**NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

Notice published February 19, 2026

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8, subdivision (c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Justice (Department) is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation sections 942 through 947 of Title 11, Division 1, Chapter 11. This proposed regulation was the subject of a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking published in the California Register (Register 2025, No. 45-Z) on November 7, 2025, as Notice File Number 2025-1028-05. These changes are in response to comments received regarding the proposed regulation and for clarification purposes. Changes made after the 45-day comment period are illustrated in the regulation text by ~~green double strikethrough~~ for proposed deletions and red double underline for proposed additions.
