clothing, tournament entries, and tickets to attractions.

The maximum value of any gift or cash will be \$1000.00 total for any one day period of play. The amount of hours that are required to be played along with how many chips will be given to each player per hour will be pre-determined and clearly posted.

Players must collect their cash or merchandise prize at the time they are awarded, and before the next qualifying period begins. Players are not allowed to carry-over or accumulate hours from one qualifying period to another. As an example – Between 4A and 9A, players earn \$10 per hour of playing time in one hour increments. Players will be able to redeem their points at a rate of \$1.00 per 100 points earned. All points that a player redeems shall be paid out as cash. At the request of a patron, points may be cashed out to purchase food comps/discounts, tournament entries/discounts, special event entry fees, merchandise, gift shop items, or may be used to purchase gaming chips at which point a Turlock Poker Room employee will reduce the player's reward card account by the amount necessary to purchase the requested item.

4. If a cash prize is involved, is the amount progressive or a fixed amount?

Fixed based on points earned.

5. Explain if the gaming activity is House funded or player funded:

House funded.

The proposed Player Rewards Card is a loyalty rewards program open to any Turlock Poker Room patron free-of-charge. The program will reward seated and playing cardholders with points based on hours of play at a given table.

Any patron of the Turlock Poker Room can sign up for a player rewards card at no cost.

Card Description

The player rewards card will include the following information on the front of the card:

• The Turlock Poker Room's Logo.

The player rewards card will include the following information on the back of the card:

- A photo of the player, which will be taken on the date the card is signed up for and created.
- The patrons name.
- The number of the card which is unique to that patron and to the Click Point Software.
- Descriptive language regarding the card and its restrictions.
- A 'Responsible Gambling' message, including the phone number and website for help.
- A barcode unique to the patron's card in the Click Point Software system.

All player information and hours will be logged, tracked, and stored safely in the Click Point Software system. Only management has access to sensitive areas of the system, which includes a history of members' gaming activity within the casino, point redemption history & other data available for analysis. The permission levels for Turlock Poker Room staff are controlled by a Licensee. All staff members with a user name and password (which include cashiers, floor persons & customer service associates) are given minimum access to the Rewards System simply to allow them to perform their duties associated with the Rewards System which can include signing up new members, redeeming points for members & checking membership status. All player information will be maintained in a secure database accessed only by management personnel. The database will be backed up daily. Access to the database will be tracked.

All point structures for a particular promotion will be pre-determined and posted throughout the gaming floor and on all literature. Points can be earned by the amount of time played and can be combined from both live and tournament play, as well as when a player transitions from tournament play to live play. The range of points will be from one hundred (100) to three hundred (300) points per each hour of live play. When a patron enters a tournament, they will be awarded an amount of points, which shall not be based on the amount of time played in the tournament, ranging from twenty-five (25) to two hundred and fifty (250). When a player transitions from tournament play to live play, that player will receive between one hundred (100) to five hundred (500) points for the first hour of play after exiting a tournament and transitioning to live play. This is restricted to only one (1) bonus per day. The bonus points that are awarded for transitioning from tournament play to live play are not a fixed amount. The bonus earn rate is as follows: a multiplier set by the licensee, multiplied by the base rate of earning for that game and time of day equals the amount of points awarded. (i.e. If bonus multiplier is 2 and standard rate of earning is 100 points per hour, then the member would be awarded 200 points for the first hour of play after transitioning from tournament play.) However, the amount awarded shall never be less than one hundred (100) points or more than five hundred (500) points.

- The earn rates will not differentiate based on the table limit of any game.
- All hours that are tracked shall be made available when a player requests to see their status. Players may request to verify how many points they have earned. Upon request, a floorperson will immediately notify that player of how many points they have earned. Players can also ask to see how many points they've accrued by asking

an employee to scan their card. The player will then be shown a record of the points they've earned up to the exact time. A printable record of the points earned will also be made available to customers.

- Points are non-transferrable, and are for use by the patron who earned them only.
- A player wishing to redeem points can ask an employee to redeem their points for food comps/discounts, tournament entries/discounts, special event entry fees, merchandise, gift shop items, or may be used to purchase gaming chips according to the cash equivalent, at which point a Turlock Poker Room employee will reduce the player's reward card account by the amount necessary to purchase the requested item. The employee will check the cardholder versus the picture on the card and scan the Rewards Card to determine if the player's rewards card holds enough of a balance to be red-deem for the requested tiem. If so, the employee shall issue the requested item and the corresponding points will be automatically deducted from the player's unused points.
- Any points not redeemed in a six-month period from the date that the points were scanned and recorded into the system will be purged from the system.
- Only the licensee will have the access and the ability to add points manually. The
 only instance where points would need to be added manually would be in the case of
 user or system error (i.e. accidentally deducting too many points during a coupon
 issuance) or to restore a member's account. In all other instances, no points will be
 manually entered into the system to award points to a player and will only be tracked
 an added based on the scans.

The card will work as follows:

Any patron can request a Rewards Card at no charge. A designated Turlock Poker Room employee will then input the patron's name, address information and take a head shot photo. A Turlock Poker Room employee will then issue a card. The card will be non-transferable.

A player will present their card when they are seated at an eligible game to establish a start time of play. Their card will then be scanned, which will enter them into the system. An employee will visit each table in the poker room on the hour, approximately 15 minutes after each hour, and ask players with rewards cards present their cards. The employee will input the type of table and scan each player card using a handheld, wireless scanner. A player will only earn points based on the time that they were scanned in upon sitting at a table and for each hourly scan that they are scanned. Furthermore, a player's rewards card will only be scanned when they are seated at an eligible game and during each hourly scan, not upon the exit of the player prior to each hourly scan.

For example: If a player sits down at a table at 5:30, they will be scanned into the system. The hourly scan occurs at the beginning of each hour. The player will then get their card scanned at 6:00, which will log 30 minutes of time on their rewards card. If the player plays until 6:30, they will not get credit for the additional 30 minutes, as the next scan is not until 7:00. If the player plays until 7:15, they would get credit when the 7:00 scan occurs, in which case the player would have accrued 90 minutes of time on their rewards card (5:30 to 7:00).

The only additional equipment is plastic swipe cards issued to each participating customer that are the same size as a typical credit card, and a scanning wand or swipe machine to record hours played.

Turlock Poker Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should Turlock Poker Room advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-002285) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Poker Tournaments. Furthermore, all rules and procedures for Poker Tournaments, including but not limited to the following, shall be displayed conspicuously and prominently in Turlock Poker Room at all times that a Poker Tournament is offered for play:

- How a player may enter the tournament.
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament.
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by Turlock Poker Room, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution.
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament.
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered, and the number of players that will be paid.
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid.
- The rules and procedures for any and all gaming activities that being offered in conjunction with the Poker Tournaments.
- Any other restrictions that apply to the Poker Tournaments.

Tournament Log

- Results of the tournament, including the amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament
- Signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament

All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Gaming Activities Offered During Tournament Play

The "Drawing for Prizes" Ticket (GEGA-003545):

- Rules of Play: The Drawing for Prizes Ticket Promotion involves a random drawing where a bin or other randomizer will be used. During pre-determined times and intervals of the promotion, Casino staff will announce the commencement of the drawing and collect player tickets from each player seated at the eligible tournament game. Player tickets will be collected over the course of the promotion and stored for the duration or collected at pre-determined times. Those tickets will then be placed in the drawing bin and will be rotated. Once the tickets are thoroughly mixed, a casino employee will randomly draw one ticket from the bin. The player who has their ticket drawn will be awarded the posted prize. If a ticket is drawn and the winner of the drawing is not present, the ticket will be placed back in the drawing bin and another will be drawn. This process will occur until a winner is selected and present to claim their prize. Once the drawing is complete, all tickets that are used will not be destroyed and not be returned.
- Prize: The Drawing for Prizes Ticket Promotion features a fixed prize element. The player who has their ticket randomly selected will receive a prize ranging in value from \$50 to \$50,000 in the form of casino chips, merchandise, future tournament entries and special event tickets. A player may also win a chance to spin a prize wheel with 108 predesignated spots with different prize amounts posted in each spot. In all instances, prize amounts will be pre-determined and posted before being offered.
- <u>Funding</u>: The prize is funded by the Casino. No amount shall be deducted from the Tournament prize pool in order to fund this gaming activity.

• Eligibility:

- The promotion will be open to all players who participate in an eligible game during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the promotion. The prizes will be awarded to players when their ticket has been randomly selected during a pre-determined and posted time period. The drawing times will be pre-determined and posted in advance during the promotional period.
- For the drawing, the player must be seated and participating at a pre-determined and designated game in order to be eligible to win. Furthermore, players may be required to participate in an eligible game for a pre-determined and designated period of time in order to qualify.
- A player will be eligible to receive one ticket during pre-determined times and intervals during the promotional period such as hourly, daily, weekly, etc. The distribution times, based on time of play, will be pre-determined and posted in advance prior to the promotion being offered.

- All procedures, times, and cash amounts will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

The "Spin for Prizes" Wheel (GEGA-003117):

Rules of Play: The Spin for Prizes Wheel Promotion will be used as a tool to determine a
house-funded amount to be added to a Poker Tournament's prize pool. The additional
cash/chip value will be determined by a licensee of The Turlock Poker Room prior to the
commencement of a designated Poker Tournament for which this feature is offered. The

- Value will be determined when a Turlock Poker Room licensee spins the prize wheel prior to the commencement of a designated Poker Tournament.
- Prize: "The Spin for Prizes" prize wheel is decorated in 108 sections with each section depicting different specific prize values ranging in value from \$10 to \$50,000. The amount listed in the section that the wheel pointer stops on will be added to the total prize pool of the designated poker tournament. In all instances, patrons will be provided with ample notice that this feature will be an element of the tournament.
- <u>Funding</u>: The prize is funded by the Casino. No amount shall be deducted from the Tournament prize pool in order to fund this gaming activity.
- Eligibility:
 - The promotion will be open to all players who participate in an eligible game during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the promotion
 - o There is no minimum or maximum number of players required to be playing in a designated game in order for the table or a player to be eligible for the promotion.
 - All procedures, times, and cash amounts will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements.

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- The specific structure will be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament will not change once sign-ups begin.
- Promotional materials will not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided will be equal and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- Entry may be earned by redeeming points from a players "Player Rewards Card (BGC ID GEGA-002831)".
- Entry may be earned by receiving a complimentary entry from the Turlock Poker Room. Reasons for complimentary entry can include but are not limited to:
 - Goodwill: To help offer an "I'm sorry" that a player's experience was not better
 - Holidays/Events: Mother daughter/son on Mother's day; Father daughter/son on Father's day; former military personnel on Veteran's Day; patron birthdays. Reasonable proof shall be required.
 - Loyalty: A "thank you" for continued patronage; for wearing Turlock Poker room logo shirt or cap at the start of the tournament.
- More than one method of entry for a specific tournament may be utilized.
- The number of complimentary entries to any individual tournament may be none up to the entire population of entrants to a particular tournament.
- The availability of complimentary entries will be clearly and conspicuously posted beginning at least three days prior to an eligible tournament.
- Complimentary entries can only be granted by licensed Key Employees or Owners.
- Patrons may not receive more than five complimentary tournament entries per calendar year for any combination of reasons.

- ** Re-Buy: The re-buy shall be offered during specific tournaments, which will allow a player to re-buy into a tournament after they have been eliminated from the tournament during specified time frames of the tournament. In this case, the cost of the W.S.O.P. shall either be fully funded by the card room or reimbursed from the player(s) buy-ins, rebuys, and add-ons in an amount equivalent to the cash value of the W.S.O.P. entry. If the total of the buy-ins plus the re-buys and add-ons (if applicable) does not equal the value of the non-cash prize, the card room shall cover the shortfall. The winner must make their own travel arrangements and hotel accommodations while at the World Series Poker Tournament in Las Vegas, Nevada. There will be only one winner during this tournament.

The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the tournament player. All advertisements shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the gaming activities offered during the Poker Tournaments.

Advertisement Requirements

The Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID listed below shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Royal Flush Bonus Promotion.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Casino at all times that the gaming activity is being offered:

- Qualifying games.
- Eligible dates and time periods.
- Qualifying hand & corresponding prize amounts.
- The amount that the prize pools are increased by each day.
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply.

Controlled Game

The Royal Flush Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to all limits and versions of the currently approved games offered at The Casino, as shown below.

All Approved Poker Games

All controlled game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Rules of Play

A player that receives the qualifying hand of a Royal Flush, during a pre-determined and posted time period, will win a pre-determined and posted prize ranging in value from \$25-\$5,000.

The qualifying hand will be a Royal Flush using two hole cards to make up the five-card hand in all applicable games.

• Players must be seated and playing at a designated table in order to qualify for the promotion.

Royal Flush Progressive Jackpot

- There is no minimum or maximum amount of players required to be playing in a designated game in order for the table to be eligible for the promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible while they are on break or off duty.

Funding

The Royal Flush Progressive Jackpot utilizes four progressive prize pools, which will be funded by the Turlock Poker Room. There will be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken for this promotion. The Turlock Poker Room will initially seed each prize pool, one for each suit (club, diamond, heart, spade), with an amount ranging from \$25-\$5,000 in the form of cash or casino chips. The royal flush progressive prize pools are then increased daily at pre-determined and designated times with an amount ranging from \$0-\$5,000. Each prize pool will be capped at \$5,000. The Turlock Poker Room will then re-seed the pool with a pre-determined amount ranging from \$25-\$5,000. In all instances, patrons will be provided with ample advance notice of the prize amounts, including the amount each prize pool will increase by for each game that is eligible for the promotion.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will provide no purchase necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. The NPN table will be treated in the same manner as a "live" table. The NPN player shall adhere to the same rules as the live player. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Royal Flush Bonus Hand. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Advertisement Requirements

The Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID listed above shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Spin for Prizes gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be displayed conspicuously and prominently posted in the Casino at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Qualifying losing hands.
- The prizes that shall be available to win by spinning the wheel.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.
- Any No Purchase Necessary opportunity.

Controlled Game(s)

The Spin for Prizes gaming activity shall be attached to the following approved controlled games offered at Turlock Poker Room, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. Furthermore, this gaming activity shall be attached to the play of any of the controlled games listed below while that game is being offered for play.

All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

Rules of Play

The Spin for Prizes gaming activity awards players, who make a losing qualifying hand, with the opportunity to spin a wheel. The wheel is decorated in 108 sections with each section depicting a specific prize amount. In all instances, patrons shall be provided with ample notice of the losing qualifying hands and of the possible prize amounts.

Prize Amounts

A player that makes a losing qualifying hand shall be given the opportunity to spin the wheel in order to be awarded a prize. The cumulative value of any and all prizes won shall range from \$10 to \$50,000. The wheel consists of 108 spots listing cash and merchandise prizes ranging in value from \$10 to \$1,000 in value; including but not limited to TVs, iPads, phones, tickets, etc. and one "Bonus Spin 2X" spot. If the pointer stops on the section labeled Bonus Spin 2X, the player shall spin the wheel again, and the amount listed in the section that the pointer stops on shall be doubled and awarded to the player. This amount shall range in value from \$20 to \$2,000. If on the second spin, the pointer lands on the Bonus Spin 2X again, the player shall win the posted jackpot prize amount which shall range in value from \$40 to \$50,000 in the form of cash or chips. If the wheel should stop on a merchandise space after a double spin, the

player will be awarded yet another spin until the wheel stops on a space with posted cash/chip value. The jackpot prize shall be pre-determined and posted by the casino.

Qualifying Hands

Furthermore, the qualifying hand chart option shall be displayed prominently within the Turlock Poker Room at all times the Spin the Wheel promotion is being offered for play.

Turlock Poker Room Spin for Prizes

Eligibility

- The prize shall be awarded to a player when he or she makes a losing qualifying hand, and that player has spun the wheel which landed on a listed prize amount.
- A minimum of two players must be dealt into the game in order for the table to qualify for the gaming activity.
- When a qualifying hand is announced, a floor person shall verify that the hand qualified. Any deviation from a standard deck shall nullify the gaming activity.
- In order to qualify for the gaming activity, the player that is dealt the qualifying losing hand must use both hole cards.

No Purchase Necessary

The Spin for Prizes gaming activity shall be offered for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with no restrictions, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary (NPN) game. The Turlock Poker Room shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the jackpot without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Spin for Prizes gaming activity. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Turlock Poker Room"Splash the Pot" Promotional Rules

Advertising Requirements

Turlock Poker Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-003950) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Turlock Poker Room at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games.
- Eligible time period(s).
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Amount to be added to the pot (prize amount).
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Controlled Game

The Splash the Pot promotion shall be attached to all limits and versions of the currently approved games offered at Turlock Poker Room, as listed below:

All Approved Poker Games

All base game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control.

Rules of Play

The Splash the Pot gaming activity features a promotional element which shall be attached to the above listed approved games at the Casino. During pre-determined times and intervals of the promotional period, a casino employee shall announce the commencement of the drawing in order to determine which table(s) shall be selected for the "Splash the Pot" prize. One or more tables may be eligible to receive the designated prize. The casino key employee shall assign a card selected from a standard deck of 52 cards to each active Poker table. Once a card for each table has been selected, the table with the highest ranking card will be awarded the predetermined and posted prize. The Splash the Pot gaming activity shall be funded by the Casino. Therefore, there shall be no additional jackpot fees or collection fees taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

There will be no administrative fees attached to the Splash the Pot promotion.

No Purchase Necessary

All persons wishing to participate on a No Purchase Necessary (NPN) basis will be accommodated by asking a Casino Floor Manager for a NPN table to be set up. This will be accomplished within a reasonable period of time and the participant will be dealt hands as if it is in a live game. All opportunities to win the promotion will be provided to a person participating at an NPN table in the same procedure and manner as that of a live game. No cash, collection, or Casino gaming chips will be used at the NPN table. The Casino dealer or floor manager will play the hands of the unoccupied seats to simulate a full game.

Turlock Sports Ticket Giveaway Procedure

- All seated players in an active game qualify for the promotion. Players must be in an active game at the beginning of the sporting event. They must also be in an active game at the same time as the winner of each qualifying period is determined. A player can take a break from playing in a game, but if their square is determined to be a winner while they are on break, they forfeit their prize for that qualifying period.

Turlock Poker Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001127) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Turlock Poker Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible dates and time periods
- All prizes and prize amounts
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eliqible Controlled Games

The Will Play for Food promotion shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Turlock Poker Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

Players may be awarded food and/or non-alcoholic beverages for participating in any of the above listed controlled games, during holidays, for continued patronage, or as a gesture of good will if they have a negative experience. The prize value shall be a fixed amount between \$1 and \$1,000 and shall be prominently displayed in the Casino at all times this promotion is offered for play.

- Players may be awarded food while seated and playing in any of the controlled games listed above. In this instance, the food and/or non-alcoholic beverage will be given to a predetermined and posted table at predetermined times.
 - Example: All seated players engaged in a live Mexican Poker game at a predetermined time on a predetermined day will be given a pizza and a soda.
- Players may also be awarded food and/or non-alcoholic beverages for continued patronage or during holidays.

No administrative fees shall be taken for the Will Play for Food promotion as it is fully funded by Turlock Poker Room.

No Purchase Necessary

The Will Play for Food promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Turlock Poker Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001404) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Turlock Poker Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games and time periods
- Qualifying hands and corresponding prize amounts
- Administrative fees
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at Turlock Poker Room, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Pure Spanish 21.5 (GEGR-000554)
- Pure 21.5 Blackjack (GEGR-000552)

Object and Summary

Players are betting that both of their first two cards will match the player-dealer's up card in rank. A player that achieves one of the qualifying hands listed below for the Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot is eligible to win a fixed or progressive prize.

- 1. To begin each round, players must make their regular base game wager. Players may optionally place any bonus bets and optional \$1 Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot fee. Each eligible controlled game will have a designated spot on the layout for the progressive wager to be placed on ("sensor-less wager spot").
- Once all players place their bets and/or jackpot fee, the chips should be left in the
 designated spot on the layout. The house dealer then counts the number of bets for
 that round, inputs the total number of bets, and then presses "Check Bets" on the Table
 Control. The jackpot fees shall be dropped into a separate and locked jackpot collection
 box and accounted for separately.
- The house dealer then follows standard approved procedures for dealing the base game. A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game regardless of the outcome of the base game.
- 4. When a player has achieved a winning hand, a casino representative will be responsible for verifying the winning hand. This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- Only seated players, who are dealt a designated hand and who have placed the optional \$1 jackpot fee are eligible for payouts.
- Backline bettors are not eligible to participate in this gaming activity.
- A minimum of two players, a player and the player-dealer, are required for this gaming activity.
- A minimum of three decks must be used in the base game in order for the game to qualify for the promotion.
- A player can qualify for the jackpot element of the game, regardless of the outcome of the base game.
- Winning players will be paid in live casino chips by a casino representative at their seat once their hand has been verified by a casino representative.
- There is no limit to the number of times a player can qualify for and win either the fixed or the progressive prize during any given promotional period.
- A player may place a base game wager as well as the optional jackpot fee on any unoccupied seat, as well as their own, and become eligible for multiple payouts.
- Tournament games are not eligible for this promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible to play when off duty and out of uniform.
- The player-dealer position is not eligible to participate in this promotion.
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to place a
 jackpot collection fee and become eligible for the Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot
 gaming activity when either in the player-dealer or player capacity.

Prize

The Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot features both progressive and fixed prizes. All prizes will be paid by a casino representative. Once all proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner(s) in live casino chips. Payouts over \$10,000 may be paid the following day via check. The payouts will not be made from the house dealer's tray.

Progressive Prize

The progressive prize will range from a minimum of \$1,000 and will have no maximum amount. The actual amount shall depend on the amount the jackpot was originally seeded at, as well as how much time has accumulated in order for the jackpot to increase progressively each day.

- Three Suited Aces of Spades is paid 100% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.
- Three Suited Aces of Hearts, Clubs or Diamonds is paid 10% of the progressive jackpot amount shown on the progressive meter.
- All progressive payouts will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the player-dealer's tray.
- All other hands are paid from the reserve fund. They do not get deducted from the progressive meter.
- In the event more than one progressive meter payout or any other qualifying hand hits during the same round, all players with a qualifying hand will be paid the posted progressive prize amount.
- When more than one progressive meter payout hits, one progressive pay will be paid from the meter and the others will be paid from the reserve fund.
 - In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund. All hands will be paid the posted prize.

Fixed Prize

- All fixed payouts will be paid by a casino representative. Once the proper paperwork has been filled out, the casino representative will pay the winner in live casino chips. The payouts will not be made from the player-dealer's tray.
- All fixed payouts will be deducted from the amount in the reserve fund and not from the progressive meter.
- In the event that more than one qualifying hand hits during the same round, all fixed prize winning players will be paid 100% of the posted fixed prize amount.
 - In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino will make up any shortfall and will be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund. All hands will be paid the posted prize.

Funding

The Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot is a player-funded jackpot with both fixed and progressive elements. The Casino will initially seed the jackpot at an amount ranging from \$1,000 to \$100,000. Once there are sufficient monies in the Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot reserve fund, the initial seed will be reimbursed to the Casino from the reserve fund and shall be documented in the accounting records. After the progressive jackpot is hit, the progressive meter will be re-seeded by the reserve fund at a minimum of \$1,000 to a maximum of \$100,000. In the event the reserve fund is depleted, the Casino shall make up any shortfall and be reimbursed once there are sufficient monies in the reserve fund. The progressive prize pool shall increase daily based solely on the number of jackpot collection fees placed and collected each day. There is no cap on the progressive jackpot. Furthermore, the Casino will cover any shortfall and will not be reimbursed.

Each \$1 jackpot fee paid by a player will be broken down as follows:

- \$0.25 will be immediately posted on the progressive meter.
- \$0.75 will be tracked in the reserve fund. The reserve fund will be utilized to immediately reseed the metered progressive jackpot at a minimum of \$1,000 following a progressive prize win. In addition, this reserve fund will be used to pay all fixed amount prizes and administrative fees.

All monies collected and paid out shall be tracked both electronically and on a hand written log that shall be maintained by the Casino, for examination by regulatory and law enforcement personnel.

Administrative Fees

The Casino will take an administrative fee ranging from \$5 to \$30 per table per hour. The administrative fee will be taken from the reserve fund. The fee will cover the costs associated with the computer system and program in addition to technicians having to service the systems.

No Purchase Necessary

The Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with <u>no restrictions</u>. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. <u>All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Match the Dealer Progressive Jackpot. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.</u>

Equipment

The electronic software and Table Control related to and used in conjunction with this jackpot, which is used on each table eligible for this jackpot, has been tested, approved, and certified by Masque Publishing Inc.

- When a player has a progressive meter winner, the house dealer shall press the appropriate hand button on the keypad.
- The house dealer shall then contact the casino representative.
- Once the Casino verifies the progressive meter win, the casino representative shall press "Jackpot Hit" on the Table Control and then enter in the appropriate code to release the funds off the progressive meter. This records the win onto the Casino Control computer. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- When the house dealer reconciles all action (on behalf of the player-dealer), he/she waits
 for new bets to be made for the next hand and then presses the "Check Bets" button on
 the Table Control to begin the next hand.
- Once the "Jackpot Hit" button is pressed and the appropriate code is entered on the Table Control, the prize is logged into the Casino Control computer.
- If the electronic software or digital reader malfunctions or breaks down, the jackpot will not be offered.
